JRHA SALE BEGINS

The Japan Racing Horse Association's annual Select Sale gets underway Monday at Northern Horse Park on Hokkaido. The sale, which had featured foals selling at their dams' sides over the course of two days, has been expanded to include a select session of yearlings. A total of 170 yearlings have been catalogued for Monday's opening session, followed by 316 foals slated to sell Tuesday and Wednesday. A number of top runners have emerged from the sale since its inception in 1998, including Admire Groove (Jpn), Hat Trick (Jpn), King Kamehameha (Jpn), Sundrop (Jpn), Utopia (Jpn) and Zenno Rob Roy (Jpn). But top billing among the sale's graduates goes to the appropriately named 2005 Japanese Horse of the Year Deep Impact (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), who sold for ¥70,000,000 in 2002. The fouryear-old recently added the G1 Takarazuka Kinen to his trophy case and is now slated to embark on a European campaign that will culminate in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. There's no sibling to the champion selling this year, but Deep Impact's graded-stakes winning half-sister Veil of Avalon (Thunder Gulch) does have a yearling colt by top British sire Pivotal (GB) catalogued as hip 60. Buyers will have a chance to buy yearlings from the first crops of a top group of performers, including Agnes Digital, Aldebaran, Falbrav (Ire), Gold Allure (Jpn), Grandera (Ire), Mineshaft, Moon Ballad (Ire), Sky Mesa and Symboli Kris S. Stallions whose first foals are just now coming on the market include Japanese stars King Kamehaha (Jpn) and Neo Universe (Jpn), as well as U.S. champion Smarty Jones and Australian standout Exceed and Excel (Aus). The record price for the sale is ¥490 million (\$4,537,037) for a Dance in the Dark (Jpn)--Air Groove (Jpn) colt sold in 2004. Hip Happenings p3

Runner-up in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud in October, Stormy River (Fr) (Verglas {Ire}) returned to take the Listed Prix Djebel at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 4 and G3 Prix de Fontainebleau 19 days later at Longchamp. Despite returning there as the hot favorite for the May 14 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains, he ran with the choke out and was a target in front for the Ballydoyle duo Aussie Rules and Marcus Andronicus late on. Last time in the June 20 G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot, he did himself no favors by struggling to stay with the pace and was doing all his best work at the finish when runner-up to Araafa (Ire). "I don't know why he was so cold at Ascot, but he could not keep up with the pace and still ran a great race," said trainer Nicolas Clement. "He has confirmed all his quality today and, having been on the go all season, deserves a break now. Rather than go for the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois [at Deauville Aug. 13], I'll probably bring him back fresh for the [Sept. 3] G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp." HUMA PARK TO BE SOLD

Huma Park Stud is to be put on the market, it was announced yesterday. Since being set up by Hubie de Burgh and Marc de Chambure four years ago, the County Kildare operation has acquired multiple Group 1 winner Rakti (GB) (Polish Precedent--Ragera {Ire}, by Rainbow Quest) and 2002 G1 Prix Morny winner Elusive City (Elusive Quality--Star of Paris, by Dayjur). However, difficulty in acquiring new stallion prospects was cited as a factor in the decision to sell the state-ofthe-art facility incorporating 254 acres, 100 boxes and a capacity for at least four stallions. The stud will be offered for sale in September by Maynooth-based W A Coonan Auctioneers, while no decision has been taken on the future of Rakti and Elusive City. "This is a not a decision we have taken lightly, we built Huma Park as a stallion farm and had hoped to stand a minimum of four stallions and expand from there," de Burgh explained. "We have two excellent Group 1 performers in Elusive City and Rakti, but we have found it increasingly difficult to gain access to the stallions we desire and are therefore unable to participate at the level we feel is needed in the ever increasingly competitive stallion market."
