Juddmonte Farms' Cacique (Ire) (Danehill) and James Scatuorchio's English Channel (Smart Strike) lock horns for the fourth consecutive time in today's GI Arlington

Million. English Channel has gotten the best of that rival in two out of those meetings, taking the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic S. at Churchill May 6 and the GI United Nations S. at Monmouth July 8. Cacique, trained by Bobby Frankel, was second best on both of those occasions, but had his moment in the sun on Belmont S. day, notching the GI Manhattan H. by a head, with

English Channel back in fourth. "You always want more," Frankel commented. "We'd like to get another Grade I with him [today]. He's the kind of horse who gets away from the gate well. We'll see how he breaks, and if the early pace is slow, he'll be near the front, and if the pace is fast, he'll be farther back. Edgar [Prado] will make that decision." English Channel makes his second start over the Arlington lawn after completing the exacta as the 4-5 chalk in last year's GI Secretariat S. "I really don't think that was Arlington or him not liking the turf," trainer Todd Pletcher told Daily Racing Form. "I think it was more the trip he got." As for Cacique, Pletcher added, "He was a better horse than Cacique at a mile and an eighth, and he was a better horse at a mile and three eighths. But these horses are very competitively matched." The top two will have their work cut out for them, with the ageless The Tin Man (Affirmed) and Better Talk Now (Talkin Man) standing in their way. The Tin Man resurfaced from the bench in top form, winning the GII San Marcos S. Jan. 22, finishing second in the G1 Dubai Duty Free S. Mar. 25 and scoring in the GII American Invitational H. last out July 2. Better Talk Now, winner of the 2004 GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Lone Star, has only started twice this season, annexing the GII Dixie S. May 20 and finishing fifth in the U.N.

European Invasion Comes up 'Aces'...

While the home team looks well-represented in the Million, European invaders Ace (Ire) (Danehill), Touch of Land (Fr) (Lando {Ger}), Soldier Holow (GB) (In the Wings {GB}) and Phoenix Reach (Ire) (Alhaarth {Ire}) also rate a big chance. Ace held his own in the U.S. last fall, finishing third in the GI Turf Classic Invitational S. and second in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. He ships in off a runner-up effort in the G3 International S. at the Curragh July 15. Touch of Land, fifth in last season's Million, enters off a victory in the G3 Grand Prix de Vichy July 19. Solider Hollow makes the trip across the pond after a pair of second-place finishes, including the G2 Pferdewetten Trophy last time June 18. Phoenix Reach boasts wins at the highest level in Canada, Hong Kong and Dubai, but may be up against it here, making his first start since placing 10th in the 2005 G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. July 25.

charge who is looking to improve off his runner-up finish in this race last term. Trainer Todd Pletcher sends out two, the free-wheeling Ramazutti and Go Deputy, who had a breakthrough win in his latest. On the board in four straight graded events this winter and spring, including a narrow neck loss in the Gl Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup S., he finally notched that elu-

sive graded win in the July 15, 11-furlong GII Bowling Green H. at Belmont. The six-year-old, who is crossentered in the GI Arlington Million, has some tactical speed and should be able to track a few lengths off his stablemate. "He's consistently right there if the race sets up well for him," said Pletcher. "I think he's better with an honest pace in front of him." With Ramazutti the clear speed in the field, Pletcher doesn't discount his chances, either. "Sometimes, you can get lucky in a race like this with a speed horse," Pletcher said. The unknown in the race is French invader Grand Couturier, who is trained by Jean-Claude Rouget. The three-yearold will be taking on older horses in his U.S. bow, but comes armed with some smart European form. The bay was only a neck back in third in the G2 Prix Noailles in April and, in his most recent start, was fourth beaten 2 1/4 lengths in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp July 14.




