CHAMPION LOST IN THE FOG EUTHANIZED

He was rarely beaten on the racetrack, but champion Lost in the Fog (Lost Soldier--Cloud Break, by Dr. Carter) Sunday lost his battle with cancer. The four-

year-old was euthanized at trainer Greg Gilchrist's barn at Golden Gate. Diagnosed with lymphoma just a month ago after three large tumors were discovered in his spleen and along his spine, the four-year-old underwent one round of chemotherapy, but was in distress after grazing Sunday afternoon. "I always tried to get him out to graze on nice days, and I had kept him out as late as I could before going over to the races to saddle a horse," Gilchrist said. "But I got a call from the barn that, immediately after going back into his stall, he started showing signs of

discomfort. It just came out of the blue and hit him. One minute he was eating grass and enjoying the day, but he went down hill real quick." Gilchrist added, "We did all we could for him, but it didn't help. The cancer was too far advanced, and we couldn't get it turned around. We tried very hard, he tried very hard, but it was just too much to overcome." A \$13,000 KEENOV weanling and a \$48,000 OBSAUG yearling, Lost in the Fog RNA'd for \$195,000 at the 2004 OBS March sale, but Gilchrist was able to buy the colt privately for owner Harry Aleo from Southern Chase Farm. Unbeaten in two starts at two, the dark bay with the distinctive blaze traveled the country as he opened his sophomore campaign with eight straight victories, including the GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga, GII Carry Back S. at Calder, GII Swale S. at Gulfstream, GII Riva Ridge BC S. at Belmont and GIII Bay Shore S. at Aqueduct. He also won minor stakes at Golden Gate and Bay Meadows, and was sent off the 7-10 favorite in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. Lost in the Fog could not sustain his unbeaten streak that afternoon, tiring to be seventh, but was named the Eclipse winner as top sprinter.

Lost in the Fog had to settle for second in his 2006 debut, the Golden Gate Sprint S., but he rebounded to take the June 3 GIII Aristides BC H. at Churchill Downs. "What a champion he was," Gilchrist said. "To win that race, under adverse conditions--he had to have those tumors then--only one in a million could do something like that. I'd like people to remember him for the great warrior he was." In total, Lost in the Fog had 11 wins and a second from 14 starts, earning \$978,099. "I have so many good memories, I could talk about him for hours," Gilchrist said. "He took us to so many places and we met so many good people, it was like living a dream." He added that an autopsy was performed at the University of California at Davis and that, after cremation, Lost in the Fog's ashes would possibly be sent to Southern Chase Farm in Williston, Florida.

It was time to sit up and take notice when the Aga Khan decided to keep Kastoria in training this year at the age of five. A survey of the latest edition of the Aga's stud book reveals that that the vast majority of his homebred broodmares, which number around 170, were retired after their three-year-old season. If I've counted correctly, there were only 16 exceptions to this rule and none of these 16 had been given the chance to compete at the age of five.

So why was Kastoria asked to break new ground? The decision to keep her in training possibly owed something to Europe's much improved programme for older fillies and mares, but I suspect that the main reason was that Kastoria still had so much untapped potential.

A severe sinus problem, which was relieved by a hole being bored into her face, had severely restricted her career as a young filly. Consequently, this big daughter of Selkirk hadn't made her debut until the June of her four-year-old season, when she failed to win a maiden race for four-year-olds and up at Wexford, one of Ireland's minor tracks. Fortunately, Kastoria quickly showed the benefit of that initial experience and before long she was competing with credit in stakes company. By the end of the season she had raced six times for two wins and four seconds, including two seconds at Group 2 level. According to the Racing Post handicappers, Kastoria had improved virtually with every race and her final effort was rewarded with a rating of 114. There were clearly plenty of opportunities available to a mare of this class, but even Kastoria's connections must be a little surprised at how well her current campaign has gone.

When she wore down Yeats to take the G1 Irish St Leger, she was winning for the fourth time in five starts in 2006, and she is likely to continue to tackle the males.

Kastoria is by no means the first daughter of Selkirk to shine after the age of three. Squeak (GI Beverly Hills H. and GI Matriarch S.), Favourable Terms (G1 Nassau S.), Field of Hope (G1 Prix de la Foret), Red Bloom and the late-maturing Freedonia are other Selkirk daughters which have scored at group level at four. And Kastoria isn't the first to shine in a St Leger, as Sulk, another of Selkirk's Group 1-winning daughters, was second in the French St Leger. Selkirk's 1000 Guineas winner Wince produced Quiff, a close second in the 2004 St Leger.


It is hardly surprising that Selkirk's progeny often train on extremely well. At nearly 16.3 hands, Selkirk is one of the bigger stallions in Britain and he was narrow as a young horse. In other words, he was just the type to improve with maturity. Although he showed plenty of potential as a two-year-old, he wasn't able to fulfil this promise during the first half of his second season. The possibility existed that he was simply racing over too far, as he tackled 1 1/4 miles and 1 7/16 miles, but he also disappointed when he was returned to a mile and another explanation emerged. Selkirk needed to have an undescended testicle removed, after which he was transformed into an outstanding miler.

Although Selkirk disappointed on all three occasions he ventured beyond a mile, he has been a prolific source of very talented performers from 1 1/4 miles to 1 3/4 miles. This year alone he has enjoyed stakes success in that distance range with Freedonia, Kastoria, Kiswahili, Linas Selection, Riyalma, Scottish Stage and Tam Lin. But, as a son of Sharpen Up, Selkirk is also capable of siring good sprinters, with The Trader, Etlaala, Jedburgh and Reve de Paix among the current examples.

