The word was out about George Washington before he set foot on a racecourse and he proved it was for real when winning the G1 Phoenix S. by eight lengths last August. Put away for the winter after a follow-up in the G1 National S. the next month, he arrived at Newmarket for the May 6 G1 2000 Guineas with a tidal wave of expectation behind him. The bay treated a high-quality field with disdain there, cruising to a 21/2length tally over subsequent G1 Epsom Derby winner Sir Percy (GB), but he tore muscles in his hindguarters when second to Araafa in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh three weeks later. Nursed back to health for Goodwood's G2 Celebration Mile, he got going late after a slow start to be third in that contest Aug. 27, but was just warming up for his tour de force here. Steadied in mid-pack early as his pacemakers carved out the fractions, he was boxed in between rivals turning into the straight, with Mick Kinane keeping a tight hold. Allowed some rein approaching the final furlong, he responded to pick up Araafa and Christophe Soumillon in a matter of strides before being coaxed to a facile score. "They went a nice pace and we got in behind [trainer] Jeremy [Noseda]'s colt, as I knew he'd take me where I wanted to go," said winning rider Mick Kinane. "When I asked him, he went by him very easily. I've ridden good milers, but none better than him and there were never any worries today--he behaved impeccably and he was very content going out and going down before the start, showing a great attitude. People were probably all too quick to knock him down after a farce of a race at Goodwood on his comeback with a penalty, but I got on well with him that day and he's an exceptionally good horse." Aidan O'Brien is looking to Churchill Downs Nov. 4 and the GI Breeders' Cup Mile with George Washington. "Everybody saw it today and Mick said he was just half-speeding," the conditioner added. "He grew up great after Goodwood and Mick learnt a lot about him that day. He's becoming a man now--he's been a little bit immature, but he walked into the parade ring fine. It has been a case of perfect progression as far as Simply Perfect is concerned this term and she continued the upward trend with a game success in this contest. Beaten only by the subsequent G1 Prix Morny hero Dutch Art (GB) at Windsor on debut June 5, she filled the same spot 16 days later in the G2 Queen Mary S. over five furlongs at the Royal meeting here. Trying a furlong further, she graduated in a Lingfield maiden July 14 before returning to this venue to finish third in the G3 Princess Margaret S. 15 days later. She met trouble in running and was unable to land a blow when seventh in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. over seven furlongs of The Curragh Aug. 27, but demonstrated her toughness when bouncing back to win the G2 May Hill S. over York's mile Sept. 9. Settled close to the early pace set by the rank Sesmen (GB) (Inchinor {GB}), she was committed by Darryll Holland at the top of the stretch and led at the quarter pole. Always holding Treat and Jamie Spencer to her inside, she veered right across her path late on, but the stewards allowed her to keep the contest. "I said to [trainer] Jeremy [Noseda] the other day that she's a strong little filly and still has a bit of Queen Mary speed in her," her rider said. "This was her second time over a mile and she really dropped her head for me today. Her attribute is that she's very tough and travels well. She sees out the trip very well and wants better ground than this--when she gets it she'll lengthen a bit more than she did there." Noseda is targeting the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket next May. "She's a tough, honest filly who showed form at five and has just progressed and got better as she's gone up in trip," he said. 
