### GIVING THEM THE RUNAROUND AT ASCOT

It looked unlikely on the home turn, but Michael Tabor's Hurricane Run (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) rescued victory from the jaws of defeat to win a memorable renewal of the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S.

at Ascot yesterday. Electrocutionist (Red Ransom) was the first into gear, ranging up to join pacemaker Cherry Mix (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}) with a half mile to race. But Christophe Soumillon went to work, energizing Hurricane Run as they raced down the straight, and the 5-6 favorite came through along the rail to wear down Electrocutionist for a hard-fought half-length score. It was another half-length back to Heart's Cry (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), who stayed on gamely on the out-

side. "I thought [Hurricane Run] was floundering, but Christophe galvanized him and got him going again and I was kind of mesmerized," Tabor commented. King George cont. p2

The weather was stifling in Saratoga Springs yesterday, but that didn't stop Bernardini (A.P. Indy). Sent off

the 1-2 favorite in the GII Jim Dandy S., the Darley homebred just cruised around the sloppy racetrack, winning by nine lengths under a motionless Javier Castellano. "I was worried about saving him for the Travers [G]. Aug. 26]," Castellano said. "I didn't want to beat him up. At the top of the stretch, I could hear everyone trying to come after me. I decided to wait as long as I

### TOUR DE FORCE

Take D'Tour (Tour d'Or) didn't look like an Eclipse contender at the start of the season. The free-running

five-year-old opened 2006 with an uninspiring sixth-place finish in a minor stakes at Tampa Bay Downs, and was sent off at 8-1 facing Gulfstream allowance foes next time out. But the chestnut mare powered to a four-length success that afternoon and has been unbeatable since, adding a 10-length victory at Gulfstream

in April before back-to-back 5 1/2-length triumphs in the May 21 GII Shuvee H. and June 17 GI Ogden Phipps H. Bidding for her fifth straight, she will be asked to carry her speed around two turns and beyond a mile and a sixteenth for the first time in the GI Go for Wand H. at Saratoga today. Can she do it? Trainer David Fawkes is convinced she can, if, he told Daily Racing Form, "she gets settled enough in the first turn where she's comfortable, that's all. ## King George cont. Together Again...

Christophe Soumillon last partnered Hurricane Run when the imposing colt was a fast-finishing neck runner-up to Shamardal in the 2005 G1 Prix du Jockey-Club. Kieren Fallon took over thereafter, winning the G1 Irish Derby and the G2 Prix Niel. Fallon earned plaudits for his enterprising ride to thread through the inside and win the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, and he resumed the connection with an all-the-way success on Hurricane Run's four-year-old bow in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup back at The Curragh May 28. Caught on the line by Pride (Fr) in the June 25 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud, Andre Fabre's flagbearer had a reputation to regain here and, in the absence of the banned Fallon, it was the reigning French champion who was handed the responsibility. Stalking Cherry Mix throughout, he was being ridden on the turn as Frankie Dettori took Electrocutionist to the front. Responding to the pressure, the crowd's choice ground his way to victory in the final 50 yards. "I loved the position he was in and then he just floundered for some reason," Michael Tabor continued. "When Frankie went past him I was worried, but it was great to see him come again. It's very sad for Kieren and it's very sad for us--as good a jockey as Christophe is, Kieren is our retained jockey. It's sad, but that's the way it is." Soumillon revealed that he was in no panic at the top of the straight. "I didn't want to make my move early and, when I saw Frankie coming, my only option was to sit back and wait on the inside and hope for room," he said. "I think this horse is really special to come back like he did with true Group 1 horses in front. He's just wonderful. It's the biggest race in the world." Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford was pleased with the run of Electrocutionist, who was stiff when led out on the morning of the race. "He's run his heart out and is a superb horse," Crisford commented. "He tried his best and gave absolutely everything he had, but found one too good for him on the day. Angara hadn't won a race since taking the GI Beverly D. S. last August, but she ended the drought in celebration of trainer Bill Mott's 53rd birthday. Off the board in four starts after her Grade I triumph, the bay improved to be third in the May 27 GII Sheepshead Bay H. and was beaten just a neck when second in the June 24 GII New York BC H. going 10 panels at Belmont Park. Allowed to settle off the solid fractions set by stablemate My Typhoon (Giant's Causeway), Angara was still next to last while caught behind horses at the top of the lane, but fought her way through the crowd to take the three-way photo for the win. Lady of Venice (Loup Solitaire), off at even-money, was wide throughout and finished fifth, beaten less than two lengths. "She didn't get beat far," said trainer Patrick Biancone, who trained Angara before she joined the Mott stable. "She showed she's a contender with the best older fillies." Unchallenged since finishing fourth in his career opener at Gulfstream in January, Bernardini enjoyed his easiest win to date here. The imposing bay broke his maiden by 7 3/4 lengths in his second start Mar. 4, then hit the line 3 3/4 lengths to the good in the Apr. 29 GIII Withers S. even after jockey Javier Castellano dropped his whip. His performance in the May 20 GI Preakness S. was overshadowed by the injury to Kentucky Derby hero Barbaro, but that 5 1/4length score--in his first try at two turns--earned retroactive respect and he was odds-on to repeat in the Jim Dandy. Sent right to the front as he tried out a sloppy strip for the first time, Bernardini galloped along through solid splits and was under his own steam as he opened up on his overmatched rivals. "I've been saying all along how good this horse is," Tom Albertrani said. "I think we are going to see better things from this horse later on. I don't think we are going to be fearing anyone in the Travers. If he stays at this level, he is going to be a very tough horse all year." Ryan Moore kept it simple on Best Alibi and those tactics paid dividends as the sophomore made a successful first foray into all-aged company. Fourth in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster in October, he returned to finish eight lengths behind Septimus (Ire) when runner-up in the G2 Dante S. over course and distance May 18, tiring in the rain-softened ground. Sixth in the June 3 G1 Epsom Derby, he showed he had progressed in the interim when third behind Dylan Thomas (Ire) in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh last time July 2. Soon in front here, he had to be kept up to his work in the closing stages as Hattan threatened, but answered every call to record an ultimately comfortable score. "I think he was getting a bit fed up in front, but once the other horse got to his quarters, he went again," the owner's Racing Manager Bruce Raymond told PA Sport. "I don't think Ryan [Moore] was anxious at all. He was by far the best horse in there and something would have to have been wrong with him to get beaten. She did it well and is tough and very consistent. She's very versatile trip-wise and ground-wise." 

