Darley Stable's **Bernardini** (A.P. Indy) put the wraps on a phenomenal weekend for the Maktoum family, winning yesterday's GI Travers S. by a decisive 7 1/2 lengths. The victory added to the earlier graded-stakes successes by Godolphin's **Ashkal Way (Ire)** (Ashkalani {Ire}) and by Sheikh Rashid bin Mohammed al

Dermot Weld has just one renewal of the G1 Moyglare Stud S. to his credit, but in Khalid Abdullah's **Supposition (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) he has a live candidate to double the score at The Curragh today. The first Juddmonte runner to be trained in Ireland, the two-year-old filly made an instant impact when narrowly beaten by subsequent G2 Vintage S. runner-up Duke of Marmalade (Ire) on debut here June 30. Her smooth seven-length success at Galway Aug. 1 set her up for her stakes debut. "She's in good form," the owner's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe told *PA Sport*. "The form of her first race looks quite smart, but obviously it's a big leap to Group 1 from maiden. The trainer seems happy with her so we hope she's good enough." **Cont. p9**

The Making of a Superstar...

A son of Grade I winner Cara Rafaela, who was acquired privately by Sheikh Mohammed from the TNT Stud of Gonzalo Torrealba carrying a foal by A.P. Indy in early 2003, Bernardini debuted modestly enough, finishing fourth going six panels at Gulfstream Jan. 7. Stretched to that oval's one-turn mile Mar. 4, the striking bay posted a 7 3/4-length victory and shipped north to take the GIII Withers S. over that same trip by 3 3/4 lengths Apr. 29. After carefully considering their options, connections elected to run in the GI Preakness S. and, despite the unfortunate events that afternoon, nothing could be taken away from Bernardini's performance as he strode home 5 1/4 lengths best. Passing on the GI Belmont in favor of a late summer and fall campaign, the colt waltzed to a nine-length victory in the July 29 Jim Dandy, earning him 1-5 favoritism for the Travers.

Leaving Nothing to Doubt...

Following an alert dispatch, Bernardini found himself sandwiched between the Todd Pletcher-trained duo of GI Haskell Invitational S. hero Bluegrass Cat (Storm Cat) and GIII Northern Dancer BC S. winner High Cotton (Dixie Union). Javier Castellano sensed that his mount was keyed up and allowed him to lead through an opening quarter of :23.53. Despite being hounded every step by Bluegrass Cat, Bernardini relaxed enough to turn in an internal half-mile in a leisurely :49.19, turned on the afterburners leaving the quarter pole and cruised to the winner's circle. "I did not expect to go to the lead like that, but my horse broke sharp, he wanted to go in the first turn," Castellano commented. "I didn't want to fight him. I wanted to see him comfortable." Added winning trainer Tom Albertrani, "He trained beautifully going into this race. He was a lot sharper after the Jim Dandy. Hopefully, he comes out of the race in good order and we'll go in the [GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, Belmont Park, Oct. 7] and [GI Breeders' Cup Classic, Churchill Downs, Nov. 4]. Henny Hughes was purchased by Sheikh Rashid last summer after breaking his maiden at Monmouth Park and taking the Tremont S. at Belmont by 15 lengths. He made it three in a row in the GII Saratoga Special, then had to settle for second in the GI Hopeful S., GI Champagne S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. The evecatching chestnut was not as his best while wintering in Dubai, but came to hand when he returned to the U.S. this spring. Off at 2-5 in his comeback, the July 1 GIII Jersey Shore Breeders' Cup S., he romped to a 10length victory, stopping the timer in 1:08 1/5 for the six furlongs. Trainer Kiaran McLaughlin brought the colt to the King's Bishop off eight weeks' rest, and was rewarded for his patient handling with a dominant victory. The winner goes next in the Oct. 7 GI Vosburgh S. "The Vosburgh is against older [horses], but he's ready for it," McLaughlin said. A two-time winner from nine starts overseas, Ashkal Way took a second-level allowance over the Belmont turf May 25 and made it back-to-back victories with a nose victory in a \$100,000 optional claimer downstate June 14. A maiden winner in five European starts, the chestnut was runner-up in his U.S. bow at Santa Anita Sept. 29, then took the GII Oak Tree Derby by a nose just 16 days later. He returned to be second by a neck in the GI F.E. 

