LYMPHOMA DIAGNOSIS FOR LOST IN THE

FOG Lost in the Fog (Lost Soldier) has been diagnosed with a potentially fatal case of lymphoma, according to trainer Greg Gilchrist. The four-year-old colt, owned by

Harry Aleo, was taken to a veterinary clinic at the University of California-Davis earlier this week after developing what connections intially thought to be a routine case of colic. Doctors performed a sonogram that revealed a cantaloupe-sized cancerous mass in his spleen. Gilchrist said that the colt's

racing career was over and that the focus would now shift to simply saving his life. "This will not be unlike the situation with Barbaro," Gilchrist said. "Mr. Aleo will spare no expense and this horse will have the best surgeons available. We have always put the horse first and nothing will change. We will just do the best we can for him." Gilchrist said that if the cancer went untreated, it was expected that Lost in the Fog would survive for no more than a year. "We could go with radiation and chemotherapy, but I don't think that will happen," Gilchrist said. "We will probably choose to remove his spleen and hope that the cancer has not metastasized and spread. Right now, everyone feels it hasn't. The tricky thing is that he is 50-50 to make it through the operation. There are very few surgeons who have done this." Further tests will be done Friday to see if the cancer has spread beyond the spleen. If it has, no surgery will be performed, Gilchrist said. Lost in the Fog won his first 10 straight races, including the GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga, and suffered his lone defeat in 2005 in the Breeders' Cup Sprint. He has since lost two of three starts, including a ninth-place finish in his last race, the July 15 GIII Smile Sprint H. at Calder. Gilchrist said he believed the lymphoma was at least partially responsible for Lost in the Fog's poor form this year. "Obviously, he's been running with this for a while," Gilchrist said. "It shows you that this horse has the heart of a lion. It certainly could explain why he had some subpar performances."

The sole stakes winner in the field, **Chace City** took the June 18 Victoria S. at Woodbine, but suffered his only career loss after jumping in the air soon after the start of the GIII Bashford Manor S. at Churchill Downs July 8. "He was in the No. 1 post and he over-rated when the No. 2 horse came in on him," said assistant trainer Scott Blasi, who is running the barn for Steve Asmussen who is serving a six-month suspension. "I think he found himself in a position where he didn't know where he was at. I don't think it was his fault. He's a two-year-old and it was a new experience for him being in that position."

Saratoga Special BC S.

King of The Roxy was recently purchased by Team Valor and transferred to the barn of trainer Todd Pletcher. Well beaten in his debut at Hollywood park May 18, the dark bay rounded out his tenure with Richard Matlow with a 2 3/4-length score in a 5 1/2-furlong contest July 2. "It's an ambitious spot, but he's training well," said Pletcher. "He runs in blinkers and we haven't been working him in blinkers. Apparently, that makes a big difference...We'll give it a shot and see how he does."

A professional 2 1/2-length winner going 4 1/2 panels at Churchills Downs May 27, Octave stumbled at the start in her latest, a 5 1/2 furlong test at Belmont Park July 2, but still managed to finish a respectable second to Desire to Excel. Looking to secure her first

graded stakes victory here, the filly appeared primed for her best effort following a bullet four-furlong work in :47 4/5 at Belmont Aug. 10. "I told Garrett [Gomez], 'Don't take away what comes easy,'" explained Todd Pletcher. "'Sit in the pocket and keep coming at them.' That's exactly what happened. It's a tiring track. From the eighth pole to the wire, you have to have a very fit horse to get there." The \$350,000 KEESEP yearling, who is raced by Starlight

Stables and Donald Lucarelli, was the second 9-1 shot winner in one week at the Spa for the Pletcher barn, following a victory by Jade Queen last Thursday. 

She entered winter quarters as a leading fancy for the G1 1000 Guineas on the strength of her victory in the Listed Oh So Sharp S. over seven furlongs of Newmarket's Rowley Mile in her final juvenile start. Heavy rain on the morning of May 7 G1 1000 Guineas diluted her chance, and she could only manage an eighth-place finish on that sophomore debut. The bay filly progressed from there to record solid fourth-place finishes in both the May 28 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at the Curragh 28 and G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 23, and followed home Ouija Board (GB) and Alexander Goldrun (Ire) at a respectable distance when coming home sixth in the Aug. 5 G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood on her last trip to the track. Racing in midfield through the steady early fractions here, she was pushed along as the field turned for home. The filly was challenging soon after, and one smack behind the saddle saw her hit the front 100 yards from the line, where she was good value for her half-length winning margin.
