**INVADING THE SUBURBS**

A perfect five-for-five in Uruguay, **Invasor (Arg)** (Candy Stripes) will try to take his act to the suburbs of New York this afternoon. The four-year-old colt is the

9-5 morning-line favorite in the GI Suburban H. at Belmont Park. Purchased for a reported \$1.4 million by Shadwell Stable after his unbeaten South American stint, the bay was sent to Dubai and finished seven lengths behind Discreet Cat when fourth in the Mar. 25 G2 UAE

Derby. He headed to the U.S. to continue his career and was back in the winner's circle in his first American appearance, posting a 1 1/4-length score in the May 19 GI Pimlico Special H. for trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "He had trained really well going into the Pimlico Special, but you really had no idea what to expect looking at his form in Uruguay," McLaughlin said. "I wanted to run in an easier spot to see where we were at with him, but Rick Nichols of Shadwell wanted to run in the Pimlico Special because it was a small field. Since that race he has done everything right--he's a neat horse to be around." Also unbeaten since shipping to the States is **Rathor (Ire)** (Machiavellian). The Flaxman Stable colorbearer, a handicap horse in Britain, opened his U.S. account with a win over optional claimers going six furlongs at Aqueduct in March. He came back to take similar contests going a mile and a sixteenth at Belmont May 4 and June 6, and should have no trouble handling the 10 panels of the Suburban. He broke his maiden by 10 lengths at that trip last July. "This horse is really good," said jockey Eibar Coa, who has been aboard for all three American starts. "To tell you the truth, I don't know how good he can be. He has proved to me that he can handle any situation. He's got all the tools." Trainer Rick Dutrow Jr., who won this race last year with Offlee Wild, saddles **Wild Desert** (Wild Rush). Last year's Queen's Plate hero has been out just once since running third in the 2005 Prince of Wales S. at Fort Erie, finishing second by a head in the May 5 Alysheba S. at Churchill Downs. **Suburban field, p2**

**EXTRA EFFORT NEEDED IN MOTHER GOOSE**

The winner of the May 6 GIII La Troienne S. going 7 1/2 furlongs and the June 3 GIII Dogwood Breeders' Cup S. going a mile, **Joint Effort** (Runaway Groom) will try to stretch it out another furlong for the GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont today. The chestnut filly has tried a distance beyond the mile just once before, but had a rough trip in the 1 1/16-mile GII Darley Alcibiades S. at Keeneland last October and finished a too-

bad-to-be-true 10th. Her pedigree indicates the added ground will be well within her scope. **Lemons Forever** (Lemon Drop Kid) proved she could handle the trip in her latest outing. The chestnut filly, off at 4-7-1 in the May 5 GI Kentucky Oaks, powered from last to get up for a 1 1/2-length victory. "She's done very well since the Oaks," trainer Dallas Stewart remarked, adding, "It didn't really make much sense to me to turn her back to a mile after running a mile and an eighth in the Oaks, so we skipped the Acorn and pointed for this." Stewart opted to take a pass on the June 10 GI Acorn S. at Belmont, but trainer Eddie Kenneally brought **Bushfire** (Louis Quatorze) up for the race and it paid off. Disqualified and placed sixth after finishing third in the Oaks, the bay filly battled through fast fractions in that test and prevailed by a head at the wire. "It was awesome," Kenneally said. "She really seems to like Belmont." Now five-for-eight, Bushfire also boasts a 6 1/2-length victory in the Apr. 8 GI Ashland S.

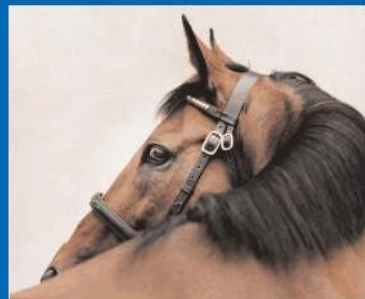

**Alexander Goldrun** has carved out a reputation as one of the best distaffers in the world over the past two years, winning the G1 Prix de l'Opera and G1 Hong Kong Cup in 2004 before returning last term to annex both this contest and G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood. She also placed in the 2004 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas and in Kranji's G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup, and in the G1 Falmouth S. at Newmarket, G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown and G1 Prix de l'Opera last term. She comes into this off a distant runner-up effort to Hurricane Run (Ire) in the May 28 G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup, but should find the company more agreeable this afternoon. "Alexander Goldrun is in great form," trainer Jim Bolger, who is looking for his fifth renewal, told the *Racing Post*. "I am very happy with her." Her main foe once again is **Red Bloom**, who has failed to hit the heights suggested by her juvenile exploits when winning the G1 Fillies' Mile in 2003, but who showed she retained ability last term when second in this race and third in the Nassau. Runner-up to Pride (Fr) in the G2 Prix Jean Romanet in August, she gained her reward with success in the G2 Blandford S. over course and distance the following month. Sixth in the Prix de l'Opera in October, she returned with a fourth on testing ground in the G3 Middleton S. at York May 18 and needs to improve to provide trainer Sir Michael Stoute with a first renewal. "Sir Michael is very pleased with her," owner Cheveley Park Stud's Managing Director Chris Richardson commented. "She has developed further over the winter and has strengthened."

