STEWARDS SAY CROSBY STAYS GOLD

Pure as Gold (Stolen Gold), claimed for \$100,000 out of a runner-up effort at Hollywood June 14, paid quick dividends for his new connections with a controversial victory in yesterday's GI Bing Crosby H. at Del Mar. Sent off at 23-1, the chestnut gelding with Jon Court aboard was the longest shot on the board. He contested the early fractions of :21.62 and :44.18 before inching clear in upper stretch and outfinishing Bordonaro (Memo {Chi}) for a half-length victory. But the intrigue didn't stop there. Jockey Alex Solis, aboard Bordonaro, claimed foul against the winner and replays of the stretch run clearly showed Court accidently striking the runner-up across the face with his whip. After a lengthy review, the stewards upheld the order of finish. "It wasn't a matter of I thought he might have hit my horse," explained Solis. "I was sure he hit my horse. I wouldn't have claimed foul otherwise. Jon didn't do that on purpose. But my horse was intimidated by what happened. He turned his head when it happened and then he was watching that other horse all the way through the stretch. He kept looking at him and he wasn't giving me all he had. But I know it was one of those things. It was horse racing." Cont. p2

The late scratch of G1 Falmouth S. winner Rajeem (GB) (Diktat {GB}) took some quality from yesterday's G1 Prix d'Astarte, but the Deauville race produced a fluent winner in Aga Khan homebred Mandesha (Fr) (Desert Style {Ire}). Mandesha was reserved towards the rear off the even early fractions by jockey Christophe Soumillon before challenging up the stands' side passing the quarter pole. Impressionnante (GB) (Danehill) looked to have the contest won in the centre under Olivier Peslier's drive, but Mandesha found an extra gear and rolled by in the final 100 yards. Saeed Manana's Rajeem (GB) will tackle next Saturday's G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood after missing yesterday's race with an infection. Trainer Clive Brittain discovered the infection in the G1 Falmouth S. winner's off-fore heel Saturday morning, but reported the three-year-old on course for the 10-furlong Nassau after making a quick recovery. Spun Sugar (Awesome Again), winner of last year's GII Black Eyed Susan S., proved her gameness earlier this season when she outbattled Happy Ticket to win the Apr. 8 GI Apple Blossom H. She was fourth behind Take d'Tour as the even-money choice in the June 17 GI Ogden Phipps H. "She was never happy in her last race," Pletcher said of that defeat. "I think she's a better filly around two turns and she showed what she's all about today." The Go For Wand marked a resurgence for Balletto (UAE) (Timber Country), who was second in the 2004 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, but missed all of 2005. She was well-beaten by Take d'Tour in all three prior starts this term, running second in the May 21 GII Shuvee H. and third in the Ogden Phipps. "She came back like her old self and ran with a lot of determination," trainer Tom Albertrani said of the runner-up. "She ran her heart out. It just came down to the bob at the wire." Pletcher also trains favored Oonagh Maccool (Ire) (Giant's Causeway), who faded to last after chasing the early pace. "[Oonagh Maccool's race] was disappointing," Pletcher admitted.
