SCHIAPARELLI BEST IN DEUTSCHES DERBY

Schiaparelli (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) produced a merciless display of galloping to Sunday's G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg. He follows in the steps of his brother Samum (Ger), who tookthe event for the same owner-jockey combination six years ago. Successful at Cologne Apr. 17 and at Hannover May 7, Schiaparelli made it three straight in the Listed Grosser Preis der Hannoverschen Volksbank June 5. Because the German Derby was scheduled to accommodate the World Cup, he took on older horses early and ran with credit to finish runner-up to Donaldson (Ger) in the G1 Deutschland-Preis at Dusseldorf June 25. That experience helped him cope with this crowded and competitive affair and he relaxed when steadied in mid-division by Andrasch Starke early. Creeping closer in the back straight, the chestnut swung wide into the home stretch and took over at the guarter pole. Tackled by Dickens (Ger) (Kallisto {Ger}) in the closing stages, he was always holding that rival and was the comfortable winner at the line. Schiaparelli, who was purchased out of the paddocks as a foal by Stall Blankenese's Franz Gunther von Gaertner, marks the third German Derby winner for Monsun, following Samum and Shirocco (Ger). chart p2

SOARING TO VICTORY

Sky Conqueror (Sky Classic) appeared to have too great a task in catchingthe free-running Last Answer (Langfuhr) in the final sixteenth of yesterday's GII Northern Dancer Breeders' Cup H. at Woodbine, but he proved that he was up to the task. The bay collared that foe late and inched clear to record his second graded-stakes victory of the year. Content to settle off the slow early fractions carved out by Last Answer, who was barreling along over the rain-soaked turf while more than eight lengths in the lead, Sky Conqueror slowly closed the margin on that rival and soon had the lead in his sights. Full of run late, the four-year-old gradually wore down the game front-runner. "I was really concerned. I wasn't willing to spot any horse that much ground, especially on this turf course," said Kabel, who won the last six Woodbine stakes in which he has competed. "My horse came up big." cont. p2



MEETING HELD AT DEL MAR OVER

Del Mar track management held an informal meeting the morning of July 22 to address the spike in injuries and fatal breakdowns during the first days of the seaside oval's summer season.

The meeting included several trainers and representatives from the Thoroughbred Owners of California, as well as the California Horse Racing Board's chairman Richard Shapiro.

The group met informally in an effort to calm the concerns raised by both horsemen and racing fans since the seven-week season got underway on July 19. Unofficially, seven horses have been injured in the three racing days since the season began, with four euthanized. Of the four euthanizations, three occurred in the afternoon.

"We all have the same concerns," said Joe Harper, Del Mar president and general manager. "Safety is the number one issue at Del Mar. Unfortunately the majority of catastrophic injuries are an accumulation over time, but we still need to identify the issues we need to be dealing with." For the complete story, click <u>here</u>.
