Principle Secret may not be here, but stablemate Prime Ruler (Orientate) could be an able deputy. He earned big speed figures for his debut win going 5 1/2 panels over this surface Aug. 5, but breaks from the rail here and will need to work out a good trip. Great Hunter (Aptitude) sheds his blinkers after runner-up finishes in both the Best Pal and the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship S. July 4.

BELLAMY ROAD TO HURRICANE HALL

Kinsman Stable's Grade I winner Bellamy Road (Concerto--Hurry Home Hillary, by Deputed Testamony) has been retired and will enter stud in 2007 at Hurricane Hall in Lexington, Kentucky, according to a press release. The four-year-old, currently being syndicated,

will stand for \$10,000, live foal. An \$87,000 OBSAPR purchase as a juvenile by Kinsman, the Floridabred began his career for trainer Michael Dickinson, capturing his debut and the GIII MGD Cradle S. He was transferred to Nick Zito ahead of his three-year-old campaign and kicked off 2005 with a

15 3/4-length allowance win at Gulfstream. The dark bay followed with an electrifying 17 1/2-length victory in the GI Wood Memorial S., equalling Aqueduct's track record of 1:47 for nine furlongs. Seventh as the favorite in the GI Kentucky Derby, Bellamy Road didn't start again until the GI Travers S. in August, when he finished second in what would be his final career start. "Few horses enter stud that were as athletically gifted as Bellamy Road," said Ben P. Walden Jr., president of Hurricane Hall. "His New York track record was accomplished in a hand ride by over 17 lengths." Walden added, "Bellamy Road is a freak, along the lines of a Red Ransom, a Danzig or a Seattle Slew. He is the perfect first stallion for us."

NO BREEDERS' CUP FOR FALLON

Kieren Fallon has decided not to apply to ride at the Nov. 4 Breeders' Cup meeting at Churchill Downs. Ballydoyle's retained jockey was denied a licence to ride in last month's GI Arlington Million, and the prospect of further delays caused by the deliberations of the Kentucky officials has led to his latest decision. "Kieren Fallon has decided not to proceed with his application for a licence to ride in the United States at this time as there is a great deal of uncertainty around obtaining a licence in time for the Breeders' Cup, to be held in Kentucky," read a statement made by the rider's legal representative, Christopher Stewart-Moore of Ralph Davis Solicitors. KENNETT SQUARE, PA...Kentucky Derby winner Barbaro continues to please veterinarians with his progress after his most recent right hind leg cast change last week. "Barbaro is wearing the new cast satisfactorily," said Dr. Dean W. Richardson, Chief of Surgery. "We continue to monitor him closely, and depending on how he progresses, we may change it again within the next two weeks." The colt's left hind foot, which has laminitis, continues to improve gradually, according to Dr. Richardson. The bandage on this foot is changed daily. "Barbaro's appetite is great, and we take him out each day to hand graze him," said Dr. Richardson. "His vital signs remain normal, and he seems very happy." Barbaro is in the Intensive Care Unit of the University of Pennsylvania's George D. Widener Hospital, where he is recovering from injuries suffered at the Preakness on May 20. The next update will be posted Tuesday, Sept. 12 unless there is a significant change in Barbaro's condition.

BOOK 1-2 SIRES


The Doncaster sales company's 'St. Leger' yearling sale set a new record with an average of 32,158 guineas last week (over \$60,000), that figure a 30-percent gain over last year's average. The sale had been moved to last week from this week because of redevelopment at Doncaster racecourse, but you can bet your bottom dollar it will never move back, not when you had all the leading European agents there the week before they need to leave for Keeneland. Doncaster has been one of a number of yearling sales already this season to register good results--Fasig July, Saratoga, Deauville, and Baden-Baden among the 'majors'--and now that the warm-ups are completed, it's time to move on to the main event--Keeneland September.

Last year's sale shattered, by more than \$55-million, the all-time record for a horse sale, when 3,571 yearlings (a phenomenal 70 percent of 5,097 catalogued) sold for \$381,349,900, and averaged \$106,791. I might mention, in this context, that this one sale accounted for nearly a third of the record \$1.175-billion 12-sale 'majors' total in 2005. Of all the thousands of statistics I have conjured over the years, this may be the single most staggering one of all: in 2005, nearly 12,000 horses averaged over \$100,000 each at those 12 sales. That really is mindblowing, that every year there could be 12,000 horses worth over \$100,000 each. They sure weren't worth that much, even relatively speaking, when they were plowing fields, pulling carts, and carrying people into battle.

Though it is all one sale, nothing illustrates the tiers of the marketplace better than the September Sale, either. Book 1 last year averaged over \$495,000. By the time we drew breath for our day off on the first Friday last year, 917 yearlings had been sold for \$268,815,000, an average of over \$293,000.

Those first four days constituted 70 percent of the gross for the entire 14-day sale, and almost 23 percent of the whole 12-sale, \$1.175-billion total. So it's a very important week coming up, to be guilty of massive understatement.

