TATTS TO STAGE EXTRA BREEZE IN 2007

Tattersalls is to stage a second breeze-up sale next year, which will take place Friday, May 4, the day before the two-day Guineas meeting, and which will be known as the Tattersalls Guineas Breeze-Up Sale. The auction house aims to catalogue between 125 and 150 two-year-olds, with all lots breezing the day before the sale on the same strip of ground used for the April breeze-up sale. "Having established the Tattersalls Breeze-Up as Europe's premier two-year-olds-in-training sale, we felt that the time was right to stage a second sale, and Guineas weekend provides the perfect focal point for a new breeze-up sale," said Tattersalls' Chairman Edmond Mahony. "The impetus for the new sale has come not only from the spectacular sale ring results, but also from the racetrack achievements of the sale graduates. Last year's Tattersalls Breeze-Up produced a higher percentage of Group 1-winning twoyear-olds than any other 2005 two-year-olds-in-training sale, and the 2006 sale has already produced the Group 2 winner Hamoody. Both purchasers and vendors like the proven Tattersalls Breeze-Up format, and we are keen to cater to the increased demand and also to provide an outlet for two-year-olds which may benefit from that little bit of extra time to mature." Entries for both 2007 Tattersalls' breeze-up sales close Dec. 8.

got off the van at Davis, he was feeling good enough where he was looking around for the racetrack." Last year's champion sprinter, the four-year-old has not raced since finishing off the board in the GII Smile Sprint H. July 15 at Calder.

While giving a nod to Gone West and A.P. Indy, we would have to acknowledge that Storm Cat still reigns as America's most sought-after sire of sires. That is hardly surprising when one notes that at least 13 sons of Storm Cat have already sired Grade I winners and that his sons include Giant's Causeway, Forestry, Hennessy, Tale of the Cat, Forest Wildcat, Stormy Atlantic and Stormin Fever, as well as the prematurely deceased Harlan. Of course, like any sire of sires--even Storm Cat's grandfather Northern Dancer--Storm Cat has also had his share of sons who have had less of an impact.

One Storm Cat who initially promised much, but delivered less satisfactory early results than those named above was Sea of Secrets. However, he is currently threatening to redeem himself with California juvenile star Principle Secret, impressive winner of the GII Best Pal S. over the weekend.

Principle Secret is now two for two, an identical

record to the one which Sea of Secrets boasted as a juvenile, although he didn't make his first start until mid-October of his two-year-old season. Sea of Secrets extended his unbeaten record on his three-year-old debut with a win in the GII San Vicente S. After disappointing in his next

two outings--the GII San Felipe S. and GIII Bay Shore S.--Sea of Secrets was away from the races for nearly seven months. Beaten into third in an optional claiming race, he returned six weeks later to defeat subsequent champion sprinter Artax by 8 1/2 lengths in a 7 1/2-furlong optional claiming event at Santa Anita while running a 110 Beyer. After that effort, Sea of Secrets appeared likely to be a major threat in West Coast sprint stakes, but he ran only three more times. Off the board in the GI Malibu S., he took third in the Tokyo City H. on his only start at four. He returned in January of his five-year-old season after a 10-month absence and ended his career with an unplaced effort in the El Conejo H.

Retired to stand at Walmac International in Lexington, Kentucky, Sea of Secrets took to stud an impressive pedigree. His dam, Love From Mom, was a daughter of Mr. Prospector, which means that Sea of Secrets is bred on exactly the same pattern as other Storm Cat graded-stakes sires Tale of the Cat, Storm Boot and Storm Creek. What's more, Love From Mom is also the dam of graded-stakes winners Dancing Jon, Fight for Love and Love That Jazz (herself dam of the triple Grade I winner Society Selection). Cont. p3

Sea of Secrets did hit the headlines early in his stud career when a two-year-old from his first crop was sold for a then world-record \$2.7 million at the 2003 Barretts March Sale. Named Diamond Fury, this colt didn't break his maiden until his fifth start, and although he has now won five races and \$114,580, he has yet to earn black type. Sea of Secrets did actually get two black-type winners from that first crop in Appealing Secret, who took the Katy S. at Sam Houston; and Road to Mandalay, successful in the Remington Park Oaks. In his second crop, Sea of Secrets was represented by My Miss Storm Cat, who this year added a win in the Desert Stormer H. to a third in the GIII Landaluce S. earned at two. Sea of Secrets also has a third-crop stakes winner in the shape of Thekatcamehome, successful in the Prairie Meadows Debutante S. These results, combined with a 71 percent winners-to-runners ratio for his first three crops, were not at all bad for a stallion who had spent most of his career standing at a fee of \$5,000, but not enough for Sea of Secrets to remain viable in Kentucky, and he now stands a Ballena Vista Farm in Ramona, California, where he covered at a fee of \$3,500 in the most recent season.

