BLUEGRASS CAT RETIRED WITH INJURY Grade I winner **Bluegrass Cat** (Storm Cat--She's a Winner, by A.P. Indy) suffered a non-displaced fracture to his right hind pastern in his runner-up effort to Bernardini in

Saturday's GI Travers S. and has been retired. The WinStar homebred, a Todd Pletcher trainee, was "significantly lame" in his right hind following the race, according to a press release, and subsequent radiographs revealed the fracture. Surgical options are currently under review by owners Bill

Casner and Kenny Troutt. The injury is not life-threatening. "We are clearly disappointed that Bluegrass Cat's racing career has come to an end," said WinStar President Doug Cauthen. "We are excited, however, about his extraordinary prospects as a stallion." Prior to the Travers, Bluegrass Cat notched a breakout victory in the Aug. 6 GI Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Park. The three-year-old broke his maiden by 6 1/2 lengths for trainer Todd Pletcher at Belmont last September and went on to win the GIII Nashua S. and GII Remsen S. at two. In his sophomore bow, the son of Storm Cat embarked down the Derby trail with a win in the Sam F. Davis S. and a runner-up finish in the GIII Tampa Bay Derby, but a hiccup in the form of a well-beaten fourth in the GI Bluegrass S. at Keeneland resulted in 30-1 odds when he lined up for the May 6 GI Kentucky Derby. He belied those odds and found only Barbaro too good that day, then returned five weeks later to be second, this time to Jazil, in the GI Belmont S. The bay went in search of and found Grade I glory in the Haskell Invitational at Monmouth, winning by a resounding seven-length margin (Video).

Swan Song for the Cat...

Sent off the 5-2 second choice to Bernardini in the Travers, he tracked that foe before weakening down the lane, finishing second by 7 1/2 lengths. "This horse was just coming into his own," said Pletcher. "Bluegrass Cat was bringing his game to a whole new level coming off his performance in the Haskell. It is quite disappointing that his career has to come to an end. He was a very special horse." Bluegrass Cat, a half to MGSW Lord of the Game (Saint Ballado), is out of the unraced A.P. Indy mare She's a Winner, a full to MGSW Daydreaming and GSW Accelerator. Under the third dam is champion Rhythm, as well as successful sires Not For Love and Mutakddim.

World-traveler Dubai Escapade graduated second time out in Dubai last March before being shipped to the U.S. She came back after nearly 11 months on the shelf to win in a pair of allowance starts at Gulfstream this winter, then recorded her first graded-stakes victory in the GII Madison S. at Keeneland Apr. 12. Freshened for two months, the four-year-old returned better than ever, winning the June 11 GII Vagrancy H. at Belmont by six lengths, but she was derailed in her latest start when finishing sixth after stalking the early pace in the GI Princess Rooney H. at Calder July 15. "At Calder, I don't think she handled the track and she appeared confused when another horse went by her," said Eoin Harty, explaining her lackluster performance. "I just threw that race out and started from scratch." Back to her beloved spot on the lead here, the filly broke cleanly, led her rivals through sharp early fractions and had plenty left in the tank to collect her first Grade I victory. Nothing But Fun (Dixie Union), sent off at 5-1, mounted a gallant rally in the stretch to get up for the second spot, but was no match for the winner, who was 8 1/2 lengths in front on the line. George Pleases Connections...

Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's G1 2000 Guineas winner George Washington made his eagerly awaited return yesterday, and trainer Aidan O'Brien expressing himself "delighted" with his third placing. Off since sustaining a muscular injury after finishing runner-up in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh May 27, he was sent off the 5-6 favorite under Mick Kinane, deputising for the banned Kieren Fallon. While none of his notorious exploits were evident during the preliminaries, he missed the kick at the start and lost ground before racing freely in last place. Gaining on the leaders in the stretch, he was finishing strongly on the run to the line to get within 1 1/4 lengths of the winner and runner-up Killybegs. "We had the pacemaker in there to make it a consistent, true gallop and we were hoping they would follow and George would follow the field," O'Brien said. "They chose not to, and it wouldn't have been fair to ask George to follow him after he'd been off so long--automatically it turned into a sprint. Mick was happy with him and said when he let him down he was very rusty. He said it was only in the last furlong that he got going. He tore all the muscles off the top of his pelvis down into his hindquarters, and another horse wouldn't be here, but we knew that if we didn't make today, there was no point in looking at the rest of the season. We'd rather him be finishing than not finishing, and Mick had to put him to sleep and give him a lot to do, because we wanted him to be enjoying it. It's a long time since he's run and he had never worked off the bridle, so we couldn't be happier, other than he didn't win. He'll have a run under his belt in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. [at Ascot Sept. 23] and we won't run a pacemaker. He'll be like Alexandrova--if they walk, he'll walk at the back and if they fly, he'll be cantering along at the back and it won't matter then."



