

### MCINGVALE SUIT CHARGES KICKBACKS TO TRAINER AND AGENT

Prominent racing owner James McIngvale on Thursday filed a federal lawsuit in Texas that in part charged trainer Bob Baffert and Florida-based sales agents J.B. McKathan and Kevin McKathan with receiving secret commissions and kickbacks on "various Thoroughbred racehorses" the Houston furniture industrialist purchased at public auction. The lawsuit, which was filed in the U.S. District Court in Galveston, Texas, specifically details a transaction involving the sale of Work, a \$950,000 purchase on behalf of McIngvale at the 2003 Keeneland April 2-year-olds in training sale. The civil action alleges that the McKathans received a 10% commission from consignor Murray Smith for the purchase of the son of Menifee-Pacific City, by Carson City. A copy of a \$95,000 canceled check paid to Our Team LLC, a Florida corporation affiliated with the McKathan brothers, was included as an exhibit with the lawsuit. The check, which was signed by Smith, had included in the memo line, "10% Comm. On Menifee-Pacific City." According to the lawsuit, McIngvale had an oral agreement with the McKathans to pay them 5% of the purchase price of horses bought on his behalf during the term of their relationship, from 2001-2004. The lawsuit - which seeks a variety of unspecified damages - goes on to allege that, during the course of an investigation by McIngvale into the dealings with the named defendants, J.B. McKathan "confessed to McIngvale that he did in fact receive secret commissions and kickbacks on Thoroughbred racehorses defendants recommended and purchased on behalf of McIngvale." Neither J.B. McKathan nor Kevin McKathan immediately returned calls made by The Blood-Horse on Thursday. The siblings operate the McKathan Brothers Training Center near Citra, Fla. Baffert's role in the lawsuit is defined as an adviser and trainer to McIngvale, who admittedly spent millions on horses during the four-year association with the McKathans. But Baffert told The Blood-Horse on Thursday that the McKathans handled the sales end of the relationship with McIngvale. "I just trained the horses," Baffert said in a brief interview. "J.B. was in charge of the sales. I don't know anything about the lawsuit, but I am going to find out." Smith was not named as a defendant in the suit, and was mentioned in the complaint only as the "seller" in the discussion of the sale of Work, who has three wins from 29 lifetime starts, earning \$53,173. ### HORSE SLAUGHTER BILL PASSED BY HOUSE

A bill to end horse slaughter for human consumption passed the U.S. House of Representatives Sept. 7 with a final vote of 263-146. Two amendments to alter the bill both failed to pass. "It was a significant win," Kentucky Rep. Ed Whitfield said. "There was just an overwhelming feeling, at least on the House side, that something should be done about it." Whitfield, along with New York Rep. John Sweeney, were lead sponsors of the bill. If the bill becomes law, the American Horse Slaughter Prevention Act would shut down the three horse slaughter plants in the country. The plants in Forth Worth and Kaufman, Texas, and DeKalb, Ill., slaughtered more than 90,000 horses last year. The vast majority of the meat was sold overseas, where it is considered a delicacy. **RECORDS FALL AT SEPTEMBER** Tattersalls Ireland's September Yearling Sale ended with more increases yesterday and record returns, prompting Chair-



man Edmond Mahony to reflect on the "strength of the demand from buyers at all levels." Overall, the gross was sent through the  $\in$  10-million mark and the average was up by over 35 percent on 2005. While acknowledging that the first day's record-setting year-

ling purchase of €225,000 during the inaugural "New Sires' Showcase" had been the highlight, Mahony pointed to a number of causes for the auction's upswing this week. "It meant a great deal to us that the highest-ever priced yearling at Tattersalls Ireland was bought from the New Sires' Showcase and to have eight horses sell for €100,000 or more was especially pleasing," said Mahony. "The success of this week's sale can be put down to many factors, not least the fact that vendors are offering horses at the September Sale that appeal to the purchasers, be they trainers, agents or pinhookers. It is also increasingly evident that the results of horses bought at this sale in recent years have been outstanding; every day there seems to be another new two-year-old winner bought from last year's sale, 10 of which are now stakes winners or placed, as well as the high-profile horses such as Rising Cross (GB), Saoire (GB), English Ballet (Ire), and many buyers here have said that they are specifically targeting next year's €300,000 Tattersalls Ireland Sales S. Overall, we were delighted with the strength of the demand from buyers at all levels throughout the sale."

### On A High Note...

It was a filly by Medecis (GB) who topped yesterday's final session of the auction. Offered by the Irish National Stud, which stands the 2002 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and G1 Prix de la Foret runner-up, hip 456 is a half-sister to last Monday's Listed Ripon Champion Two-Years-Old Trophy winner Stevie Gee (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}). The filly was purchased by trainer Jim Bolger's nephew Ken Bolger for €60,000. Medecis is a half-brother to the family's flagship performer Alexander Goldrun (Ire), who lines up in tomorrow's G1 Irish Champion S. "She was an athletic filly and a good walker," Bolger said of the yearling. "The update to her pedigree was a help and she will make a fine broodmare in time." Later, agent Bobby O'Ryan paid €58,000 for hip 499, a colt by the hot first-season sire Invincible Spirit (Ire) from the family of Superlative (Ire) consigned by Woodtown House Stud. Hip 577, a filly by Bertolini from Ballybrennan Stud, was knocked down to Enda Kelly, buying for Lady O'Reilly, at €49,000. Full results are available on www.tattersalls.ie.

**BANDARI RETIRED** Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Bandari (Ire)** (Alhaarth {Ire}--Miss Audimar, by Mr. Leader) has been retired and will stand at Peria Stud in Tallow, County Waterford. Trained by Mark Johnston throughout his career, Bandari was successful in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York in 2002, before finishing third when favorite for the G1 St Leger at Doncaster. He added the G2 Princess of Wales's S. to his tally in 2004 and G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot the following year, but had been disappointing this term and finished last of four on his final start in this year's renewal of the Princess of Wales's S. July 13. A fee is yet to be set for Bandari, who won 11 of his 33 starts and £547,045 in prize money.
