last May. His trainer An-

drew Balding paid tribute yesterday. "Phoenix Reach has been our stable flagship since I started training and we will miss him terribly," Balding said. "He achieved so much in spite of some very bad luck and his appetite for competition was second to none. It takes a very special horse to travel across the world from one topclass race to the next and still perform at the very highest level." The addition of Phoenix Reach, who won five races in total and accumulated £1,975,483 in prize money, to the National Stud's roster was welcomed by the Stud's Commercial General Manager Tina Dawson yesterday. "The National Stud is delighted to be working in partnership with Winterbeck Manor Stud and the Christou family and we look forward to standing this talented, three-times Group 1 winner," she commented. "Achieving a Timeform rating of 124, despite considerable setbacks, proves what an absolute top-class performer he is. Being by proven multiple Group-1 producing sire Alhaarth and out of Carroll's Canyon, a half sister to Arc winner Carroll's House, Phoenix Reach makes a very exciting prospect for breeders in 2007."

A filly by Pulpit attracted top price of \$330,000 as the marathon Keeneland September Yearling Sale marched on yesterday in Lexington. The chestnut filly, consigned by Claiborne Farm, agent, was purchased by Southern Equine Stables. She is out of the unraced mare Audrey Paulina (Meadowlake). The top-priced colt of vesterday's session of the September Sale was a bay vearling from the first crop of the unraced Authenticate. The seven-year-old Authenticate, who is by Gone West out of MGISW Lakeway, stands at Cedarcrest Farm in Palestine, Texas for a fee of \$3,000. The yearling is out of La Riviera (Affirmed) and is a half brother to GSP Frenchglen. He was consigned by Highclere Sales, agent, and was purchased for \$120,000 by Welcome Gate Farm. Through 10 of 14 sessions, Keeneland has sold 2,601 yearlings for a total of \$385,707,000. The cumulative average is up 5.4 percent from a year ago to \$148,292, while the median is up 16.7 percent to \$70,000. The sale continues today at 10 a.m. and runs through Monday.

That sire has a live contender in Jaber Abdullah's Pretty Majestic (Ire), who had Whazzis back in third in a Chester conditions event last month and who has the profile of a typically tough Mick Channon improver.

Hips 1882 and 3001 are sons of More Than Ready, the successful Vinery stallion, who was the leading freshman sire in Australia in 2004-2005. Hip 1882, a \$120,000 purchase, was produced by Winthrop Arms (Val de l'Orne (Fr)), the dam of six winners from seven to race, including SW Valarone. Hip 3001 is a dark bay son of MSP Shuttered (Wild Again), a half-sister to MGSW Stem the Tide (Proud Truth) and GSP Private Gold, He was hammered down for \$195,000. Hip 2579, a son of leading U.S. freshman sire Johannesburg and Quiet Talk (Valid Appeal), was purchased for \$95,000 and hails from the family of American champion and Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf winner Perfect Sting. The trio will be sent to Asmussen's farm in Texas before being sold at the 2007 Hong Kong International Sale.
