Few matches turn out the way they were planned, but yesterday's G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood was textbook as the high-class mares Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross (Ire) and Alexander Goldrun (Ire) (Gold Away {Ire}) battled out the finish, with Ouija Board barely an inch better off at the line. Lord Derby's five-year-old had the support of the nation behind her and the evenmoney pick needed all of her popularity to ward off Noel and Miriam O'Callaghan's raider, who headed her for a large part of the final quarter. Regaining the edge in the pulsating final drive, it was a short-head verdict for Ouija Board's. "It was a great horse race and full credit to the runner-up--between them they've won 10 Group 1s, which is phenomenal for mares," trainer Ed Dunlop said. Oujia Board Wins Nassau (cont. from p1)

Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) has endeared herself to her country with shows of bravado and class at home and abroad, displaying a high level of consistency at the top level that began with an impressive success in the G1 Epsom Oaks in June 2004. Adding the G1 Irish Oaks and GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf to her tally on either side of a third in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, she rescued her four-year-old season from the doldrums to finish runner-up in the Filly and Mare Turf and win the G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin in December. After placings in the Mar. 25 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba, Apr. 23 G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup back at Sha Tin and G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 2, she returned to her best to deny Electrocutionist in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 21 and was badly baulked when fifth in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown last time July 8. Racing closer to the pace than usual here, she took over traveling strongly with 2½ furlongs remaining before being tackled and passed by Alexander Goldrun (Ire) (Gold Away {Ire}) and Kevin Manning out wide. As the pair locked into battle, it was touch and go to the line, where Ouija Board carved out a slim margin. "We knew she'd won over a mile and a half, so we couldn't afford to sit and sprint with some good milers, but she was in front a long way out," Frankie Dettori explained. "The other mare went by me and Ouija Board likes a target, so she put her head down when it really mattered. Both fillies dug all the way to the line and she's got great guts. She's a special filly--one of the all-time favorite horses in England and one of a kind." Dunlop was putting plans on hold yesterday. "We've had plans for her all year and broken them all and we weren't even considering this race before," he said. "She's had a hard race, so we'll take her home, see how she is and take it from there." Alexander Goldrun's trainer Jim Bolger was not downcast afterwards, saying, "I was very happy with the run. I always knew it would be tight and it was on the bob. The ground was not a problem, that is not an excuse. The intended target is the G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 9]." 



Invasor opened his career with five straight wins, earning him championship honors in Uruguay. He took his show on the road to Dubai, where he finished fourth behind Discreet Cat in the Mar. 25 G2 UAE Derby. Shipped to the U.S. barn of Kiaran McLaughlin after that effort, the colt quickly proved he was legit with a 1 1/4-length victory in the May 19 GI Pimlico Special. He powered to a 4 1/4-length victory in the July GI Suburban H. and was looking for his third straight Grade I win here. Second choice in the field of nine. Invasor stumbled at the break, but recovered to run a stalking fourth. He rallied inside of favored Flower Alley (Distorted Humor) turning for home, forced that rival wide while angling out for running room in the stretch and took over with a furlong to run before gamely holding off the late charge of Sun King. "It makes us trainers and jockeys look good when you have a horse like this," said McLaughlin. McLaughlin did admit to some anxious moments. "I was worried at the eighth pole," he said. "We had been in a fight throughout and Sun King came to us. We were in a dogfight; it was a great race. Today, he dug in and showed a great desire to win. I thought we had won, but I had to watch it over again. Two more wins and we might have Uruguay's Horse of the Year and America's Horse of the Year." Asked what might be next for Invasor, McLaughlin said, "We're not sure about the Woodward or the Jockey Club Gold Cup. [Owner] Sheikh Hamdan [bin Rashid al Maktoum] asked to run him once more before the Breeders' Cup [Nov. 4 at Churchill]." Sun King added this heartbreaking loss to his narrow defeat in the GI Met Mile. "Coming down the stretch, we were getting closer to Invasor," explained jockey Rafael Bejarano. "I knew we were ahead at one point and at the wire, I thought we had the race won. Sun King has a lot of heart, but Invasor is a tough horse." She established herself as one of the leading domestic juvenile fillies last term, finishing runner-up to Confidential Lady (GB) in the G3 Prix du Calvados here in August and to Rumplestiltskin (Ire) in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac in October. Capped by a success in the G3 Prix Miesque at Maisons-Laffitte the following month, she returned to finish runner-up to Daltaya (Fr) in the G3 Prix de la Grotte on her last outing Apr. 23. Like **New Girlfriend**, who hails from the Robert Colet barn successful with Whipper 12 months ago, she is attempting to re-establish her juvenile reputation. The latter, who looked impressive when winning the G2 Prix Robert Papin last July, appeared not to stay a mile when sixth in the May 14 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp and third behind Impressionnante (GB) in the G2 Prix de Sandringham at Chantilly June 4. "I've thought that the 1300 meters of this would suit her perfectly," her trainer told Paris-Turf. "Christophe Soumillon worked her on the track and she is very well." Somnus, who took advantage of heavy overnight rain to win this two years ago, was down the field in last year's renewal and has questions to answer. He had Kodiac back in third when enjoying a confidenceboosting win in a Haydock conditions event July 8 and heads a powerful British raiding party. Included in that crew is Amadeus Wolf, who has yet to grace the winner's spot this term after a profitable two-year-old campaign which featured wins in the G2 Gimcrack S. at York in August and the G1 Middle Park S.



Stewards to Get a Closer Look:

In the wake of last week's controversial finish to the GI Bing Crosby H., Del Mar stewards will now have access to TVG's two isolated-camera views during weekend races at the track. "TVG uses two isolated cameras during the weekend races here and we now have access to those feeds," explained steward Scott Chaney. "We won't be watching TVG, but we do have access to those feeds if we need it. We in no way choose the horses that they decide to isolate on, but if we feel we need them, we can view the film."
