FLEET INDIAN TO BE SOLD AT KEENOV

Paul Saylor's **Fleet Indian** (Indian Charlie--Hustleeta, by Afleet), winner of last Friday's GI Personal Ensign S. at Saratoga, is scheduled to go through the ring at the Keeneland November sale 10 months after selling to Saylor for \$290,000 at the Keeneland January sale. Taylor Made Sales Agency will consign the five-year-old. A restricted stakes winner prior to being purchased by Dapple Bloodstock on behalf of

Saylor at the 2005 renewal of the January sale, Fleet Indian has gone on to become one of the best of her division. A perfect five-for-five wearing Saylor's colors, all in stakes company, the Todd Pletcher trainee's wins include the \$1 million GI Delaware H. and the Personal Ensign ([Video](#)), her first Grade I score. Thus far, she has earned over \$1.1 million in 2006. Fleet Indian was a \$40,000 FTNAUG yearling purchase by Leprechaun Racing in 2002, and was resold by that outfit to Stan Fulton for \$230,000 as an OBSMAR juvenile. Jimmy Toner trained Fleet Indian for Fulton.

SPRINT SHOWDOWN AT BELMONT

There's still a week of racing remaining at historic Saratoga Racecourse, but it's hard not to get excited about a potential match-up between Belmont Park specialist **Silver Train** (Old Trieste) and GI King's Bishop S. winner **Henny Hughes** (Hennessy) in the GI Vosburgh S. at Big Sandy Oct. 7. "Obviously, running against older horses, you have to respect [Silver Train] at that track, for sure, and that outfit, but you have to run against them," trainer Kieran McLaughlin told *Daily Racing Form*. "But we're not ducking anybody or worrying about anybody." The GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and GI Met Mile hero has been freshened since his score in the GI Tom Fool H. July 16. He posted a five-furlong workout in 1:00 at the Big A Aug. 8.

IRRIDESCENCE HEADING TO FRANCE

Team Valor's **Irridescence (SAf)** (Caesour) is being lined up for a French campaign which will begin Sunday in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp. Rested since beating Best Gift (NZ) and Ouija Board (GB) in the Apr. 23 G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin, the Mike de Kock-trained five-year-old will tackle the mile contest before a crack at the Oct. 1 G1 Prix de l'Opera de Longchamp, where she could meet Oaks heroine Alexandrova (Ire). "We do not expect to win the Moulin, as that would be unlikely for a 10-furlong mare, but we hope to get a good race into her that will help her perform up to snuff in the l'Opera, which right now is starting to look like a very hot contest, what with Alexandrova pointing for it," Team Valor President Barry Irwin said on www.teamvalor.com. Jockey Weichong Marwing has retained the ride aboard the mare. "Irridescence won the Queen Elizabeth Cup, but she could not have accomplished the feat without a brilliant ride from Weichong," Irwin continued. "In deciding to have him ride Irridescence next week, we hope in part to have him evaluate her current state of preparedness for the l'Opera. Mike de Kock, who will receive the mare when she is finished racing in France, has been kind enough to allow Weichong to ride the Irridescence for us in both of her upcoming French races."

GEORGE STILL HAS QEII AIM

Aidan O'Brien reported Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's **George Washington (Ire)** (Daneshill), a comeback third in the G2 Celebration Mile at Goodwood, has emerged from the race less than 100 percent, but is still expected to contest the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. Sept. 23 at Ascot. "He seems to be fine, but a small bit stiff which is understandable as Sunday was the first time that muscle was really stretched fully," the Ballydoyle conditioner told *Racing Post*. "We'll see what he's like in a couple of days, but all going well the Queen Elizabeth II S. is the plan at the moment." Despite being sent off the 5-6 favorite for Sunday's mile contest, the G1 2000 Guineas hero could only fill the minor placings behind Caradak (Ire). That was the colt's first outing since sustaining a muscular injury after finishing runner-up in the May 27 G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh.

After the weekend of all weekends at Saratoga, the Darley bandwagon keeps rolling and it was Notability who carried the maroon and white colors to an all-the-way success for the sponsors. Kept in handicap company last season, he scored at Chester before finishing a short-head second to Home Affairs (GB) at Haydock in May. The bay was off the board in his next three starts, but returned to his best on his first try at stakes level when third behind Echo of Light (GB) in the G3 Summer Mile S. on Lingfield's Polytrack July 15. Runner-up to Belenus (Ire) in the G3 Sovereign S. at Salisbury last time Aug. 17, Notability led at every step here under an enterprising Philip Robinson and was always holding the late challenge of Azarole.

