#### **MOUNTAIN WOMAN**

She's made just three career starts, but the undefeated two-year-old filly Richwoman (Successful Appeal) has already logged a few frequent-flyer miles this season. After breaking her maiden at Keeneland in April

by an impressive seven lengths, she traveled across the country to annex the May 27 Cinderella S. at Hollywood, then returned to Kentucky to gut out a neck victory over Chagall (Successful Appeal) in the GIII Debutante S. at Churchill July 8. Tomorrow, she'll start in her third state in as many races when she takes

on nine other juvenile fillies in the GII Adirondack S. at Saratoga. "She's a very nice filly with a lot of promise," said her regular rider, Shaun Bridgmohan. "She's won on the lead, from off the pace, and she's already shipped out to California to win a stake. I like her a lot." Richwoman will be the 122-pound highweight in the Adirondack, which finds Chagall taking another crack at her. An \$825,000 FTFFEB purchase earlier this year, Chagall broke her maiden at first asking at Churchill June 16, then narrowly failed as the even-money choice in the Debutante. "She's trained well since," said Todd Pletcher, who conditions the filly for Michael Tabor, Susan Magnier and Derrick Smith. "We're optimistic that she's going to run well."

Pennsylvania because of a fractured right hind leg suffered in the GI Preakness S. and a month after developing laminitis. "We felt he was ready for a change of scenery, so last week we took him outside to pick his own grass," said the center's chief of surgery, Dr. Dean Richardson, who is shown in pictures hand-grazing the bay in grassy areas adjacent to the ICU. "He's not outside for a long time, but it's enough to let him

enjoy the fresh air and sunshine. If he remains this comfortable, he will be hand-grazed daily." A month ago, things looked grim for the GI Kentucky Derby hero after it was announced that he had developed laminitis in his left hind hoof, prompting the removal of about 80

percent of the hoof wall. While Barbaro is far from out of the woods, Dr. Richardson was upbeat about his condition. "I'm very pleased with his progress,' said Dr. Richardson. "His appetite remains strong, he sleeps well, and we continue to monitor him closely. He is measurably gaining weight and his overall attitude is great." Barbaro underwent a cast change to his right hind last Tuesday. In other Barbaro news, Breyer Animal Creations, which makes model

It looks as though the owners of Secretariat's

much-traveled daughter L'On Vite recalled this advice in 2002. That was the year Coolmore announced at the end of the northern hemisphere breeding season that Danehill--for the first time since 1990--would not be working a second shift in Australia. Giant's Causeway substituted for him.

This caused a problem for L'On Vite, who had been virtually married to Danehill since she arrived in Australia at the age of nine, with a 1995 Jade Hunter filly foal at foot. The Danehill--L'On Vite partnership didn't get off to a good start, as their first foal died, but they then produced four daughters over the next five years. The second of these daughters, Milanova, showed Classic potential early in her three-year-old season, when she took the Lindsay Park Guineas in September 2002.

Another incentive for maintaining L'On Vite's relationship with Danehill was that this pairing was producing foals bred along similar lines to the Australian star Flying Spur. This Danehill colt, who won the highly prestigious Golden Slipper S. and two other Group 1 events, is out of Fanfreluche's grand-daughter Rolls, whereas L'On Vite is herself a daughter of the celebrated Fanfreluche. Flying Spur had already become Australia's leading first-crop sire in the 1999-2000 season and his excellent Northern-Hemisphere pedigree, coupled with his impressive looks, had led to his shuttling to the Irish National Stud. Those fast performers Mister Links, Osterhase, Steenberg and Firebolt resulted from Flying Spur's time in Ireland.

L'On Vite duly traveled to Ireland to renew her acquaintance with Danehill in 2003, and her journey was made all the more fortunate by the fact that Danehill was to die on May 13. Happily, L'On Vite conceived a colt a few weeks before Danehill's death and that colt, Holy Roman Emperor, continued his rise to the top of the two-year-old division when he inflicted the first defeat on the Coventry S. winner Hellvelyn in the G1 Phoenix S. Sue Magnier's colt is now the winner of three of his four starts, and his below-par effort from a moderate draw in the Coventry must now be forgotten.