Last week we published the list of 17 stallions with double-figure representation in Book 1; a massive 74 percent of the yearlings in Book 1 are by one of these 17 sires, which I think demonstrates how commercially powerful these top stallions really are. Today I want to look at Books 1 and 2 combined; there are 125 stallions total represented by the 1,268 yearlings catalogued in the first two books, but the first thing we have to note is that the top 17 also account for 34 percent of the yearlings (267 of 794) in Book 2.



Combined, therefore, the 17 stallions we highlighted last week account for 618 of the 1,268 catalogued in the first two books--almost 49 percent of the total. The influence of these 17 stallions on the market cannot, therefore, possibly be understated. These are North America's most important commercial stallions, no doubt about it.

The next tier of commercial sires would have to be defined as all other stallions with double-figure representation in the first two books. There are 24 of these, with a combined 401 yearlings catalogued, roughly 30 percent of the total. So if we add the two together, 41 sires with double-figure representation in Keeneland Books 1 and 2 comprise 1,021 yearlings catalogued--80 percent of the total. So, on the accompanying table listing information about all 125 stallions represented, you can make a mental note that any with 10 or more catalogued in the first two books is among an elite group of 41 sires who really dominate the North American market.

Of the 24 not covered last week, 11 are sires whose first foals were born in 2001 or earlier, while 13 are 'younger' sires, whose first crops were born between 2002 (first four-year-olds this year) and 2005 (first yearlings). The 11 older sires include four who are properly 'older:' Deputy Minister (16 catalogued) and his son, Silver Deputy (17); the number three sire with first foals 1989 (behind Storm Cat and Gone West), Theatrical (13); and the number two sire with first foals 1994 (behind A.P. Indy), El Prado (16). The 1997 'sire crop' contributes Cherokee Run (17) and Mr. Greeley (20). From 1998, besides top-17 sire Unbridled's Song, we have Hennessy (11), Maria's Mon (10), and Smart Strike (10). From the 2000 sire crop, which includes Top 17 sires Distorted Humor and Elusive Quality, we can add the Coolmore '2000 Twins,' Grand Slam (48) and Tale of the Cat (33). Oddly, the one really top sire who is not among the 41 with 10 + catalogued in the first two books is Awesome Again (9); no doubt that will prove to be a one-year anomaly.

There are 13 more sires, with first four-year-olds or younger, with 10+ catalogued in the first two books. Besides the Coolmore Top-17 pair of Giant's Causeway and Fusaichi Pegasus, Dixie Union (10) and War Chant (12) represent the sire group with their first four-yearolds this year. Neither the group with first three-yearolds this year (F2003), nor the group with first twoyear-olds (F2004), were represented among the 17 sires with double-figure representation in Book 1 only. Four of those with first three-year-olds do have 10+ between the first two books: these are El Corrdeor (10), Forest Camp (12), Point Given (12), and Tiznow (12). Three sires with their first two-year-olds make the list: Came Home (14), Johannesburg (20), and Street Cry (19). Finally, and not surprisingly, sires with their first yearlings are well represented: besides Empire Maker (39 in Books 1-2 combined), Mineshaft (37), and Vindication (60) among the top 17 reviewed last week, four other sires with their first yearlings make this list: other probable six-figure average sires Aldebaran (24) and Sky Mesa (22), as well as the Airdrie pair of Harlan's Holiday (13) and Proud Citizen (12), both of whom were well received during Fasig-Tipton's season-opening New Sire Showcase.

Charged with conspiracy to defraud in July as a result of the City of London Police's investigation into alleged race fixing, Fallon is currently banned in Britain following a decision by the Horseracing Regulatory Authority not to renew his license. Fallon's legal team is in the process of contesting the ruling of the Illinois stewards which denied him the chance to ride at the Million meeting. He is free to ride in Ireland and in France, which would only outlaw him if asked to do so by the HRA. "Kieren feels this situation is untenable and unfair to Aidan O'Brien, who needs certainty in his arrangements for the Breeders' Cup," the statement continued. "He has regretfully made his decision known to the trainer and owners involved, and hopes they will enjoy a successful campaign."

CHANNON POINTS TO LEGER Trainer Mick Channon will saddle John Livock's Championship Point (Ire) (Lomitas {GB}) in Saturday's G1 St Leger at York, with Tony Culhane booked to ride the colt. Winner of the May 6 Listed Predominate S. at Goodwood, Championship Point has finished off the board in both the June 3 G1 Epsom Derby and G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York last time Aug. 22. After overseeing a piece of work involving Jaber Abdullah's Voltigeur winner Youmzain (Ire) (Sinndar {Ire}), who is being aimed at Sunday's G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp instead of the oldest Classic, the West Ilsley trainer was upbeat yesterday. "It was only half-speed work, but both horses are in good form and Championship Point worked great," Channon told PA Sport. For Culhane, it will be his first ride in a Classic. "I've not ridden him before, but obviously he must have come back to some form or he wouldn't be running," Culhane told PA Sport. "I'm hoping for the best."

WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES

We've written before in this column about the potential benefits of what we call a "Parallel Pattern." A "Parallel Pattern" would be defined by individuals in different halves of a pedigree being bred on a similar cross. So, on a pedigree chart, if you drew lines from the common ancestors down to the two subject individuals, you would get two sets of parallel lines. A variation on the theme is a "Reverse Parallel Pattern," where one key individual is bred on a reverse cross to another. These patterns seems to work particularly well when the sire and broodmare sire, or sire and dam, are the individuals, and in these cases, the "Parallel Pattern" often seems to offset what is general a low percentage play, that of crossing a mare back to a stallion from her own male line.

All of this is a preamble to discussion of a most unusual pedigree, that of Circular Quay, who rocketed to the top of the juvenile colts division with a remarkable last-to-first win in the GI Hopeful S. on Labor Day. A son of Thunder Gulch, Circular Quay is out Circle of Life, who was herself an example of a pedigree upgraded by a "Parallel Pattern." She was from the third crop of the good sprinter Belong to Me, who was then standing in New York at a stud fee of \$10,000.

Circle of Life's dam, Concentric, a daughter of Shadeed, failed to win in ten starts. Her granddam, Magic Circle (Alydar), did get bold black-type by virtue of a win in what used to be called a "Q" race (an allowance race which qualified as a black-type event), but her only black-type horse from 12 foals was Magic Squall, a Summer Squall colt who earned that distinction with a third in the Puss N Boots S. at Fort Erie.

What is more interesting than Circle of Life's female line is her pedigree pattern. Belong to Me is by Danzig-a son of Northern Dancer--out of a mare by Exclusive Native--a son of Raise a Native. Concentric is by a grandson of Northern Dancer in Shadeed out of a mare by Alydar, a son of Raise a Native. Therefore, both of Circle of Life's sire and dam are products of a Northern Dancer/Raise a Native cross. That the mating had created a somewhat special individual was clear very early on in Circle of Life's stud career. After realizing \$105,000 as a yearling, she was resold the following winter at the Fasig-Tipton Calder Sale for \$700,000. Circle of Life was also quick to prove her merit as a runner. In just four starts as a two-year-old, she won the GI Spinaway S. and took second in the GII Schuylerville S. and third in the GI Matron S.

Circular Quay's sire, Thunder Gulch, adds to the background, as he is by Gulch--a grandson of Raise a Native--out of a mare by Storm Bird--a son of Northern Dancer, so he is bred on a reverse cross to both Belong to Me and Concetric. So, Circular Quay is by a horse bred on Raise a Native/Northern Dancer cross, out of a mare whose sire and dam are Northern Dancer/Raise a Native crosses. Actually, this particular pedigree gets even more intriguing. Thunder Gulch's Raise a Native strain comes via Mr. Prospector, and his Northern Dancer strain comes via Storm Bird. This is particularly interesting when we recall that Circular Quay's granddam, Concentric, is by a son of Nijinsky II (bred on very similar lines to Storm Bird) and out of a mare by Alydar (bred on very similar lines to Mr. Prospector). Thus, one of "Parallel Patterns" in this pedigree also involves duplications via genetic relatives.

With regard to Nijinsky II and Alydar, we can note that this is far from the first time that they have proved profitable for Thunder Gulch. They also appear together in the pedigree of this year's GIII Selene S. winner, Seductively, whose dam is by Alydeed (by Shadeed out of an Alydar mare, and so bred on an identical cross to the granddam of Circular Quay). Nijinsky II is found in the pedigrees of at least six other Thunder Gulch stakes winners, including GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine, Spain, and Grade I winners Shot of Thunder and Sense of Style. Of course, Alydar comes up in the pedigree of Thunder Gulch's dual Classic-winning champion Point Given, who is out of a mare by Alydar's son Turkoman.

On the subject of Point Given, we should note that he has been gaining some serious momentum recently. His first crop now includes dual graded-stakes winner Go Between (another to combine Storm Bird and Nijinsky II), graded-winning and Grade I-placed Point Determined, and stakes winner The Max. His second crop, currently two-year-olds, already contains Naseem, who took the Lindsay Frolic S. at Calder Saturday in her career opener, and Point Ashley, who completed a great day for the sire line on Labor Day with a win in the GI Del Mar Debutante S.

"That might seem like a lot of money, but he is a lovely colt and is the spitting image of Elhamri," Kirk explained. Grove Stud were also responsible for the joint highest-priced filly of the session, an Orpen yearling offered as hip 129. Out of a half to last year's G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial winner Fracas (Ire), she was knocked down to the Curragh-based conditioner Ken Condon for €100,000. That price was equaled by trainer Ger Lyons when securing hip 155, a daughter of Galileo (Ire) from Newtownbarry House Stud on behalf of Patrick Doyle. Her dam is a half to Revogue (Ire) and King of Tara (Ire).