Trainer Todd Pletcher sends **Master Command** from Belmont Park in search of his second straight graded score. The \$650,000 FTSAUG yearling capped off his 2005 campaign with a maiden win in Belmont in October and an allowance score at Aqueduct in November. He added a Gulfstream allowance tally in his 2006 opener in January, then made his stakes debut in the Apr. 8 GII Oaklawn H. and finished fourth. Sent off the 13-10 chalk in the GIII W.D. Schaefer H. at Pimlico May 20, the four-year-old went right to the front and never looked back, winning by 2 3/4 lengths over GI Suburban H. hopeful Andromeda's Hero. He will be joined on the front end by **Siphon City**, who cruised to an eight-length win in Calder's Sumter S. May 6, and wired the field once again when besting **Congrats** by 1 1/2 lengths in the GIII Memorial Day H. May 29. **Gouldings Green** outfinished Suburban candidate Wild Desert by a head to take the May 5 Alysheba S. at Churchill Downs. The crowd's choice to make it two in a row in the May 27 GIII Hanshin H., he was forced to alter course in the stretch and hit the wire second, but was moved up to first by the stewards.

Veteran **Miesque's Approval** came from out of the clouds to win the Jan. 28 Sunshine Millions Turf at Gulfstream, spoiling jockey Jerry Bailey's farewell ride when beating Bailey's mount, Silver Tree, by 3/4 of a length. The seven-year-old couldn't quite get past English Channel in the Mar. 11 Canadian Turf H., running second by the same margin, but rebounded to post a nose score in the Apr. 14 GII Maker's Mark Mile at Keeneland. He is the heavy favorite to repeat. **On the Border** bids for his fourth in a row. The six-year-old was freshened following an optional-claiming tally on Turfway's Polytrack Jan. 1, returning to take an allowance test on the turf at River Downs May 29. He was let go at 19-1 in a Churchill allowance June 10, but belied long odds to win it by a neck and has been working bullets for this race. **Free Thinking** stopped the clock in 1:34 flat when taking an optional claimer over course and distance May 12. Sent right to the front in the June 3 Opening Verse H. going a sixteenth farther, he tired late to be third, but could get loose on the lead this time.

Trainer Doug O'Neill has had plenty of success transforming claiming horses into stakes horses--most notably leading handicapper Lava Man--and looks to have worked his magic again with **Maryfield**. Like Lava Man, Maryfield was haltered for \$50,000, at Santa Anita in January. Since the claim, Mayfield captured a \$40,000 seller in February, then won the off-the-turf Flower Girl H. by 5 1/4 lengths a month later. There was no shame running third to Behaving Badly and Leave Me Alone in the Apr. 7 Bug Brush S., nor in her second-place effort to the speedy My Miss Storm Cat in her latest, the May 28 Desert Stormer H. over this surface. The five-year-old mare has ample speed, and with jockey Pat Valenzuela aboard, there's little doubt what the game plan will be. **Somethinaboutlaura** is another who's been facing top fillies. She completed the exacta underneath Proposed in the Apr. 30 B. Thoughtful S. at Hollywood, and was third to that filly and Star Parade (Arg) in the June 3 GII Milady BC H.

When it comes to finding the wire first, a number of CashCall runners have the game figured out. Leading the win parade is trainer Doug O'Neill's **Cambiocorsa**, who enters the race with a dazzling seven-race winning skein on the line. It began back in November in a Santa Anita state-bred allowance, and most recently the four-year-old notched wins in the Apr. 16 GIII Las Cienegas H. and May 26 Wishing Well S. under the Hollywood lights. With a record of nine wins in 15 starts, **Sweet Talker** is another who likes to get her picture taken. Last year's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup S. heroine won Laurel's Dahlia S. in her seasonal debut Apr. 15, and annexed the May 29 GIII WinStar Distaff H. at Lone Star in her latest. The late-running **Shining Energy** will likely get swift fractions to close into, which she didn't get last time when she dug in to win the nine-furlong GI Gamely BC H. at Hollywood May 29. Still, the mile distance is probably a bit shorter than her ideal. Japan's **Dance in the Mood** traveled to Hollywood to be second in the 2004 GI American Oaks, and returns looking to replicate her winning effort in the G1 Victoria Mile at Tokyo May 14. The firm turf of Hollywood should suit **Luas Line**, who slips in under the radar despite having won the GI Garden City BC H. at Belmont last September.

