DUO ADDED TO ECLIPSE Mountgrange Stud's Blue Monday (GB) (Darshaan {GB}) and Jeff Smith's Snoqualmie Boy (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) were yesterday supplemented for Saturday's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. at Sandown. The former, who took the G3 La Coupe S. at Longchamp June 15 and Snoqualmie Boy, who scored in the June 22 Listed Hampton Court S. at Royal Ascot, were added at a cost of £20,000 each. Lord Derby's multiple Group 1 winner Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) and Roldvale Ltd's G1 Champion S. and G1 Dubai Duty Free scorer David Junior (Pleasant Tap) headed the 13 remaining in the 10-furlong contest at the fiveday stage. Aidan O'Brien has left in a quartet, with the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) winner Aussie Rules (Danehill) the most likely representative, while Sir Michael Stoute has a duo in Khalid Abdullah's Notable Guest (Kingmambo) and Anthony and David de Rothschild's Notnowcato (GB) (Inchinor (GB)), but scratched Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's G2 Hardwicke S, winner Maraahel (Ire) (Alzao).

LUKAS CONSIDERS BASHFORD DEBUT FOR

PEGASUS WIND Hall of Fame trainer D. Wayne Lukas may make the bold decision to have juvenile Pegasus Wind (Fusaichi Pegasus) make his racing debut in Saturday's GIII Bashford Manor S. at Churchill Downs. The colt has been working fast and frequently for Lukas, including a five-furlong breeze in :59.80 at Churchill Monday. "I haven't got any definite plans," Lukas said yesterday. "I'm just going to see how the rest of the week unfolds." Lukas may run Pegasus Wind in a July 9 maiden. "He's an exceptional colt," the trainer said. "I've been around enough good horses to know that he can run. He's impressed everybody else out here, too."

KIEREN FALLON CHARGED

Kieren Fallon was among 11 people charged by the City of London Police yesterday as the long-running investigation into alleged race-fixing came to a head. Less than 24 hours after winning the G1 Irish Derby on Dylan Thomas (Ire), the six-time British champion jockey was charged with conspiracy to defraud custom-

ers of the internet betting exchange Betfair, alongside fellow riders Fergal Lynch and Darren Williams. Miles Rodgers, who managed the Platinum Racing syndicate, was charged with conspiracy to defraud and an offence under the Proceeds of Crime Act, while Joanne Richardson, believed to be his partner, was also accused of an offence under the Proceeds of Crime Act.

Detective Chief Superintendent Steve Wilmott of the City of London Police later said, "In early 2004, Betfair, an internet betting exchange, brought to the attention of the Jockey Club a number of what they considered to be irregular betting patterns. The security department of the Jockey Club undertook an investigation and came to the conclusion that there was potential criminality that could undermine the integrity of horse racing."

While Fallon made no comment, his Coolmore connections were quick to defend his reputation. "John Magnier, Derrick Smith and Michael Tabor, for whom Kieren Fallon rides, have been assured that Mr. Fallon is innocent of these charges and look forward to his opportunity to defend himself, and to the early resolution of this issue," a statement from the operation read.

Yesterday's sensational proceedings were brought about due to the wide-ranging, exhaustive investigation which began in January 2004. Over £1 million has been spent on "Operation Crypton" in total, which centers around allegations of fixing the outcomes of races between Dec. 1, 2002 and Sept. 2, 2004. The arrests totaled 34, with more than 500 interviews undertaken and almost 40,000 pages of evidence gathered. Trainer Karl Burke and jockey Robert Winston, two of 28 to answer bail, were released without charge, while conditioner Alan Berry was later charged.

All those charged are due to appear at the City of London Magistrates' Court on July 17, with the Crown Prosecution Service expecting the case to split into three linked trials starting in spring 2007 at the earliest. Fallon is due to continue riding in Ireland after receiving the backing of the Irish Turf Club, whose Chief Executive Denis Egan said yesterday, "Basically, the situation

in Ireland is that he will be able to continue to ride. The licensing committee will obviously note what has happened, but as far as we are concerned, Kieren Fallon is innocent until proven guilty." However, Fallon and the other riders charged have had their licences expired by the Horseracing Regulatory Authority, while Berry will be prevented from entering or declaring a horse. However, the HRA have chosen to arrange a special panel to hear representations from Berry today and from the jockeys on Friday.

In a statement, the HRA said, "The City of Action Plus London Police have today charged a number of individuals with criminal offences in rela-

tion to horseracing. Some of those individuals charged are licensed by the Horseracing Regulatory Authority (the HRA). In accordance with conditions which were attached to their licences when they were issued, those licences expire immediately or are limited as follows: Fergal Lynch, jockey--licence expired pending hearing. Darren Williams, jockey--licence expired pending hearing. Alan Berry, trainer--no entries or declarations accepted pending hearing. Kieren Fallon, jockey--licensed in Ireland--prohibited from riding in Great Britain (under Rule 1Axxv) pending hearing. The panel, chaired by Sir Michael Connell, a former High Court judge and a director of the HRA, will consider each such case individually and is likely to announce it's conclusions to those concerned once all the representations have been heard. Those licensed people released from bail today are free to continue their work as normal. As part of our regulatory duty, we are required to liaise with the police regarding any matters they have inquired into to ensure no further regulatory action is necessary."

DANEHILL ON DISPLAY AT CURRAGH

Last Sunday developed into another of those Danehill days at The Curragh, when both the group races fell to sons of this legendary stallion and another son supplied the winner of one of the two Listed contests.