Beaten a head when second in this event last year, one-time Canadian Classic winner Le Cinqiueme Essai made amends for that narrow defeat with a game victory. 

Teofilo emerged from a war of attrition to take his record to a perfect three-for-three and provide trainer Jim Bolger with a fourth renewal of this important staging post. He won one of the strongest maidens run in Ireland in 2006 when besting Black Rock Desert (Ire) and Blue Coral (Ire) over track and trip July 16 before taking the Listed Tyros S. at Leopardstown 13 days later. Keen in the hands of Kevin Manning in second throughout the early stages, he took over passing the quarter pole before being pressed by Eagle Mountain and Colm O'Donoghue. That rival was alongside for a few strides on the run to the line, but Teofilo pulled out more to find a final surge and secure the victory. "He's a real nice horse who has done nothing wrong and keeps progressing," Manning said. "Today, it was a messy race and there wasn't much pace--he's left the gates guick with me and got a bump and it set him alight. I ended up in front sooner than I'd have liked and he's just doing nothing in front. When he goes a mile, we'll see the best of him and there are no reasons why he won't get further. There are no stamina doubts in my mind and he's a proper Group 1 horse." Trainer Jim Bolger also sees Teofilo as a middle-distance performer. "This is the best colt I've had and he has everything," he commented. "We'll have to think again about the [Sept. 17] G1 National S., as I don't really want to run him over seven furlongs again, and he's a middle distance horse next year." 

All eyes will be on Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's G1 2000 Guineas winner George Washington, who reappears after a three-month absence enforced by injury. Last year's G1 Phoenix S. and G1 National S. winner showed electric acceleration to rout his rivals in the Newmarket Classic May 6, but found the soft ground against him when runner-up to Araafa (Ire) in the Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh May 27. He sustained a muscular injury in that effort, and connections are anxious to see how the charismatic Ballydoyle raider will perform in his return. "We hope he retains his ability, but it was a very severe injury and it wouldn't be usual to come back this quickly," trainer Aidan O'Brien explained. "We need him back, so we took a chance and we hope it's still all going to be there." George Washington faces older horses for the first time in a stiff comeback test. The most accomplished of the brigade is Soviet Song. The multiple Group 1 winner looked as strong as ever when powering to an impressive score in the G2 Windsor Forest S. at Royal Ascot June 21 before being found out by slow early fractions when sixth in the G1 Falmouth S. at Newmarket July 12. She proved that was an aberration when runner-up to Court Masterpiece (GB) in the Aug. 2 G1 Sussex S. over course and distance, where Rob Roy was a half length back in third. Godolphin rely on last year's G1 Prix de la Foret runner-up Caradak, who shaped as if he needed this trip when third in the G2 Hungerford S. at Newbury last Saturday.

LOST IN THE FOG GIVEN "REASONABLE CHANCE"

The doctor treating sprint champion Lost in the Fog for cancerous tumors said Friday that the colt has "a reasonable chance" of reducing them to a size that's conducive for chemotherapy or surgery.

Dr. Gary Magdesian, chief of equine medicine at University of California at Davis, said Friday that Lost in the Fog is being treated with Dexamethasone, a corticosteroid sometimes used in treating lymphoma.

"We want to see if [the tumors] will respond to the extent that they are reduced to a size that will make them amenable to surgery or chemotherapy," Magdesian said

"There's a reasonable chance [of success]," he added.

If the tumors shrink, Magdesian noted, "I would say that chemotherapy, especially, gives him the best hope [of surviving]." Click here for the complete story.

"Then there is Hurricane Run and the Japanese horse, so it might be a question of missing that this year and going for the Champion, but we'll play it nearer the time."


