Freshened after finishing fifth in the Oct. 29 GI Breeders' Cup Turf, **English Channel** was able to sit off hon-



est fractions in his first two starts this season, winning the Mar. 11 Canadian Turf H. at Gulfstream by 3/4 of a length over Miesque's Approval and besting **Cacique** by a half-length in the May 6 Gl Woodford Reserve Turf Classic at Churchill Downs. Looking to rebound from his

loss in the Manhattan, the chestnut colt settled in fourth as Shake the Bank (Sandpit {Brz}), the rabbit for defending U.N. champ Better Talk Now (Talkin Man), cut out six furlongs in a solid 1:11.92 and a mile in 1:36. The 84-1 pacesetter threw in the towel on the far turn, but English Channel was poised to strike, driving to the front as they straightened for home. He was joined by Cacique as they raced down the lane, but refused to budge and was edging away at the finish. "I was a little bit concerned on the first turn, because he was a little bit rank," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "But by the time they had gone by the stands for the first time, he had settled in. He dropped his head and I knew he was fine." Pletcher added that the four-year-old will be pointed for either the Aug. 12 GI Arlington Million, or the GI Sword Dancer Invitational H. at Saratoga the same afternoon. Relaxed Gesture, the crowd's 19-10 chalk, closed from fifth to be third while never threatening the top two. Better Talk Now couldn't take advantage of the early fractions set by his stablemate. 

ASMUSSEN TO START SUSPENSION MONDAY


Steve Asmussen, currently the second-leading trainer in North America, has decided not to go to court to contest the six-month suspension he was handed by the Louisiana Racing Commission. Asmussen was suspended after No End In Sight tested positive for the local anesthetic mepivicaine following an off-the-board finish at Evangeline Downs Mar. 24. He appealed the decision when it was issued in May, but the original ban was upheld by the Commission June 23 and, although he denies that the administration of the medication was authorized by either himself or his staff, Asmussen will begin serving the suspension Monday. He will not be eligible for relicensing until January, 2007. "The majority of the owners have decided to turn their horses over to Scott Blasi [Asmussen's assistant at Churchill] at this point," the conditioner told Daily Racing Form. "He has a long-standing relationship with the owners and is capable of doing an excellent job." Asmussen still faces a six-month suspension based on a positive test for acepromizine in New Mexico, but that case has not yet been heard by the state racing commission.

PROUD TOWER TOO DONE FOR YEAR Proud Tower Too (Proud Irish), winner of the GI Malibu S. and, most recently, the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen S. Mar. 25, had a bone chip removed from an ankle Thursday and will be out for the remainder of the season, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "He did it two weeks ago when he had his first work back," trainer Sal Gonzalez told *DRF*. "He'll be out four months and we'll have to start all over. It happens." Proud Tower Too worked four furlongs at Hollywood in :48.80 June 24. **BROTHER DEREK TO MISS HASKELL Brother Derek** (Benchmark), fourth in the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S., will be forced to miss the Aug. 6 GI Haskell Invitational H. due to a fever, *Daily Racing Form* reports. "He spiked a small temperature, probably some kind of virus," trainer Dan Hendricks told *DRF*. "He had an elevated white blood count. We got backed up. We won't start working for a couple of weeks--we won't make the Haskell." Hendricks added that the colt has yet to go back to the track. While his next start is up in the air, he could be pointed for the Sept. 2 El Cajon S. at Del Mar and possibly the Sept. 23 GII Super Derby at Louisiana Downs.