ful runner in her own right, winning seven races and \$115,186 in 25 starts, but is a half-sister to a much better runner in the shape of Barbara O'Brien (Eltish), winner of the GIII Chaposa Springs H. Barbara O'Brien-and most of the foals out of her dam, Brandy O'Brien--were bred in Florida, but Brandy O'Brien's pedigree is pure West Coast. She is by Desert Wine, whose victories included the GI Hollywood Gold Cup, GI Charles H. Strub S. and GI Californian S.; she is a half-sister to the GIII Inglewood H. victor Blaze O'Brien; and she is out of Irish O'Brien, winner of the B.

Thoughtful H. at Santa Anita and Autumn Days H. at Oak Tree. Irish O'Brien was the only stakes winner for her sire, D'Artagnan, and similarly the next three dams are by a trio of sires rarely seen in the pedigrees of major stakes winners: Saltville, Tahitian King and Star Pilot.

Principle Secret is a product of the emerging Storm Cat/Seattle Slew cross, which has also produced graded-stakes winners Bluegrass Cat, Raging Fever, Stormin Fever, Toasted, China Storm, Statue of Liberty, Night Patrol and Atlantic Ocean, as well as another 2006 juvenile graded winner, last week's GIII Sorrento S. victress Untouched Talent. It's worth noting that Slewpy, the grandsire of the dam of Principle Secret, is also broodmare sire of Slewpy's Storm, a stakes winner by Storm Creek, who is bred on the same Mr. Prospector/Seattle Slew cross as Sea of Secrets. It's also worth noting that Storm Cat has enjoyed great success with mares carrying Damascus, the grandsire of Principle Secret's second dam, Brandy O'Brien, while Brandy O'Brien's sire, Desert Wine, is half-brother to Menifee, a Grade I winner by Storm Cat's son, Harlan.

THE YOUNG GUNS

Last week, when we ran the lists of leading mid-year APEX sires, you may have noticed the restriction was that they had to have had a minimum of 250 'year-starters' (200 if they are sires with first foals 2002, first four-year-olds this year). Regardless of the demands of the commercial auction market, the statistical truth is that you can't really judge stallions (with a high degree of predictability about their future prospects) until the end of the year their first four-year-olds have finished racing. Even now it is probably too early to assess that 'first foals 2002' sire crop. You can imagine, therefore, how confident I am in the reliability of the 'first foals 2003' (first three-year-olds 2006) at this stage of the proceedings.

That's the disclaimer. Now let's accede to the demands of the commercial market and have a look, first at the F2002 sire crop. Here we can immediately see the effect of doubled crop sizes, because Giant's Causeway is miles ahead in total number of runners ('year-starters,' counted once each year/season they run; he has a massive 387); number of A Runners (21, here they are also counted once each year they are an A Runner--he has 17 'unique A Runners'); number of ABC runners (55); and, of course, he is miles clear in money earned as well. Under those circumstances, he has probably done extremely well to tally a 2.71 A Index and 1.78 ABC Index. Stablemates Montjeu (233 runners, 2.79) and Fusaichi Pegasus (244 runners, 2.46) are in the same neighborhood, both in number of year-starters and in A Runner indices.

But, though they ranked first, equal third, and sixth in number of A Runners, and first, equal second, and equal fourth in number of ABC Runners, none of the Coolmore trio could quite crack the top five in the key APEX rating, the overall A Runner Index. Those huge crops are just too much for these sires to uphold those averages, unless they're Sadler's Wells or Danehill.

The F2002 sire with the best A Runner Index (50+ year-starters) is Lane's End's Dixie Union (3.59), who I have said before I thought was just about the best North American two-year-old of 1999.

He won three graded stakes in California, including the GII Norfolk, in which he turned the tables on his GII Del Mar Futurity conqueror Forest Camp, and he went into the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile three-for-four. Dixie Union had run a Beyer 104 in the Norfolk, but he drew the 12 hole at Gulfstream Park, and that was that. Anees, who had been third in the Norfolk, came with a big swooping run to win the Juvenile in a Beyer 102. Dixie Union did get a consolation Grade I win in the Haskell as a three-year-old (Beyer 111), but it was his two-year-old form that was so impressive.

And so far, it's as a two-year-old sire that Dixie Union is making his mark. He has a 3.80 two-year-old ABC rating (1.00 is average, as with all APEX ratings), and has hands-down the best two-year-old of either sex in Europe in Sander Camillo.

