off at 1-4 in the July 7 Albert the Great S. at Belmont, he once again filled the role of runner-up. The margin was so close in the Aug. 5 GI Whitney S. that trainer Nick Zito wasn't sure if Sun King or Invasor (Arg) got the decision. Unfortunately for him, it was Invasor. "When the horses are ding-donging, you can't tell who's in front," Zito admitted. "It's just a head bob. I hope he gets a good journey [this time]." The Brooklyn native has also entered Andromeda's Hero (Fusaichi Pegasus), who took a Saratoga allowance test July 31; and the speedy Wanderin Boy (Seeking the Gold). Runner-up to Invasor in the May 19 GI Pimlico Special, Wanderin Boy romped by seven lengths in an optional claimer in the mud at Belmont June 25, but faltered to sixth after pressing the pace in the Whitney. "They're all doing well," Zito said.



Amadeus Wolf failed to see out the mile of the G1 2000 Guineas May 7, but performed with credit to be seventh. A fine fifth in the June 24 G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot, he was fourth in the G1 July Cup and filled the third spot in the Aug. 6 G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest. The three-year-old was beaten just two lengths when second to **Reverence** last time. Jockey Neil Callan remarked, "My fellow goes on any ground and is in great form. He came bouncing out of the York race and looks really well." Reverence has yet to win a stakes race over this trip, but showed lethal speed over Britain's minimum distance when taking the May 30 G2 Temple S. and the Nunthorpe. "[Trainer] Eric [Alston] says the horse has never been as well--he's bucking and kicking and is in absolutely top form," ownerbreeder Gary Middlebrook told PA Sport. "He's bigger and stronger now and I think he'll definitely get six." Veteran Quito has charted an unorthodox route to the top, having emerged in his later years from handicap company to make the metamorphosis into stakes performer. He demonstrated what a force he is over seven furlongs this term when winning the June 8 Listed John of Gaunt S. at this course and last Thursday's Listed City of York S., but he was also runner-up in the May 17 G2 Duke of York S. and sixth in the July Cup over this trip. His warm-up in Sunday's Listed Beverley Bullet S. did not go to planned, as his saddle slipped in the closing stages, but the nine-year-old is reported at the top of his game. Trainer David Chapman told PA Sport, "There should be plenty of pace on, which would suit him. We are very hopeful." In the supporting cast is Balthazaar's Gift, who has strong claims on his G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte success in November and his fast-finishing second to Les Arcs in the Golden Jubilee. He has to rebound from a below-par effort when trailing in the Maurice de Gheest, but trainer Tom George believes there were excuses for that run. "There was a catalogue of things that went wrong at Deauville," he told PA Sport. "He got very upset in the stalls and he was very sore after the race. He's recovered very well though and he's in good order."

The five-year-old gave Frankel his third Forego score, winning by a half-length a year ago, but has been unable to get back to the winner's circle since. Second in the GI Cigar Mile H. to end 2005, the dark bay returned to be fourth in the Apr. 8 GI Carter H. and has since filled the



show spot in the May 29 GI Met Mile H. and Aug. 12 GII Vanderbilt BC H. Commentator, a perfect three-for-three at the Spa, beat subsequent Horse of the Year Saint Liam by a neck in the GI Whitney H. last summer. Sidelined by a sore shin after finishing third in the GI Woodward S. last September, the chestnut gelding came back after a 10-month absence to gallop home a 6 1/4-length winner Commentator A Coglianese in the state-bred Mugatea S. at

Belmont July 12, running his record to eight-for-10. He has been working sharply for his second start off the layoff, prepping for the Forego with a bullet half in :47 1/5 Aug. 26. Nightmare Affair rides a four-race winning streak into this Grade I test. The winner of three straight sprint stakes this spring, the five-year-old was overlooked at 14-1 in the July 15 GII Smile Sprint H., but closed from the back of the pack to best **Pomeroy** by two lengths. The Smile runner-up was making his first start since finishing eighth in the Vosburgh last year. The winner of the 2004 GI King's Bishop S., he has been first or second in all four Saratoga starts.

Island Fashion has yet to win in six starts on the turf, but she could turn it around here. The six-year-old mare was beaten a head by Amorama in the GI John C. Mabee H. on the Del Mar lawn last season. She failed to make an impact when off the board in the Aug. 21 GI Pacific Classic and Oct. 29 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, but layered those disappointing efforts between thirds in the Oct. 2 GII Lady's Secret BC H. and Dec. 11 GII Bayakoa H. Sent to Dubai for her 2006 opener in the G2 Godolphin Mile, the gray could do no better than seventh, but she resurfaced in this year's edition of the Mabee and just missed, finishing third by a neck. Winless since the '05 Mabee, Amorama was fourth for the third straight time in that event last time out, but was beaten only a half-length for all the money. She ran second behind champion Intercontinental (GB) in the Palomar last year. Five-year-old Mea Domina, a maiden winner over this course at three, has won six of eight starts on the lawn. She came back after nine months on the bench to be third behind Polyfirst and Three Degrees in the Aug. 9 Osunitas H. and should be sharper in her second start back.



## **CHEMOTHERAPY NEXT FOR LOST IN THE FOG**

Lost in the Fog, champion sprinter of 2005, will begin chemotherapy treatments for his cancer at the University of California at Davis next week, trainer Greg Gilchrist said Sept. 1. The process could last for as long as nine months. Gilchrist, during a brief teleconference from Golden Gate Fields, said the hope is that chemotherapy can put the four-year-old colt's lymphoma into remission and give the horse as much as two years of quality life. "It would have to be a miracle for Lost in the Fog to be cured," Gilchrist said. "This is something that puts it into remission and allows him to go on." Gilchrist, along with owner Harry Aleo, were disappointed to learn earlier in the day that Lost in the Fog's tumors had not shrunk in size since the horse began treatment with injections of the corticosteroid Dexamethasone 10 days ago. "Doctors came down from the university Thursday to do a scan," he said. "Nothing had changed. Nothing had gotten any smaller. Nothing had gotten any larger." Aleo and Gilchrist made the decision on chemotherapy on the advice of Dr. Gary Magdesian, UCD's chief of equine medicine. For the complete story, click here.