Early in last year's Saratoga meet, Henny Hughes was accorded the status of a coming superstar. Successful by six lengths on his debut, he had won the Tremont S. at Belmont by 15 lengths, and followed up at the Spa with a powerful 3 3/4-length triumph in the GII Saratoga Special. At that point, however, his domination of the two-year-old ranks came to an end. In the GI Hopeful S., he could never make the lead, and took second 4 1/4 lengths behind Fusaichi Samurai, while in the GI Champagne S., he roared through suicidal early fractions before again finishing second to First Samurai, this time beaten 2 3/4 lengths. In the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, Henny Hughes took command in the early stages and set a more controlled pace. He took revenge on Fusaichi Samurai, holding that rival at bay by two lengths, but lost out on a shot at the juvenile title when caught late by Stevie Wonderboy.

Henny Hughes had been purchased by Sheikh Mohammed's Darley operation after the Tremont, and he wintered in Dubai. Apparently all did not go well there, and he remained unraced through that country's major events. Returned to the U.S., and the barn of Kiaran McLaughlin (who had taken over from original trainer Patrick Biancone after the Champagne), Henny Hughes didn't make his three-year-old debut until July 1, when he devastated the field in GIII Jersey Shore Breeders' Cup S., winning by 10 lengths. On Saturday, he finally arrived at full fledged superstar status, taking the GI King's Bishop S. by 5 1/4 lengths.

Like his son, Henny Hughes' sire Hennessy also lost his shot at a champion two-year-old title when second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, in his case after a titanic struggle with Unbridled's Song. Hennessy, who only raced at two, had earlier shown some spectacular form to take the GII Hollywood Juvenile Championship by 5 1/2 lengths; the GII Sapling S. by 9 3/4 lengths; and the GI Hopeful S. by 3 1/4 lengths.

Hennessy has sired 35 stakes winners in his first six Northern Hemisphere crops, including, in addition to Henny Hughes, Johannesburg--the champion two-year-old in North America, England, Ireland and France--other graded winners Madcap Escapade and Harmony Lodge; Grade II winners Keats, Toasted, Distilled and Blazonry. We should note that Johannesburg is making a sensational start this year, his first-crop two-year-olds already in-

cluding GII Sanford S. winner Scat Daddy; G2 Richmond S. winner Hamood; G3 Round Tower S. winner Rabatash; and Listed scorer Marcavelly, and this will obviously increase Henny Hughes's already considerable allure when he retires to stud.

Henny Hughes was bred in Kentucky, but his family is one which has previously mostly made its name in the Mid-Atlantic. The upsurge in the female line's fortunes can be traced to Short Winded, Henny Hughes's third dam. Short Winded was by the rather obscure Harvest Singing, a son of Nasrullah, who won five races and \$21,530 in the late 1950s without ever earning black-type. Harvest Singing appears never to have sired a stakes winner, and with the exception of the descendants of Short Winded, appears in the pedigree of only one other stakes winner. This distaff side of Short Winded's pedigree wasn't a lot more inspiring. In fact, the best horse produced by her dam, the Alquest mare Wind Cloud, besides Short Winded, was her brother Long Winded, who raced for seven years to win 12 races and \$44,407. Although these appear extremely unlikely credentials for a dynasty founder, Short Winded herself did at least have the virtue of being tough, as she ran for five years, making 58 starts and winning five times for earnings of \$32,306.

Toughness was a virtue which Short Winded appeared to pass on to her offspring, as 11 of her 12 foals made it to the track, 10 of them winning. She did particularly well with the Maryland sire Hagley (by Olden Times), a fast two-year-old who trained on to take the Withers S. at three. Three of Short Winded's Hagley offspring earned black-type--Henny Hughes's granddam Shortley, and the stakes-placed pair of Vodka Talking and Breathless Wind. Vodka Talking produced stakes winner Rollodka, and is granddam of graded winner Gin Talking, and third dam of graded scorer Dixie Talking.

Incidentally, no fewer than four other daughters of Short Winded went on to produced stakes winners, and two bred graded scorers: the Dancing Count mare Countess Shorwind became dam of the GIII Laurel Turf Cup H. winner Algar; and her sister Short Encounter is dam of the GII Gotham S. and GIII Best Turn S. victor Romano Gucci.

Shortley, the third of five Hagley foals out of the dam, turned out to be the best on the racetrack. Successful in the Caesar's Wish S. at two, Shortley won three stakes as a four-year-old, her most prestigious triumph coming in the GIII First Flight H., and she retired with the impressive record of nine wins, two seconds and two thirds in 14 starts.