Both Successful Appeal (3.20 A Runner Index) and Yes It's True (3.16) were very good sprinter-milers who have been to the fore among this sire crop since the opening bell. Successful Appeal, by In Reality's top sire son (as it turned out), Valid Appeal, won Grade II races at two, three (twice), and four, and ran third to Forestry and Five Star Day in the GI King's Bishop as a three-year-old. Yes It's True, himself a \$900,000 two-year-old trained by Wayne Lukas, won eight graded races, four of them (at up to six furlongs) as a two-year-old.

Both horses ran 11 times each as three-year-olds in 1999, and only one of their combined 22 starts that year was not in a graded stakes. Their success is a big testament to soundness, durability--and speed.

But it's also true that all three of this crop's top sires do have better ratings for their two-year-olds than their three- and four-year-olds--as do other top 10 F2002 sires Cape Canaveral (2.81) and More Than Ready (2.64). So, while they deservedly get all the points for speed and precocity, it's entirely possible that the top horses with a somewhat 'later' profile (Montjeu and Giant's Causeway, for example) could eventually catch the speedier types for sire crop leadership. In any case, they're all among what looks like a pretty significant sire crop.

I'd like to single out two others from among the top 20 of the 2002 sire crop. Interestingly, both are from the same, great Gay Missile family. The first is Lemon Drop Kid, who now scores over 2.00 in most major categories, and is among the group's top 10, with nine A Runners and 31 ABC's. He has been ranked fourth in 2006 progeny earnings among North American thirdcrop sires most of the year, behind only Giant's Causeway, Yes It's True, and More Than Ready (another who's done really well), and now looks a classic case of a horse who's fallen from favor (his 2006 stud fee was down to \$20,000) just as he's getting good. The other is a horse I'd actually never heard of, name of Kipling. He's bred on the same cross as Thunder Gulch (Gulch out of a Storm Bird mare). The Storm Bird mare in question, Weekend Storm, happens to be a full sister to Summer Squall and half-sister to A.P. Indy. Kipling won five allowance races up to 8 1/2 furlongs at Monmouth, Canterbury, and Remington Park, but gained no black type himself. How he could be a good sire is anybody's guess, but Mighty Acres, in Pryor, Oklahoma, has got one hot sire on their hands. Just in the last six weeks three separate runners by him have won the \$150,000 Evangeline Mile H. and the C\$100,000 Manitoba Lotteries Derby, and his Kip Deville was second to Showing Up in the \$1-million Colonial Turf Cup.

Sophomore Form...

Galileo is running away from the field for the money title, but like stablemates Giant's Causeway and Montjeu, he doesn't necessarily score right at the top when you do the averages (and I guess that shows you what really counts--Group 1 winners). In his case, the fact that he is second to former New York stallion City Zip in number of ABC runners is a good indicator, and it's notable that, like Giant's Causeway as well as Montjeu, it looks like they're better older.

Especially in the case of these young stallions, it's important to look at the numbers from all the angles, because a couple of good results can all of a sudden make a big difference.

That said, there's no doubt that Cheveley Park's Medicean, a high-class mile to 10-furlong horse, has made a seriously good start, with seven A Runners already, and a 4.17 A Index. This includes five 'unique' A Runners, three fillies last year (including Nannina), and two colts this year, including G2 Norfolk winner and probable G1 Prix Morny candidate, Dutch Art. Medicean's sire, Machiavellian, always worked well over mares by Green Desert, and two of Medicean's group winners are out of Danehill mares mated by Cheveley Park. Bizarrely, Medicean has seven A Runners but only one B/C Runner; that's one example of why we need to look at sophomore sires from several angles. Also, strangely, Medicean never even ran at two himself, yet all of his A Runners so far became A Runners at two. Cont. p9

Just behind Medicean is another of those horses I wasn't familiar with, called Trajectory, who has a 3.95 A Index and a mind-blowing 7.30 two-year-old ABC Index. He turns out to be a Gone West horse, trained by Graham Motion for Pin Oak, and they stand him, in partnership with Gardiner Farms, in Ontario. I know these Canadian stallions can sometimes be flattered, statistically, but this looks pretty real. He had three two-year-old stakes horses in his first crop last year, and the dual two-year-old stakes-winning filly Midnight Shadow this year.

City Zip (New York crops) and Songandaprayer (Florida crops) both continue to look very legit, with 20 and 13 ABC runners (of which each has six A Runners) respectively, and a number of other horses come up in the top 10 of some of these lists. Broken Vow looks quite respectable, as do the likes of Forest Camp, El Corredor, Aptitude, and the Wintergreen pair of Ecton Park and Five Star Day--both among this group's top five on ABC Index so far. But one who has gone missing is last year's Leading Freshman Sire, Tiznow. He seems to have done a Fasliyev.

She is currently in foal to Storm Cat.