L'On Vite wasn't to find a permanent home in Ireland. With Danehill dead, she was quickly returned to Australia, where she produced a colt by Danehill's son Rock of Gibraltar in August 2005. She was then barren to Encosta de Lago, but this very successful son of Fairy King is sire of a 2005 filly out of Holy Roman Emperor's sister Milanova (with this mating producing 5x3 to Fanfreluche).

Two other sisters of the Phoenix S. winner are being given every chance as broodmares in Australia. Interestingly, both Egerszegi and Amies produced 2005 fillies by Elusive Quality, the suspicion being that these matings have been chosen partly because they create 4x3 inbreeding to Secretariat. They also produce 4x4x4 inbreeding to Northern Dancer, with four lines of Natalma in the fifth generation. Holy Roman Emperor, though, is inbred 3x3 to Northern Dancer (and 4x4x4 to Natalma) and 3x3 inbreeding also features in the pedigrees of eight of Danehill's other northern-hemisphere Group winners, including those of Rock of Gibraltar, Desert King and Horatio Nelson.

Desert King and Horatio Nelson were both Group 1 winners at two who attempted some type of Derby glory over a mile and a half at three. Desert King won the Irish version, but does Holy Roman Emperor have any prospects of staying beyond a mile as a three-year-old? Aidan O'Brien says that six furlongs suits the colt well, adding that: "he won't mind going further later on."

It is interesting that Holy Roman Emperor's sister Milanova gained both her stakes successes over a mile, including in the G3 Tokyo City Cup as a four-year-old. However, she was tried at up to 1 9/16 miles at Group 1 level, once being beaten only four lengths when sixth in the South Australian Oaks. While she might have found that distance a bit beyond her, there is no doubt that she stayed 1¼ miles, as she was second in a pair of Group 1 contests over that distance, once failing by only a neck to take the Kingston Town S. So, if Holy Roman Emperor is to target one of the Derbys, it will probably have to be the newly shortened French variety.

L'On Vite headed for Australia after being bought for only \$90,000 by Paul Shanahan at Keeneland's 1995 November Sales. She was carrying a Theatrical colt which was sent to Japan, where, as Big Viking, he won at Group 3 level over 1½ miles and was third in a Group 2 over 1 9/16 miles.

L'On Vite was a steal at less than \$100,000. She could hardly have had a more impressive pedigree, with a brilliant Triple Crown winner as her sire and a Canadian Horse of the Year as her dam. The dam-Fanfreluche-had also earned the title of champion three-year-old filly in the U.S., thanks to her victory in the Alabama S. over 1½ miles. Fanfreluche's brother Night Shift has enjoyed considerable success as a stallion and she, too, did outstandingly well as a producer.

Two of Fanfreluche's earlier foals by Secretariat were Medaille d'Or, a champion two-year-old in Canada, and D'Accord, winner of the GII Breeders' Futurity. Her other produce included two other Canadian champions in L'Enjoleur (Horse of the Year) and La Voyageuse. There are numerous stakes winners descending from Fanfreluche, who produced eight daughters. Her grand-daughter Society Lady is the dam of two British Group winners by Green Desert (another son of Danehill's sire Danzig), one being the ill-fated champion two-year-old filly Bint AllayI.

Now this cross has come up with another potential champion in Holy Roman Emperor, who seems to possess the powers of acceleration one hopes to see in a top-class juvenile.

**NUMBERS UP AT FASIG-TIPTON** A total of seven horses cleared the six-figure plateau during a lively



second session of bidding at Fasig-Tipton's New York-bred Preferred Yearlings sale at the Humphrey S. Finney Pavilion in Saratoga Sunday night, with the sale establishing a new record average. Leading the way was hip 315, a colt from the first crop of MGSW Hook and Ladder (Dixieland Band) that was knocked down to agent Buzz Chace for \$230,000. The Mar. 18 foal was produced by the winning In Excess (Ire) mare Moneymakinmamma, a full sister

