THE TIN MAN COMETH While his contemporaries Monarchos and Point Given claimed the headlines in

2001, **The Tin Man** didn't make it to the races until the fall of his three-year-old season, graduating in his second start at Santa Anita. He reeled through his conditions over the winter, then earned his first graded-stakes win July 4 in the GII American H. After a second in the GII Del Mar H., he landed the GI Clement L. Hirsch Memorial Turf Championship S. and concluded 2002 with a fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Arlington. At

five, the bay won just once, airing in the GII San Luis Obispo H., and finished the year with another fourth in the Breeders' Cup Turf. The Tin Man failed to visit the winner's circle in three 2004 starts, and was sidelined following a fourth in the Clement L. Hirsch in October. The veteran resurfaced 14 months later to take a Santa Anita allowance

Dec. 28, and showed he still had the right stuff by winning the GII San Marcos H. Jan. 22. Sent to Nad al Sheba, he tried to make all in the Mar. 25 G1 Dubai Duty Free and just failed to see off MG1SW David Junior. Mandella gave him ample time to recover, and the eight-year-old returned with a game win in the GII American Invitational H. July 2 at Hollywood.

In the Right Place...

While several fancied contenders banged into one another at the start, The Tin Man came away well from post two and went straight to the lead. Jockey Victor Espinoza sensed there wasn't much opposition early and allowed his mount to gambol along through fractions of :24.75, :50.37 and 1:15.18. He spurted clear after straightening into the lane and had enough left in the tank to deny **Cacique**. "On the first turn I knew the pace was slow," Espinoza explained. "Then, turning for home when no one was coming to me, I knew we were going to win the race. Any time there's a slow pace, he's hard to catch. This was the second easiest win I've ever had--the first was the [2002] Kentucky Derby on War Emblem."



After assuming her customary spot near the back of the pack, Gorella took closer order on the far turn. She was angled out by Julien Leparoux and the race was over as she flew past her rivals and opened up daylight. "She's like a machine," said Leparoux, who won a Grade I race for the first time.

Mulaqat, who rattled up a hat trick of wins over seven furlongs and a mile in minor company last fall, continued his improvement when taking the Listed Newmarket S. up the Rowley Mile on his second run this term May 6. Dropped in at the rear of the field, the bay moved easily on to the heels of the pace-setting Road To Love (Ire) (Fruits Of Love) at the top of the straight. Pulled off the rail to challenge down the centre at the quarter pole, the 25-1 longshot was shoved to the lead one furlong out and two smacks in the final eighth took him clear of Notable Guest. "Once he got a bit of daylight it was just a question of whether he would pick up and he did for hands and heels. Hopefully, he should progress from this," commented successful rider Neil Callan. Stormy River was runner-up in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud in October before returning to best subsequent G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest victor Marchand d'Or (Fr) in the Listed Prix Diebel at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 4. Impressive when winning the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau at Longchamp 19 days later, he was too eager early before finishing third in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains over the same track and trip May 14. Adopting exaggerated hold-up tactics in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 20, he was doing his best work at the finish when runner-up to Araafa (Ire) there, and his late rush worked to maximum effect when cutting down Viktor Timoshenko's Kentucky Dynamite in the final strides of the Prix Jean Prat. "We were happy to see Marchand d'Or win last weekend against the older horses in the Prix Maurice de Gheest, as we beat him comfortably first time out this season," Nicolas Clement said. "It will give us an indication of where the three-year-olds stand against the older horses. All we hope for is a good pace and a trouble free race--no traffic problems. If you do beat the older horses in a championship race like the Marois, you can be considered a champion." Susan Magnier and John Ingham's Ad Valorem had looked a star in the ascendant when winning the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket in 2004, but despite some solid efforts last term, failed to add to his tally. Second to Shamardal in the G1 St James's Palace S. at the Royal meeting last June, he travelled to Roval Ascot to annex the G1 Queen Anne S. on his latest start June 20. On that occasion, he had subsequent G1 Sussex S. hero Court Masterpiece (GB), Proclamation (Ire) and Cheveley Park Stud's Peeress behind in a high-class renewal. He is reunited with Jamie Spencer, who partnered him to Middle Park success two years ago. Godolphin have won this three times since 1999 and rely on Librettist, who has a progressive profile. Having missed his sophomore season due to injury, the four-year-old has quickly made up for lost time, besting subsequent listed winner Prince of Light (Ire) when breaking Windsor's track record in the July 1 Listed Midsummer S. and following up at the expense of Thierry Maudet's Helios Quercus and Baron Georg von Ullmann's Manduro in the G3 Prix Messidor at Maisons-Laffitte last time July 23. "We're looking forward to seeing Librettist on Sunday," Racing Manager Simon Crisford told the Racing Post. "He has progressed in all of his runs this season and is going the right way. The Marois is always a good race, but Librettist is an effective horse who deserves to take his chance at this level."

