Trainer Shug McGaughey has won the GI Coaching Club American Oaks on a pair of occasions, sending out My Flag in 1996 before winning the race last year with the Phipps Stables' subsequent champion Smuggler.

Pine Island (Arch) gets a chance to prove she belongs in that company and will take her fair share of beating in this afternoon's 10-furlong feature. Produced by a full sister to MGSW Country Hideaway and reigning Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine Pleasant Home, Pine Island kicked

off her career on the turf, returning nearly \$60 in winning her maiden at Gulfstream Mar. 9. An 8-1 chance in her entry-level allowance test rained off the turf June 8, she powered away to score by 5 1/2 lengths, earning a spot in the July 1 GI Mother Goose S., where she came flying late to miss by 3/4 of a length to Bushfire. McGaughey, not one to rush lightly raced horses into stakes company, felt it was the right thing to do. "I thought she was probably okay with those fillies," the conditioner commented. "I was kind of hoping Bushfire would bounce off the Acorn. I'm not too sure had we not gotten away better and someone carried [Bushfire] along a little bit further that we couldn't have been more competitive with her." Though the divisional leader is passing on this event in favor of the GI Alabama S. Aug. 19, GI Kentucky Oaks upsetter Lemons

Forever (Lemon Drop Kid) is a legitimate threat. An even fifth as a lukewarm favorite in the Mother Goose, trainer Dallas Stewart continues on undaunted. "She just didn't run her race. No excuses," he admitted. "She's been training so well it would be hard to deny her a chance to run in a race like the Coaching Club. I

Opposing her are graded stakes winners Memorette, Moscow Burning, Island Fashion and Katdogawn as well as Live Life, a valiant runner-up in the GII Beverly Hills H. after dueling through hot fractions June 24 at Hollywood. That contest marked the U.S. stakes bow for the grey, who had been Group 3-placed in France last summer.

up isn't ideal for his charge.
"The distance [1 1/16 miles] is okay, but the pace is the main thing," he told *Daily Racing Form*. "We need a good finish."

Spellbinder, the winner of the GII San Antonio H. Feb. 5 who also carries the same green and pink silks as Giacomo, is the only confirmed front-runner in

this field. The five-year-old ran second in the GII Mervyn LeRoy H. May 13 before weakening to be sixth in the GII Californian S. June 17 at Hollywood. While most of his contemporaries are now represented by runners, **Publication** has embarked on yet another phase of his racing career. Fourth in Johannesburg's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, the GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity hero had a forgettable sophomore season in 2002, but hit the board in each of his six starts at four and five, including a head loss in the GI Triple Bend H in 2003. The gelding was sidelined following a third to subsequent champion Speightstown in the 2004 GII Churchill Downs H. and returned just over two years later to land a seven-furlong optional claimer at Hollywood May 20. "He was a little worn out and had a little bit of wear and tear in his ankles," trainer Vladimir Cerin told *DRF* about the layoff. The fragile seven-yearold rallied from way back to finish fourth in the July 2 renewal of the Triple Bend in his last out.

Trainer Dermot Weld certainly knows his way to the Arlington winner's circle, having saddled Pine Dance (2000), Evolving Tactics (Ire) (2003) and Simple Exhange (Ire) (2004) to victory in this prep for the GI Secretariat S. and Golden Arrow represents the yard this year. The bay, who broke his maiden in a Listed event at first asking last June, was runner-up to George Washington in the G1 National S. in September. Beaten a neck in the G3 Ballysax S. in his seasonal debut in April, he added blinkers to be fifth to Araafa (Ire) in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas May 27, but was a disappointing fourth as the favorite in the Listed Celebration S. at The Curragh July 2. Regular rider Pat Smullen makes the trans-Atlantic journey. Kingship took the GIII American Derby in wire-to-wire fashion July 1, but faces a tougher task on the front end in the shape of GII Jefferson Cup runner-up Tahoe Warrior, who makes his first start for George Weaver. Outperformance, winner of the June 9 GIII Hill Prince S. and a respectable fifth in the Colonial Turf Cup 15 days later, must overcome the 14 hole this afternoon.

GENTLEWAVE OUT REST OF YEAR Gary Tanaka's G1 Derby Italiano hero Gentlewave (Ire) (Monsun {Ger}) will not race again this season after suffering a tendon injury. "We are not sure whether it is definitively career ending, but any time this kind of problem is involved, that has to be a possibility," said Lincoln Collins, racing manager to Tanaka. Deemed by Paris-Turf "the best performer of three-year-olds trained in France," the colt was supplemented to the Italian Classic following his victory in the G2 Prix Noialles at Longchamp Apr. 17. Valenzuela Could Be Sidelined Through Meet:

Top jockey Patrick Valenzuela faces the prospect of being out of action for the entire Del Mar meeting and

Tom Knust, Valenzuela's agent, said Thursday morning that the veteran rider is suffering from serious back pain which first surfaced during the Santa Anita meet over the winter and cropped up again at Hollywood Park this spring. Valenzuela was excused from his commitments on Wednesday's opening-day program and took off mounts on Thursday and Friday. He was expected to visit a doctor Thursday and depending on the diagnosis, either a period of rest or surgery could be indicated. In

Valenzuela's absence, Knust will carry Corey Nakatani's book, but would book mounts for both riders upon Valenzuela's return.

CHRB Considers Safety Issues at Meeting:

The California Horse Racing Board commenced public discussions Thursday in compliance with a new law (AB 1180), designed to safeguard the safety of jockeys riding in the state. The Board is considering mandating the use of safety reins, essentially a rein--made of nylon cord--within a rein which would allow a jockey or harness driver the ability to control their horse in the case the leather rein were to fail. The safety rein would add about \$15 to the cost of manufacturing reins. Darrell Haire, interim manager of the Jockey's Guild, says that the organization "strongly supports" the requirement of safety reins. Another section of AB 1180 concerns itself with the reporting of on-track accidents and seeks to expand stewards' responsibilities to include a more thorough investigation of on-track incidents and fully report their findings to the Jockey's Guild and others who have an interest in the matter. In a discussion unrelated to AB 1180, the Board revisited the issue of safety vests, required to be worn by all jockeys and riders when exercising a horse or competing in a race. That regulation, the Board said, is out of date and a proposed amendment would establish new standards and afford increased protection. The Board also approved the race meeting at the Fairplex for Sept. 8 to Sept. 25. Fairplex President James Henwood said that a purse increase of five percent would be in place for the meet owing to a financial windfall from the recordbreaking meeting a year ago.