Oddly enough, in view of the success at stud enjoyed by some of her siblings, Shortley herself failed to produce a stakes winner, and although she did throw seven winners from seven runners, her best were the Maryland Million and Politely S. third Shortpoint (by Two Punch) and Henny Hughes's dam, Meadow Flyer, a daughter of Meadowlake, who started just twice, winning her maiden and taking second in the Pasadena S. at Santa Anita.

For quite a while it looked as if Meadow Flyer was also going to disappoint as a broodmare. Seven of her eight foals prior to Henny Hughes won races, but the highest earner, Catlike Dancer (by Tale of the Cat, and therefore a three-parts sister to Henny Hughes), scored the last of her six victories when running for a \$5,000 claiming tag at Charles Town.

Usually, when a horse is as big an upgrade over the immediate family as is Henny Hughes, we can spot a pedigree reason, but the King's Bishop winner is quite an enigma in this regard. He represents the cross of a Storm Cat-line stallion over a Prince John-line mare, and this is so far found in only three other unrestricted stakes winners (including another out of a mare by Henny Hughes's broodmare sire, Meadowlake), although we admit, with the number of good-quality Prince John-line mares being greatly diminished these days, the cross wouldn't have had a particularly good opportunity. The pedigree is an outcross at five generations, and doesn't appear to have a particularly high degree of consanguinity at six generations, or even beyond.

If we had to light on one particular factor, it would be commonalities present in Storm Cat's dam, Terlingua, and Meadowlake and his sire, Hold Your Peace. Meadowlake is a Princequillo-line horse, inbred to Blue Larkspur and Sir Gallahad III, and his sire, Hold Your Peace, is out of a mare by Eight Thirty. Terlingua is by Secretariat (dam by Princequillo). In her dam, she has Balladier (bred on the same cross as Blue Larkspur), Sir Gallahad III and Eight Thirty, and Terlingua's fourth dam, Rare Bloom, is a three-quarters relative to Ample, third dam of Hold Your Peace, so the overall background is fairly similar. We really wouldn't want to be dogmatic about this being the key to the pedigree, however, and since we're informed that Hennessy was chosen for Meadow Flyer for reasons of physique rather than pedigree, perhaps he's best understood as a success for a mating of compatible types, and whose pedigree gelled for reasons which can't easily be ascertained.

MOVERS AND SHAKERS

As I was dreamily paging my way through Book 1 of the Keeneland September Sale, idly wondering whether I was looking at a catalogue which, like last year's, is going to gross \$184 million and average \$500,000 a horse, it did seem to me like I was seeing the same names over and over again. So I got out my trusty calculator and pencil (I always like that capability to erase everything and start over), and counted up that there are 17 sires with 10 or more yearlings catalogued in Book 1. Sure enough, I had been seeing the same names over and over: of the 474 yearlings catalogued for Book 1, no fewer than 351 of them (74 percent) were by one of these 17 sires. If you want to talk about a concentration of commercial power, here's how I figure it: if 70 percent of the yearlings catalogued by these 17 sires actually sell (very possible), and if they average the same as last year's Book 1 (just over \$495,000), about 250 yearlings by these 17 sires will generate around \$125 million in sales. That would be at least two-thirds of the revenues in Book 1, about half the revenues in Books 1 and 2 combined, and about a third of the revenues for the whole sale, if things stay roughly the same as last year.

Since these 17 sires also have 267 yearlings catalogued in Book 2 (34 percent of the 794 catalogued) and 164 in succeeding Books (just 4 percent of Books 3-7), it seems not at all unlikely that these 17 sires will account for between 40-50 percent of the nearly \$400 million this sale could generate. We'll be looking in more detail at Book 1-2 sires next week, and Book 3-7 sires once the sale is underway--but it's also just worth pointing out, before we sink into the morass of numbers, just who the real power brokers are among North American commercial yearling sires.

Three of the 17 are this year's North American Big Three among the debutants with their first yearlings selling: Mineshaft (17 catalogued in Book 1), Empire Maker (28), and Vindication (29). Sky Mesa and Aldebaran, the other two first-year sires who figure to finish the sales season with six-figure yearling averages, don't really get going until Book 2, along with this year's top Freshman Sires (first two-year-olds), like Johannesburg and Officer--well, make that Book 3 for Officer.

The point is that Book 1 last year averaged \$495,199, so no room for little boys with short pants--heavy hitters only, please. The market says there are 14 of them, including what must just about be the last by the great and long-lived Danzig (16 in Book 1), arguably Northern Dancer's very best and most important sire son; and a very impressive collection of pedigrees by the world's top contemporary sire, Storm Cat. He has 28 catalogued in Book 1, including some seriously blockbuster, almost certainly eight-digit (\$10 million-plus) pedigrees. A.P. Indy and Kingmambo, also among the world's top five commercial sires, though maybe for different continents, have 20 each in Book 1. Elders include Gone West (28 in Book 1), possibly about to become only the second significant sire branch from Mr. Prospector (after Fappiano); a similarly revived Seeking the Gold (16); and Barbaro's sire, Dynaformer (14).