Much, obviously, depends on the type of mare which Selkirk receives, and Kastoria is out of Kassana, a stoutly bred Shernazar mare who gained her best success in the G3 Prix Minerve over 1 9/16 miles. Kassana is also a half-sister to Kassani, an Alleged colt who triumphed in the G2 Prix Kergorlay over 1 7/8 miles. Kastoria is the second tough mare sired by Selkirk from a daughter of Shernazar, her predecessor being the Grade II winner Country Garden, who was second or third in four graded stakes as a five-year-old in 2000.

Kassiyda, Kastoria's second dam, won at around 1 1/4 miles, but her achievements on the track were less significant than her bloodlines. With Mill Reef as her sire and Blushing Groom as her broodmare sire, Kassiyda had a pedigree which combined two brilliant performers bred along similar lines. Mill Reef and Blushing Groom were both sired by sons of Nasrullah and both came from families tracing to Black Ray, through the sisters Infra Red and Eclair, Incidentally, Blushing Groom was a son of Red God, who also appears in Selkirk's pedigree, as the grandsire of his broodmare sire, Nebbiolo. Selkirk sired the Italian champion Altieri from a Blushing Groom mare, and Kastoria is his sixth stakes winner with a Mill Reef mare as its second dam, two of the others being the Group 2 winner Highdown and the Derby third Border Arrow.

Kastoria's female line has served the Aga Khan and his forebearers extremely well for an extremely long time. The family traces all the way back to Qurrat-Al-Ain, one of the foundation mares acquired by the current Aga's grandfather in 1928. More recently, it was Kastoria's third dam Kadissya who provided the Aga with the dual Derby winner Kahyasi (who has found lasting fame through his daughter Hasili).

Kadissya was also a half-sister to Kalata, whose grandson Milan won the English St Leger in 2001, so this family is a proven source of Classic stamina.

DUO SUPPLEMENTED TO MILE Scuderia Rencati's unbeaten Sesmen (GB) (Inchinor {GB}) and Noel O'Callaghan's Alexander Tango (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) were yesterday supplemented for Saturday's G1 Meon Valley Stud Fillies' Mile at Ascot. Trainer Marco Botti paid the £20,000 fee to add G3 Prestige S. winner Sesmen. "She won well last time and the margin was probably less than she had in hand, because she tends to be lazy in front," Botti told the Racing Post. The Tommy Stack-trained Alexander Tango was fifth in the Aug. 27 G1 Moyglare Stud S. on her latest start. Their additions brought the list of five-day entries to 15. Aidan O'Brien has a duo including Susan Magnier's Tralee maiden scorer Nell Gwyn (Ire) (Danehill), while Jeremy Noseda looks set to run Derrick Smith, Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's G2 May Hill S. winner Simply Perfect (GB) (Danehill).

GEORGE HEADS OEII LIST Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's G1 2000 Guineas winner George Washington (Ire) (Danehill) will face a maximum of 12 rivals in Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot. Injured after finishing second in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh May 27, the colt came back to be third in the Aug. 27 G2 Celebration Mile at Goodwood. Trainer Aidan O'Brien, who has left in a guartet including Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Faisal Salman's May 14 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains winner Aussie Rules (Danehill), has booked Mick Kinane to retain the ride on George Washington. "We think he's gone the right way since Goodwood and he's in good shape, so it's so far so good," said O'Brien Sunday. Godolphin have left in Aug. 13 G1 Prix Jacques le Marois and Sept. 3 G1 Prix du Moulin winner Librettist (Danzig) and last year's G1 Sussex S. scorer Proclamation (Ire) (King's Best), last seen when third in the June 20 G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot, alongside the Celebration Mile winner Caradak (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}). Gainsborough Stud's Aug. 2 G1 Sussex S. hero Court Masterpiece (GB) (Polish Precedent) and Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar's Irish 2000 Guineas and June 20 G1 St James's Palace S. winner Araafa (Ire) (Mull of Kintyre) are other heavyweights left in the mile contest, while Cheveley Park Stud have declared the June 23 G1 Coronation S. winner Nannina (GB) (Medicean {GB}), who was fourth in last Saturday's G1 Matron S. at Leopardstown.



Clerical Error Sends Wrong Slaughter Bill to Senate: by Amanda Duckworth, courtesy of www.bloodhorse.com

Because of a clerical error, the wrong version of a bill to end horse slaughter was delivered to the U.S. Senate. The error was discovered the week of Sept. 10, and the House of Representatives requested the bill be returned so the correct version can be sent. Lawmakers expect that the issue will be resolved quickly, according to Brent Dolen, press secretary for Kentucky Rep. Ed Whitfield. Whitfield and New York Rep. John Sweeney were lead sponsors of the bill while it was in the House. The original version of the American Horse Slaughter Prevention Act was passed by the House Sept. 7. However, a House clerk apparently delivered an amended version of the bill that would have allowed existing slaughter plants to remain open. Last year more than 90,000 horses were slaughtered in the United States. If the bill becomes law, the three existing plants, which are in Fort Worth and Kaufman, Texas, and DeKalb, Illinois, will be shut down.

"It's probably a Group 1 in class and there is very little between them, but I'm very pleased with her and she has progressed since Leopardstown," Smullen said yesterday. "She has to improve, but obviously she has."