**Henny Hughes** makes his first appearance since running second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile in October. A maiden winner over this track last year, he also captured the Tremont S. and the GII Saratoga Special and was runner-up in the GI Hopeful and GI Champagne. The chestnut colt did not race while wintering in Dubai, but has been working sharply for his return. "He's doing terrific," trainer Kiaran McLaughlin said. "He might need a race, because he has been away for a while, but he's training great and he looks great. We wouldn't lead him over there if we didn't think he was ready." **Keyed Entry**, winner of the GII Hutcheson S., stretched out to be second in the GIII Gotham and third in the GI Wood Memorial. He was in front briefly in the May 6 GI Kentucky Derby before tiring to be last, and drops back to a sprint for his first start since. **Changing Weather** rallied to take the May 20 Matt Winn S. at Churchill and will be coming late. "If Henny Hughes is not on top of his game after the layoff, and if three or four of them get out there ding-donging on the front end, it gives us a better shot at winning," trainer Eoin Harty said. "We reaped the benefit of a very fast pace last time, and hopefully we can do the same [today]."

**FALLON CHOOSES DYLAN FOR DERBY**

Kieren Fallon has opted to partner Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's June 3 G1 Epsom Derby third **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill) in tomorrow's G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh. With 13 set to go to post, the Classic has attracted the biggest field in 10 years. The bay colt bids to emulate Alamshar (Ire), who was placed in the Blue Riband before going on to success in this. Dylan Thomas kicked off the season with a victory in the May 14 G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial at Leopardstown, a race used as a springboard to success here by Sinn dar (Ire), Galileo (Ire), High Chaparral (Ire) and Alamshar (Ire) since 2000. Aidan O'Brien will also rely on Susan Magnier's May 28 G3 Gallinule S. winner **Puerto Rico (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and Derrick Smith's Epsom Derby eighth **Mountain (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) as he chases a fourth success since 1997. "Dylan Thomas has been in good form since Epsom, although he hasn't done a lot since running in the Derby," O'Brien told the *Racing Post*. Geoff Wragg is represented by John Pearce's **Dragon Dancer (GB)** (Sadler's Wells), who split Sir Percy (GB) and Dylan Thomas when a short-head runner-up in the June 3 Classic. He filled the same spot behind Papal Bull (GB) in the May 11 G3 Chester Vase, and this would be a fine stage to finally shed his maiden tag. "He hasn't surprised me this season, as we always knew he had the potential, and he's improved with every run," jockey Darryll Holland said. "He got trapped a little bit wide when second...at Chester and he improved for that run at Epsom. Dylan Thomas had very much the run of the race at Epsom, setting a nice sedate pace and quickening up the straight. My horse was very brave and I'd like to think I could beat him again." Sir Michael Stoute registered three wins in this Classic in the 1980s and relies on Gainsborough Stud's **Best Alibi (GB)** (King's Best), who followed a second in York's May 18 G2 Dante S. with a sixth at Epsom. Bruce Raymond, racing manager for the operation, is hopeful he can better that effort under Mick Kinane. "He seems to be much improved and his work has been quite exciting," Raymond commented. "He was a bit further back than we would have wanted in the Derby, but he stayed on very well. I think he's got a very good chance, as he's much better on fast ground and he's a progressive horse."

**BARBARO UPDATE** Six weeks have passed since he suffered a catastrophic breakdown in the GI Preakness S., and **Barbaro** (Dynaformer) continues to make significant progress while recuperating at the University of Pennsylvania's New Bolton Center. "He's looking really good and we haven't had any major complications to date," said Dr. Dean Richardson, who performed the surgery on Barbaro. "He is in his second cast and he is wearing this one well. He's got a phenomenal attitude on life. He's a vibrant, healthy-acting horse. It's still too early to say he's going to make it, but this horse, so far, has done everything right." Richardson said that there are at least two hurdles remaining for Barbaro. "Until the fracture has completely regained full strength, the metal is helping hold things together," he said. "The metal can break. This metal is not strong enough to hold a horse of his size up. It can break due to fatigue, the same way you could take a paper clip and keep bending it and eventually it will break. It is possible for the metal to break and if the metal breaks and anything gets unstable before the fracture heals, that would be a serious complication. The other complication is that he still could develop laminitis in his opposite foot. So far, he has shown no signs of that, but it is something that could happen a day from now, a week from now, a month from now." Richardson predicted that Barbaro will remain at New Bolton for at least two more months.
