In 1999, trainer Todd Pletcher saddled Michael Tabor's Circle of Life to victory in the GI Spinaway S. Yesterday, her second foal, **Circular Quay** (Thunder

Gulch), capped another stellar Saratoga season for the Tabor/Pletcher juggernaut, rocketing down the lane to take the GI Hopeful S. by a widening 4 1/4 lengths. A dozen lengths behind the field after a sluggish start and an opening quarter in :22.36, he still had eight lengths to make up on the

next-to-last horse after a half in :44.88. His four rivals were lined up across the track at the top of the lane, but jockey Garrett Gomez wheeled Circular Quay to the outside and hit the gas and the two-year-old zipped to the front in a matter of strides, winning handily. "I didn't want to be that far back, but they were all in a drive at the five-eighths pole, so I just sat on him," Gomez said. "I just kept waiting on him, and finally at the three-eighths pole I said, 'I'm tired of waiting, it's time to go.' He just took off." Hopeful cont. p2

Circular Quay was away slowly in his career opener at Churchill Downs June 15, but overcame a lackluster break to cruise home a 6 1/4-length winner. The Doreen Tabor-bred juvenile was bet down to 6-5 in the July 8 GIII Bashford Manor S. and lived up to his odds. Once again saving his best for the stretch run, he was caught in traffic, but fought his way through along the rail to take it by 1 1/4 lengths. The odds-on favorite as part of an entry with Scat Daddy in the Hopeful, the chestnut trailed as Pegasus Wind (Fusaichi Pegasus) dueled Irish Ace (Grand Slam) on the front end. Scat Daddy and Unbridled Express joined the fray as they straightened for home, with the latter taking a short lead at the eighth pole, but Circular Quay blew by them as his stablemate fought on to get second. "I think this puts both horses right at the top of the class," Todd Pletcher said. Plans for the duo are undecided. "I'm not crazy about the Champagne [GI, Oct. 14] being three weeks before the Breeders' Cup [Churchill Downs, Nov. 4]," he remarked.
