A winner in a pair of juvenile starts, **Bushfire** defeated Teammate a head in a Jan. 13 Gulfstream allowance, but failed to handle the sloppy track when seventh to Wait A While in the Feb. 4 GII Davona Dale S. The 3/4-length winner of the Florida Oaks at Tampa Mar. 18, Bushfire flaunted her speed over the Keeneland main track and cruised to a 6 1/2-length score in the GI Ashland S. Apr. 8. Third, but demoted to sixth behind Lemons Forever in the May 5 Oaks, the bay fought back after losing the lead to take the GI Acorn S. by a neck on the Belmont undercard June 10.

## Filly Fires Again...

Quickly into stride, Bushfire took the field along through a moderate opening quarter mile in :23.86, but relinquished a narrow advantage to Teammate, who was off slowly, but rushed up to lead after four furlongs in :46.64. Content to have that target as they raced on the far turn, jockey Edgar Prado asked Bushfire to go on with it nearing the quarter pole and his charge responded, opening daylight before holding the lightly raced Pine Island (Arch) safe. GII Fantasy S. winner Ready To Please took a run at Bushfire at the eighth pole, but was outfinished for the place. "I think the key to the race was the first quarter mile," the victorious rider submitted. "She broke sharp, but she wasn't rank. She was relaxed and even when another horse came to us, she was still relaxed. When I shook her up, she found another gear."

Following his perfect five-for-five campaign in Uruquay, Invasor was forced to give his juniors, including Discreet Cat, seven pounds in the G2 UAE Derby Mar. 25 and turned in a respectable fourth-place effort to the Godolphin runner. Despite some opposition from trainer Kiaran McLaughlin, Invasor made his U.S. debut in the May 19 GI Pimlico Special H. and, despite looking hopelessly beaten at the quarter pole, stayed on for a 1 1/4length success. Favored to make it seven of eight for his career, the Argentine-bred stalked the pace from third for the opening three-quarters of a mile. He tackled pacesetting Noble Causeway (Giant's Causeway) with two furlongs to race, opened up as Fernando Jara looked around for the competition and pulled nicely clear. "I asked him a little bit at the three-eighths pole and then he just ran up to the leaders on his own," Jara commented. "I was very confident in this horse." #### Pretty Polly S. cont.

Alexander Goldrun has stayed at the top of her game mainly due to her turn of acceleration over this trip, which saw her collect the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp and G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin at the end of 2004. A victory in this race marked her return to Europe last term and she followed the win with a creditable second to Soviet Song (Ire) in the G1 Falmouth S. at Newmarket's July meeting. Back in Britain later that month to conquer the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood, she ran third in the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown in September and G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp the following month. She was off the board in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket and the Hong Kong Cup at the end of her 2005 campaign, before finishing fifth on her comeback in the Mar. 25 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba. Overmatched against Hurricane Run (Ire) in the May 28 G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup back here last time, she came off a seven-length defeat and relished this return to distaff company. Settled in fifth throughout the early stages, she challenged wide as Chelsea Rose got the better of the long-time leader Red Bloom inside the final quarter. Grabbing the former soon after, she gradually asserted and had enough in reserve to contain that rival's game revival close home. Bolger has an identical plan mapped out for the fiveyear-old this season. "The G1 Nassau S. [at Goodwood Aug. 5] is next and then most likely the G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 9]," he said. "We'll see how she is then and she might go to France [for the Oct. 1 G1 Prix de l'Opera de Longchamp] before another run in Hong Kong." She was very feminine and very laid back--didn't have a mean bone in her body. But every time she went to the track, she put her race hat on.

If you could change one thing about our sport, what would it be? I don't want to sound ostentatious, but the problem I have is with the media--they don't do enough on owners. Those are the people that are feeding this industry. It's such a simple thing, and I think we can do more with it.

What was Edenwold named after? I name all my horses after towns in Saskatchewan. Edenwold's a small community of about 300 people.

What is your favorite vacation spot? Cabo San Lucas. We make it down about once a year.

### DERBY DREAMS AT THE CURRAGH

Unlike **Darsi**, who entered that Classic without championship pretensions on form, having won a minor race at Chantilly May 2, **Best Name** had his credentials sign-posted from the outset by Robert Collet. Justifying a bold decision to debut in the G3 Prix de Conde at Longchamp in October, he was a short-head second to the subsequent G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud scorer Linda's Lad (GB). He broke his maiden on his sophomore bow in the Listed Prix de Courcelles back at that track Apr. 9 and was doing his best work at the finish of the Chantilly Classic. "He is very mentally-balanced horse and the travelling will not be a problem for him," Collet told *PA Sport*.

"He is very well and is in perfect shape and perfect health. "He worked very well on Monday and I am sure he can improve for his run at Chantilly." Also from France is Gary Tanaka's G1 Derby Italiano hero Gentlewave (Ire) (Monsun {Ger}), who represents the Andre Fabre barn responsible for Hurricane Run. After wins in the Listed Prix Maurice Caillault at Saint-Cloud Mar. 18 and Apr. 17 G2 Prix Noailles at Longchamp, he lost his unbeaten tag to Numide (Fr) in the G2 Prix Hocquart back at the latter venue May 8. Supplemented for the Rome Classic, he justified the fee 13 days later with a commanding four-length success. "As always with these races, you wonder how the Italian form is going to translate, but he did it easily and impressively," the owner's Racing Manager Lincoln Collins told PA Sport. "Andre thought he was worth supplementing, so Gary went ahead and did it. We are looking forward to it--it's not our habit to make excuses about anything -- so may the best horse win."

## **Budget Woes Could Halt Monmouth Racing:**

Monmouth Park was able to hold its scheduled card of Thoroughbred racing yesterday, but the gates closed at 6 p.m. last night. The track had to call off its evening simulcasting program because the ongoing dispute over the state budget has resulted in a government shutdown, forcing the New Jersey Racing Commission to suspend operations. "The racetracks are required to have state regulators from the Racing Commission in order to conduct live, simulcast or internet wagering," explained Dennis Dowd, senior vice president of racing for the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority. "Without those regulators we were left with no option but to close." There is hope, however, that the doors will be reopened today. "We are in the process of drafting the paperwork to take to the appellate division, requesting permission to continue racing," said Dennis Drazin, the president of the New Jersey Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association. "The casino industry has a hearing before the appellate division panel after 4 p.m. [today], and they have been given permission to continue conducting business until that time. We are trying to get them to do the same for racing. We are hoping to get a decision that will let us race [today]." An executive order was issued yesterday afternoon, stating that all "non-essential" services be shut down "in an orderly fashion." According to Dowd, that process will take more than a day to accomplish. "We have drawn the races through Tuesday," Dowd said. "I don't believe we can close in an orderly fashion until we race out the horses that have already entered. My educated guess is that the judge will agree, and we are planning to race [today]." A decision on the horsemen's petition was expected to be reached by midnight last night.