to SW Pocketfullofpesos and SP Miss Skagit State and a half to MSW & MGSP Quiet Cash (Real Quiet). Hip 315 was consigned by Becky Thomas's Lakland North, as agent, which stands Hook and Ladder. The secondhighest-priced horse on the evening was hip 327, a chestnut colt by Johannesburg that attracted a \$182,000 bid from Richlyn Farm. Consigned by Paramount Sales as property of Sugar Maple Farm, the colt is out of the nine-year-old Out of the Buggy (Miswaki), herself a daughter of SW & GSP Embracing (Regal Embrace). In all, 12 horses brought \$100,000 or more during the two-day event. For the first time in the sale's history, the average eclipsed the \$50,000 mark, with 101 horses selling for an average of \$52,421. In his first start at three, he won the GII Louisiana Derby by four lengths over Vicarage before finishing second in the GI Blue Grass S. Last of 20 in

Giacomo's GI Kentucky Derby, High Limit hit the board just once in his next four starts that year, but regained his best form at four. The bay won the GII San Pasqual H. in early January, then romped by 4 1/2 lengths in the GII Strub S. a month later. In what would be his last start, he finished fourth to Lava Man in the Mar. 4 GI Santa Anita H., but came out of the race with an injury to his right front ankle. Produced by an unraced half-sister to stakes-winner Spartan Cat (Mountain Cat), High Limit hails from the family of GISW Dance Teacher and MGSW Gold Mover. High Limit retires with a record of 12-5-5-1 and earnings of \$922,500.

Saturday's GI Sword Dancer Invitational winner **Go Deputy** (Deputy Minister) is expected to make his next start in the GI Man o' War S. at Belmont Park Sept. 9, according to trainer Todd Pletcher yesterday. Owned by Wertheimer et Frere, the six-year-old previously won the GII Bowling Green H. July 15. Also slated to make his next appearance at Belmont is **English Channel** (Smart Strike), who ran fourth in Saturday's GI Arlington Million. The James Scatuorchio-owned colt will be aimed at the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational Oct. 7.

#### Wonder Lady Anne L. Breezes for Alabama:

Wonder Lady Anne L. (Real Quiet), who had a breakout win in the July 22 Gl Coaching Club American Oaks in her latest, worked six furlongs at Saratoga yesterday in preparation for Saturday's 10-furlong Gl Alabama S. The three-year-old filly stopped the clock in 1:14 over a fast main track. "She's doing good," said trainer Rick Dutrow, Jr. "She's going in the Alabama." Dutrow added that one horse in particular, trainer Shug McGaughey's CCA Oaks runner-up Pine Island (Arch), had him concerned. "I don't like meeting Pine Island, but where else am I gonna go?" he said. "I heard Pine Island ran a 6 3/4 [on the Ragozin Speed Figures] and my filly ran a 9. We'll be in good shape if Pine Island reacts off the race."





New York Racing Scene

In a letter to the Ad Hoc Committee on the Future of Racing, which is currently soliciting bids for the right to run the NYRA tracks, New York State Comptroller Alan G. Hevesi called for the committee "to require potential Thoroughbred racing franchise holders to demonstrate commitment to ensuring the integrity of racing and wagering in proposals." A press release from Hevesi's office read:

State Comptroller Alan G. Hevesi (yesterday) called on the Ad Hoc Committee on the Future of Racing to supplement its request for proposals (RFP) for future Thoroughbred racing franchise holders to require respondents to specifically address initiatives intended to ensure the integrity of racing and wagering recommended in 2005 by court-appointed federal monitor Getnick & Getnick. The monitor, who reported to both Hevesi and the U.S. Attorney, instituted various measures to promote ethical operations of New York's Thoroughbred tracks -- Aqueduct, Belmont and Saratoga--as well as associated wagering by the current franchise holder, the New York Racing Association (NYRA).

"It is clear that the RFP fails to adequately address the recommendations of Getnick & Getnick, as well as the reforms in the operation of New York's thoroughbred tracks already implemented as a result of the federal monitorship," Hevesi wrote in the letter to Committee Chair J. Patrick Barrett. "The abuses that led to NYRA's indictment are too serious, and the reforms that were developed in response to those abuses are too important, to be ignored in establishing the conditions for the next franchise."