That establishment is responsible for another of Susan Magnier's delegates in Holy Roman Emperor, who bids to follow in the steps of such luminaries as Fasliyev, Johannesburg and George Washington (Ire). Off the board in the June 20 G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot, he returned to take the G2 Railway S. over course and distance last time July 2. "He's in good form and we've been happy with him since his win in the Railway," trainer Aidan O'Brien told the Racing Post. Bidding to break the Coolmore stranglehold on this race is Sheikh Rashid bin Mohammed 's Hellvelyn, who took his unblemished record to three-for-three last time in the Coventry. Trainer Bryan Smart is hopeful that the grey can continue his upward progression on his biggest test. "He's a lovely, laid-back character and quite a big horse, who doesn't just look like a two-year-old," Smart said. "If anything, he was on the weak side at Royal Ascot, but did everything spot-on and I think there's a lot more to come." Andrew Boyle's Drayton, who took the May 1 Listed Coolmore S. and May 27 Listed Isabel Morris S. over five furlongs of this track, was beaten 3/4 of a length by Holy Roman Emperor when runner-up in the Railway over a panel further and is having another crack. "He hasn't got much to find with Aidan's," Tommy Stack's son and assistant Fozzy told PA Sport. "Just three-quarters of a length, so I hope we can find it from somewhere. He seemed to find the extra sixth furlong of the Railway S. no problem, but neither did Holy Roman Emperor. I hope our fellow has improved a little." Kevin Prendergast, who has won this three times, holds a strong hand with his juveniles this term and saddles a duo headed by Lady O'Reilly's unbeaten Brazilian Bride, who bids to emulate the 2004 heroine Damson (Ire) in besting the colts here. She has been laid out for this since winning the G3 Swordlestown Stud Sprint S. at Naas June 5 and warrants respect.

Godolphin, who usually hit the target when plundering the major Italian and German prizes, saddle Cherry Mix in this contest. Runner-up to Bago (Fr) in the 2004 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, he was only 12th in last year's renewal before annexing the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey-Club at the San Siro in October. Down the field in the G1 Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin in December and G3 Dubai City of Gold on his five-year-old bow at Nad al Sheba Mar. 2, he fared little better when sixth in the May 19 G2 Yorkshire Cup. 

The Great Britain and Ireland team had not carried the Shergar Cup since 2002, but that record was put straight under the stewardship of ex-jockey Jason Weaver as the home team dominated the Rest of the World squad from the outset of the Dubai Duty Freesponsored contest at Ascot yesterday. The six-race program was preceded by a six-furlong match between Weaver and and fellow team manager Michael Roberts, with the former cruising to an easy win aboard Pic Up **Sticks (GB)** (Piccolo {GB}) and earning his team an early five-point bonus. Jockey Ryan Moore was awarded the Silver Saddle trophy for leading rider at the meet, with two wins in the first three races providing the platform for a points haul of 50. Seb Sanders, pointless at halfway, staged a late rally with two wins in the final three heats, but his tally of 36 fell short. Gerald Mosse notched Team ROW's only success when partnering Young Mick (GB) (King's Theatre {Ire}) to victory in the Shergar Cup Challenge H. In taking five of the six races, Team GBI never looked in danger and ended the card with 158 points, compared to Rest of the World's 95.