As if that wasn't a big enough demonstration of Danehill's talents, the two group wins underlined Danehill's great versatility. Forty minutes after his two-year-old son Holy Roman Emperor erased memories of his Royal Ascot failure with victory in the G2 Railway S. over six furlongs, Dylan Thomas coped with double that distance when he quickened impressively to dominate the G1 Irish Derby.

Both these important races already featured on Danehill's CV. The Railway S. has proved a perfect platform for the champion sire's young sons, with George Washington, Rock of Gibraltar and Honours List all being successful (the 2004 winner Democratic Deficit is out of a Danehill mare).

Dylan Thomas is only the second Danehill colt to win the Irish Derby, following Desert King in 1997, but North Light was second in 2004 and Roosevelt third in 2003.

Danehill sired major winners over distances from five furlongs to two and a half miles, ranging from the champion sprinter Mozart (sire of Sunday's stylish Listed winner Dandy Man) to the outstanding long-distance performer Westerner.

It isn't too hard to explain how Danehill managed to do so. On the one hand, he was by Danzig, whose name became almost synonymous with speed and precocity (at least in Europe). On the other hand, the fourth generation of his pedigree featured several stallions which displayed an element of stamina. Among them are Nearco (a winner up to 1 7/8 miles), Native Dancer (Belmont S.), Petition (Eclipse S.), Tenerani (another winner at up to 1 7/8 miles) and Tom Fool (Brooklyn H. over 1½ miles). The next generation of Danehill's pedigree featured two lines to Hyperion (Derby and St Leger) and another two to the Derby-winning Mahmoud.

These staying elements often helped swing the balance when Danehill was mated with mares with a middle-distance background, such as Dylan Thomas's dam Lagrion.

Lagrion had a spectacularly poor racing record for a mare who has now produced two outstanding Group 1 winners. Unraced at two, she spent much of the next two years trekking around minor Irish tracks, without managing to win any of her 14 starts. Her best placing was her second in a handicap over nearly 1 5/8 miles at Wexford, and Turform was sufficiently unimpressed to rate her only 68 at three and 54 at four.

Her modest achievements naturally limited the amount of money her breeder Kip McCreery was prepared to spend on her and Lagrion spent her first four years visiting Priolo, Mujtahid, Lahib and Namaqualand. However, she received a better chance in 1998 when she visited the champion two-year-old Grand Lodge in his fourth season, when his fee was Ir10,000gns. *Cont. p6*

The resultant filly-Queen's Logic-failed to produce a profit for her breeder as a weanling, but she sold much better as a yearling and then developed into a formidable performer for Jaber Abdullah. Unbeaten in four juvenile starts, including three group races, Queen's Logic was so impressive in winning the G1 Cheveley Park S. that Timeform rated her 125, just two pounds below the all-conquering Johannesburg. Although Queen's Logic kept her unbeaten record intact on her reappearance in 2002, a series of problems forced her retirement. She is being given every chance as a broodmare, her first three foals being by Machiavellian, Kingmambo and Elusive Quality. She is now in foal to Rahy.

Lagrion, meanwhile, continued to visit low-priced stallions, such as Titus Livius in 1999 and General Monash a year later. But Queen's Logic's heroics in 2001 demanded that Lagrion move upmarket and she visited Danehill in 2002. Lagrion was listed as still being owned by Kip McCreery when she was covered, but she must have changed hands while she was pregnant, as Dylan Thomas is credited to Tower Bloodstock, who also bred Lagrion's 2005 Sadler's Wells filly (and Holy Roman Emperor).

It can't have been too difficult to choose Danehill as a mate for Lagrion, a daughter of Diesis. For a start, he is a son of Danzig, whereas Lagrion's exceptional daughter Queen's Logic was by a grandson of that stallion. Then there was Danehill's record with Sharpen Up line mares to take into account.

At the time, Danehill had 16 foals out of mares by Diesis's outstanding brother Kris and among them were Kissing Cousin (G1 Coronation S.), Ela-Aristokrati (twice second at Group 3 level) and Massarra (second in the G2 Prix Robert Papin). Danehill had also done very well with his comparatively small collection of foals out of mares by Sharpen Up, the sire of Diesis and Kris. Among them were the dual Group 1 winner Danehill Dancer and the dual German Group 3 winner Street Poker. Danehill even sired the Australian Group 2 winner Royal Voyage from a mare by Keen, another brother to Diesis and Kris.

The one weak link at the time was Danehill's record with daughters of Diesis himself, which stood at zero stakes winners from 14 foals. However, that record rapidly improved when Firth of Lorne was second to Zenda in the 2002 French 1,000 Guineas. Other representatives of this nick include Dr More, runner-up at Group 1 level in Hong Kong, and an Australian Listed winner.

It was a little surprising that Lagrion never tackled less than 1½ miles. Her brother Pure Genius had been a good six-furlong performer at two in 1989, when he finished second at odds-on in the G1 Middle Park S., and Pure Genius was later beaten only six lengths in the 2000 Guineas.

The idea of sending Dylan Thomas's second dam Wrap It Up to Diesis stemmed from the success that Wrap It Up's half sister Gift Wrapped had enjoyed with Diesis' brother Kris. Kris's first mating with Gift Wrapped resulted in Reach, winner of the G2 Royal Lodge S. in 1984, and the second produced Wrapping, who failed by only a head to win the G1 Oaks d'Italia over 1½ miles.

Wrapping went on to become the dam of Papering, a Group 1 runner-up in the Yorkshire Oaks and Prix Vermeille. Papering, like Dylan Thomas, was by a son of Danzig, her sire being Shaadi. As Papering stayed a mile and a half well, it isn't too surprising that Dylan Thomas is developing into a major force over Europe's classic distance.