Heliostatic completed a memorable stakes treble for his connections, following the exploits of Teofilo (Ire) in the Listed Tyros S. and Gaudeamus in the G2 Debutante S. earlier on the card. He had looked a Classic contender in the spring when second in the Apr. 15 G3 Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial S., but disappointed upon his return here when down the field in the May 14 G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial. Off the board again in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh 13 days later, he enjoyed a class drop when winning the Listed Silver S. back at The Curragh June 10 before a tilt at the G1 Irish Derby there July 2. He was enterprisingly ridden in that Classic, making the running before finishing a creditable seventh. The same tactics were adopted here; the chestnut led at every step and held sway late over Lord Admiral. "This is probably his best trip," winning rider Kevin Manning explained. 
### **MULLINS AWAITS SPLIT-SAMPLE RESULTS: BARNS SEARCHED**

by Margaret Ransom, courtesy of bloodhorse.com. Trainer Jeff Mullins said he was informed by the California Horse Racing Board that one of the horses in his care, Robs Coin, tested positive for a prohibited amount of the anesthetic mepivacaine, and that he is awaiting the results of split-sample tests. Robs Coin finished second in a \$40,000 claiming race at a mile on the turf July 8 at Hollywood Park. The 43-year-old conditioner, who was the leading trainer at the recently concluded Hollywood Park meet, said he was informed of the positive when CHRB investigators arrived to search his Del Mar barn. "I was [notified of the overage] when they searched the barn [July 27]," Mullins said. "They searched both of my barns--here and at Santa Anita." Mullins said he was shocked by the post-race test, which he said revealed the presence of 30 nanograms of mepivacaine per milliliter of urine on Robs Coin. California regulations allow up to 10 nanograms per milliliter on race day. "[Robs Coin] never even needed ice," Mullins said. "He never had a joint tapped or injected. We had him for three races and he never had anything except Bute and Lasix." CHRB officials couldn't be immediately reached for comment on the matter. Mullins said his attorney, Neil Papiano, would handle the case, but that if he's not vindicated,

HRA KEEPS EYE ON SWAMP FEVER Ireland's current outbreak of "swamp fever" could have an impact on the movement of horses to Britain, but the Horseracing Regulatory Authority is not forecasting an imminent ban at present. With 12 cases of equine infectious anemia confirmed in Ireland, HRA's Chief Executive Peter Webbon is keeping a watching brief on the situation. "I think we're a long way away from a ban, but we may find it necessary to impose some sort of restrictions," he commented. "For example, we may require horses to be tested or to come with some sort of veterinary declaration." Ireland's Department of Agriculture and Food has issued a statement advising stud and horse owners to test for the viral disease. "In view of the potential for mortality, and given the high movement of horses throughout Ireland over the past few months, horse owners are being advised to be vigilant," it read. "The general incubation period for the disease is variable and there is no vaccine available."
