MASSCAP CANCELLED AGAIN

The GII Massachusetts Breeders' Cup H., scheduled for Sept. 30 at Suffolk Downs, has been cancelled for the second straight year, track management announced vesterday. The East Boston track's signature race was slated to have a purse of \$300,000. "We continue to be negatively impacted by the onslaught of gaming in Rhode Island and Connecticut, and the current impasse in the legislature has caused a troubling atmosphere of uncertainty," explained Suffolk Downs Chief Operating Officer Bob O'Malley. "We are concerned about finishing our fall meet and the possibility of a protracted shut down in 2007 due to the impending expiration of enabling legislation." Suffolk Downs officials indicated that they had postponed the decision to cancel the MassCap in hopes that legislation could be passed in informal session, granting Suffolk additional flexibility in its racing schedule for the year. However, at a recent meeting of the state's four pari-mutuel licensees, it was determined that a compromise could not be reached. Legislation enabling the Massachusetts tracks to simulcast expired at the end of 2005. A bill passed in informal session in December allowed the tracks to continue to operate until Apr. 1, 2006. Following a six-day shutdown, new legislation in April extended simulcasting through the end of this year.

WALERIA BEATS THE BOYS

The streaking Waleria (Ger) (Artan {Ire}) proved too strong for her male rivals as she recorded her second stakes score and fifth straight win overall despite being the sole filly in the line-up. Coming here off success in the Listed Grosser Zentis-Stutenpreis at Krefeld July 30, she was settled towards the rear of the tightly bunched field by Andreas Suborics. The brown filly made her move against the stands' rail in the straight, battled past the long-time leader Senor Dali (Ire) (Peintre Celebre) inside the final 50 yards and asserted for a convincing success. Aspectus (Ire) (Spectrum {Ire}), favored at 11-10 off his victory two back in the G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen, was third into the straight, but failed to quicken and finished fifth, beaten about 4 1/2 lengths in the finish.





'WITNESS' CONFIRMED FOR DEFENSE Silent

He failed to break through in four subsequent starts, his best effort coming in a runner-up finish in the G1-HK Queen's Silver Jubilee Cup in April. Silent Witness has won 18 of his 24 starts to date for earnings in excess of HK\$58 million.
