Lost in the Fog (Lost Soldier--Cloud Break, by Dr. Carter), the 2005 Eclipse Award winning sprinter, has been diagnosed with a total of three tumors in his abdomen, and his condition as described by Dr. Don

Smith, DVM, is "terminal." After first discovering what was believed to be a cancerous mass in his spleen, doctors at the University of California at Davis vesterday introduced a laparoscope into the four-vear-old colt's abdomen and discovered that the cancer had in fact spread. Dr. Smith indicated

that one egg-sized tumor was discovered in a ligament suspending the spleen within the abdomen, but a second, more serious mass, the approximate size of a football, was observed high in the abdomen along the roof of the back and was located in a position that is inoperable, Smith said. During a national teleconference and speaking from his barn at Golden Gate Fields, trainer Greg Gilchrist indicated that Lost in the Fog would be returned to the barn as early as today for a period of 10 days to two weeks. "I think we'll bring him back here and we'll keep him here and then the inevitable is going to happen," he explained. "It would not be the right thing to do to prolong the horse's life. Good pedigrees were in demand as Angus Gold explained after signing the ticket for the top lot of the day, hip 93, a Monsun (Ger) filly who is a sister to three German Classic winners. She was consigned by Haras du Mezeray and was knocked down for €750,000. "There are very few opportunities to find such a good pedigree in a yearling sale and we didn't want to miss it," he said, adding, "The filly is obviously immature, being a late foal, and on the small side, and

will need time. She is a jewel, walked well and will now be turned out on the farm before being sent into training. Obviously she will stay and there is no rush. Where she goes into training is entirely Sheikh's Hamdan decision, but he usually sends horses bought in France to French trainers." Sheikh Hamdan didn't waste time to secure two other beautiful pedigrees, going

to €600,000 for hip <u>125</u>, a daughter of Diesis (GB) out of G2 winner Turtle Bow (Fr) consigned by Haras d'Etreham; and to €500,000 for hip 144, from the same Etreham consignment, by hot sire Elusive Quality. Out of a sister to G1 winner Anabaa Blue (GB), she is from the superb family of Urban Sea, Galileo (Ire), Black Sam Bellamy (Ire) and King's Best. Of the 137 horses which went through the ring on a bright sunny afternoon, 106 sold for a gross €14,256,000 at an average of €134,491. "We will not draw comparisons now," explained Olivier Delloye of ARQANA. "The format is new, with the sale starting on a Friday afternoon, and we sold more horses today than Agence Francaise did last year on its first day. But we are certainly very pleased with the results. The percentage of horses sold was high and there was a strong demand, for a first day that is very positive and excellent. The demand was especially good for the top horses and we had active buyers from all parts of the world. We could not be more pleased with this start.

"The new format seems to please buyers and for us it is most satisfactory. One figure talks: we sold 19 horses for €200,000 or more on that first day and last year only 13 went over that price in four days. Also, we sold 5 for €500,000 or more today when only 2 sold for more throughout last year's sale. On Sunday evening we will know precisely where we stand." Despite being sent to the clinic only earlier this week for what Gilchrist thought was a mild case of colic, Dr. Smith suggested that the recently discovered cancer in the spleen and now in the abdomen had likely been present much longer. "It could have been anywhere from a few months--probably a mimimum of four months--all the way up to a year," he said. Gilchrist said that he began noticing changes in the horse a little more than a week ago. "He started going off his feed sporadically, his temperature was consistently elevated by half a degree and he started to lose some of his aggressiveness," the conditioner related. "Then he spiked a temperature last Sunday and that's when we sent him to Davis." Dr. Smith and Gilchrist both hastened to emphasize that Lost in the Fog is not in any acute pain and has responded well to treatment. The doctor likened Lost in the Fog's condition to a stomach ache. Gilchrist added, "If this were a human, he's the kind of guy you'd like to be around." The trainer, who is scheduled to attend the sales in Ocala next week, said that he would definitely be back in Northern California "when the inevitable happens." He suggested that owner Harry Aleo may or may not be in attendance. "Harry's a tough old guy, but I think this is really bringing him to his knees," Gilchrist commented.

A Warrior Wins an Eclipse...

The dark bay became something of a rock star in 2005, winning his first 10 career starts at seven different racetracks, including the GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga. 