"He was so relaxed and I had so much horse, it gave me a good feel going to the first turn," winning jockey David Clark said. "When [Last Answer] came outside, I knew he had some fight left in him." George Brunacini, who bred 2005 Travers Stakes (gr. I) winner Flower Alley, Central Kentucky horseman Dan Mallory, and trainer Jeff Williams were among the 49 victims of Sunday morning's crash of a commuter jet shortly after takeoff from Blue Grass Airport in Lexington, Ky. Brunacini, who operated Bona Terra Farm and also bred Grade II winner Victory U.S.A., was confirmed among the flight victims by WLEX-TV. Mallory, who operated Meadow Haven Farm and was regular consignor to Fasig-Tipton and Keeneland sales, was on the flight, according to Tim Boyce, sales director for Fasig-Tipton Texas. Mallory was en route to the FT Texas sale that will be held Monday and Tuesday. Mallory served as president of the Kentucky Farm Managers' Club in 1989 and bred several stakes winners alone and in partnership, including graded winners American Spirit and Traces of Gold. Williams, 49, who was based at the Thoroughbred Center in Lexington but race primarily in Ohio, entered the business through his association with polo ponies and the Dayton Polo Club in Centerville, Ohio, according to John Engelhardt, publicity director at River Downs racetrack. He went on to become an assistant trainer with W.E. "Smiley" Adams in the late '70s and began an association with Ohio's Woodburn Farm through the 1980s. He conditioned 10 stakes winners for Woodburn Farm, including 1985 Ohio 2-year-old champion Astrotot. Dayton attorney Larry Denny had a decades-long association with Williams through both Thoroughbreds and polo ponies. "He was an outstanding trainer of young horses. One of the best caretakers I'd ever seen," stated Denny, who put himself through college as a blacksmith. "Jeff and I were partners. We'd buy lots of horses, I'd shoe him, he'd exercise them. We'd get green horses from Oklahoma, off the track, wherever, and he could teach them to turn, stop and get them broke to mallet." Williams and Denny played together for years on the Dayton Polo Club. "We won the Mid-States Tournament in Louisville one year and Jeff scored the winning goal. He won the 'Best Playing Pony Award' and sold the mare Mariposa for what was then a record price. A lot of the polo horses he trained went on to be the best ponies on the circuit. He went on to work for Bart Evans, one of the most respected horsemen in the sport of polo." According to the Associated Press, the lone survivor was the co-pilot, who was in critical condition at University Hospital in Lexington. Investigators were trying to determine if the plane was on the wrong runway and ran out of pavement. *Click for complete story.*

STABLEMATES SHIROCCO, HURRICANE RUN

COULD MEET IN FOY Michael Tabor's Hurricane Run (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) and Baron Georg von Ullmann's Shirocco (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) could prep for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in next Sunday's G2 Prix Foy. Trainer Andre Fabre told the *Racing Post* that Shirocco may avoid the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden Sept. 3 and join his stable companion in the Longchamp trial, run over the Arc course and distance. "Hurricane Run is in very good shape and will run in the Foy, but it has not been decided yet if Shirocco runs at Baden-Baden or not," he told the Post. "I am waiting on the forfeits and the ground and I need to speak with the owner Baron von Ullmann. The German race is very tempting, but I don't want him to have a hard race, and the German horses could be pretty good. If he doesn't run in Germany, he will run in the Foy too." Fabre dispelled concerns about last year's Arc winner Hurricane Run running against the GI Breeders' Cup Turf hero before the autumn showpiece. "Hurricane Run and Shirocco have already run together before and they will run together in the Arc, so I don't mind. The Foy is only a prep race, and they might even be beaten by a third horse." Christophe Soumillon looks set to partner Shirocco after the Post revealed that His Highness the Aga Khan's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club winner Darsi (Fr) (Polish Precedent) and G2 Prix Greffulhe scorer Visindar (GB) (Sinndar {Ire}) would miss the race after being ruled out for the season.