Those are the seven veteran sires with double-figure representation in September Book 1. The other seven represent the top one or two North American commercial sires in five consecutive sire 'crops': with first foals 1998, Unbridled's Song (26 in Book 1); first foals 1999, Pulpit (11); first foals 2000, Distorted Humor (23) and Elusive Quality (16); first foals 2001, Forestry (13); and first foals 2002, Giant's Causeway (18) and Fusaichi Pegasus (28). The one who is going to make the biggest commercial leap this year, by far, figures to be Distorted Humor. **Oppenheim cont.**

His stud fee had already more than doubled, from \$20,000 in 2003 (after he had been Leading Freshman sire in 2002, over Awesome Again and Elusive Quality, on the disqualification of Elusive City) to \$50,000 in 2004; so the breeders of this year's yearlings have already spent enough on the stud fee that they must have thought a bit of the mare they were breeding to the horse. Besides the 23 catalogued in Book 1, off that \$50,000 stud fee, Distorted Humor also has 22 in Book 2 and 28 more in later books--73 total. The good ones figure to sell really big, and if they don't, they're a bargain.

First Foals 2001...

Referring back to a table of leading 'younger' sires (first foals 1998-2002) we ran on Aug. 8 (p. 12), we found convincing evidence that '3 is the new 4'--meaning that the leading APEX sires used to register A Runner Indexes of 4.00+, but now they are mostly 3.00+. To hit 4.00 is a rarity, in fact only Distorted Humor (first foals 2000, 4.14) achieves this standard among what I would call the 'World Top 12 Younger Sires.' That 'World Top 12' ranking required most young sires to have had 250 or more year-starters to qualify (200 if they are first foals 2002), and there are a number of stallions from the group of 110 'first foals 2001' sires who have impressive figures with their number of year-starters around the 200 mark. If they continue to progress, they can move up to the top group. More of them in a minute. But first, let's recognize the two sires from this group who do make the 'younger' World Top 12, Forestry (3.79) and Cape Cross (2.83). Forestry is knocking on the door of stardom, and Discreet Cat could be the one to confirm his sire as a genuine World Top 12 candidate. Already Forestry has the second best A Runner Index of any 'younger' sire, behind only Distorted Humor, so all that's needed is a genuine 'household name': Discreet Cat, The Green Monkey--either will do.

Forestry was a King's Bishop (Grade I--and a top race for producing sires right now) winner by Storm Cat, and the top European 'first foals 2001' sire is Cape Cross (2.83), by Danzig's number-two sire son, Green Desert, who flies under the Darley banner. It looks very interesting that numbers 9-12 on the Younger World Top 12 list are probably, respectively, two of Darley's top three young sires, and two of Coolmore's top three. Darley has Cape Cross (2.83) and Singspiel (2.76); Coolmore has Montjeu (2.79) and Giant's Causeway (2.71). Incidentally, the other top young sire for each--Elusive Quality for Darley, Danehill Dancer for Coolmore--both have A Runner indices under 2.00. Cape Cross and Forestry are two of the three 'first foals 2001' sires tied for the lead with 22 APEX A Runners (meaning one horse can be an A Runner each season it races); the third is Archers Bay, the 1998 Canadian champion three-year-old (Queen's Plate, etc.) by Silver Deputy. I believe he died before he ever had a runner, but his three crops have had phenomenal success, as illustrated by his league-leading 5.37 A Runner Index. He, unluckily, had no chance to build on his great success, but six others from this group with under 250 year-starters do show an awful lot of promise: Tiger Hill (2.96 A Index); Intikhab (2.91); Menifee (2.44); Verglas (2.37); Military (2.00); and Gold Away (1.90). With these relatively younger stallions, quantity of success is often as good a pointer as quality (because the more numbers a sire has, the more the tendency is for their quality ratings to drop). In this regard, Victory Gallop deserves a mention for topping the group with 59 ABC Runners, ahead of Cape Cross (58) and Forestry (56). Old Trieste, a son of A.P. Indy and another who unfortunately died young, was clearly on his way to being a good sire, as Silver Train demonstrates; and another son of A.P. Indy, Malibu Moon, is about to have his first Kentucky crop sell after racking up impressive statistics from his Maryland crops.
