Deutsches Derby cont.

Aspectus captured the premier trial, the July 2 G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen at Cologne, and is in the driver's seat for the 137th renewal of this Classic. He had Lauro, Oriental Tiger and Imonso behind last time, and made up for his sole disappointment when down the field in the June 4 G1 Prix du Jockey-Club. Prior to that, his climb to prominence was text book by German standards. He won the G3 Preis des Winterfavoriten at Cologne in October before returning to annex the G3 Dr Busch-Memorial at Krefeld Apr. 23. The colt may have found the mile of the G2 Mehl-Mulhens-Rennen (German 2000 Guineas) too short when a highly creditable head runner-up to Royal Power (Ire) May 14, and is more at home over middle distances. Schiaparelli has this race in his blood and bids to emulate his brother Samum (Ger), who dominated the 2000 edition. He has taken an unorthodox route to the race, having already encoutered his elders when runner-up in the G1 Deutschland-Preis at Dusseldorf June 25. That effort confirmed the impression that he is one of his country's leading three-year-olds, suggested by his score in the Listed Grosser Preis der Hannoverschen Volksbank at Hannover June 5. He forms a three-pronged attack from the Peter Schiergen stable successful with Boreal (Ger) five years ago. His stable companions are Lauro, who took the Listed Prix de l'Avre at Longchamp May 31 before his second to Aspectus in Cologne, and Imonso. The latter relished the soft conditions when beating Dark Dancer and subsequent G3 Hamburger-Meile scorer Lateral (Ger) in convincing style in the June 5 G3 Bavarian Classic at Munich, but was undone on quicker ground when fourth in the Oppenheim-Union-Rennen. Trainer Peter Rau captured this prize in 1996 with Lavirco (Ger) and relies on Saddex, who booked his ticket here with an impressive success in the Listed Derby-Trial at Bremen July 9.

First or second in all five U.S. starts, Aragorn looks to add to his impressive resume as he stretches out to nine furlongs. The chestnut colt captured his only other start at the Eddie Read trip, taking the GII Oak Tree Derby by a nose last October. Second in both the Mar. 4 GI Frank Kilroe H. and Apr. 29 GII San Francisco BC Mile S. to start 2006, he comes off a 1 3/4-length tally in the May 29 GI Shoemaker BC Mile S. at Hollywood. Third in this race two years ago, Sweet Return wired the field in the 2005 edition of this event, but has been off the board in all five starts since. The sixyear-old shortens up after finishing fourth behind Lava Man in the 10-furlong GI Charlie Whittingham H. at Hollywood July 2. Although there is no obvious standout in this event, the select line-up is packed with talent. Andre Fabre, who has won three of the last five renewals, gets the services of Christophe Soumillon for Linda's Lad. Last year's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud winner was fourth in the G2 Prix Noailles on his sophomore debut Apr. 17 before winning the G3 Lingfield Derby Trial under a seven-pound penalty May 13. He lost his head in the preliminaries for the June 3 G1 Epsom Derby and failed to land a blow in ninth, but is on a comeback mission here. Multiplex forms the second string to Fabre's bow and defends an unbeaten record, having been promoted to first from second in the G3 Prix la Rochette at Longchamp last September before returning to take the Listed Prix de Saint-Patrick at Deauville last time July 4. He raced too freely early on when fourth in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh July 2 and needs to settle better to show his true worth.
