Godolphin runners Librettist (Danzig) and Proclamation (Ire) (King's Best) were yesterday reported to be lame following their disappointing efforts in Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. Racing Manager Simon

Crisford revealed to the Racing Post that plans are now up in the air for both last vear's G1 Sussex S. winner Proclamation, who was fifth behind George Washington (Ire) and G1 Prix Jacques le Marois and G1 Prix du Moulin racingpost.co.uk hero Librettist, a place behind. "Both horses are lame in

front, so it is a question of monitoring their progress in the next few days," Crisford told the Post. "Everything is on hold. Proclamation was disappointing and never looked like he had any finishing kick in him. Librettist didn't run anything like as well as he can run." With two of the stable's top runners currently sidelined, Godolphin will be without representation in Britain's last two Group 1 races of the season. MASTERPIECE HEADED EAST

Gainsborough Stud's Court Masterpiece (GB) (Polish Precedent) is being prepared for a winter campaign in Japan before retiring to stud in that country, connections announced yesterday. The Ed Dunlop-trained



six-year-old, winner of the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood Aug. 2, finished 3 1/4-lengths third behind George Washington (Ire) in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot, "He'll run in a race over seven furlongs in November and Court Masterpiece APRH another over a mile in December and then be retired to one of

Sheikh Mohammed's studs in Japan," the owner's Racing Manager Bruce Raymond told PA Sport. "The feeling is that he will have a better opportunity of establishing himself over there."

MUCH 'BETTER.' EH?

After failing to make an impact in his last two starts, Bushwood Stable's Better Talk Now (Talkin Man) took a trip over the border and got back to winning ways in yesterday's GII Sky Classic H. at Woodbine. The sevenyear-old veteran, winner of the 2004 GI Breeders' Cup Turf, rallied from near the back of the seven-horse field and was resolute in overtaking pacesetter Last Answer (Langfuhr) and Jambalaya (Langfuhr) to win by a head in a three-horse photo. "I've said all along this year, I think this horse is every bit as good as he was when he won the Breeders' Cup," said his trainer, H. Graham Motion, after the race. Despite his confidence, Motion said he may bypass the Breeders' Cup this year and instead opt for a return to Woodbine for the \$2 million, GI Pattison Canadian International Oct. 22. "I think there's a pretty good chance," said Motion. "The International is a very prestigious race in its own right." Lord Derby's multiple Group 1 winner could be kept at home for the Newmarket contest Oct. 14 instead of traveling to France if the ground worsens ahead of the Arc meeting. "We have the option of the Opera, but we could also look at the Champion S., which would still leave us three weeks to the Breeders' Cup," the conditioner told the Racing Post. "She is very fresh and we are happy with her at this stage."

THOMAS TO TAKE ON BERNARDINI

Susan Magnier's **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill) will make his debut on dirt against Bernardini in Belmont's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Oct. 7, trainer Aidan O'Brien has confirmed. John Velazquez has been booked for the ride on the G1 Irish Derby and G1 Irish Champion S. winner. "We're looking at giving him a prep for the [Breeders' Cup] Classic in the Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont rather than in the Kentucky Cup Classic at Turfway Park next weekend," O'Brien told Racing Post.

Reserved in rear early, he was threaded through a gap on the rail at the top of the straight and sent in pursuit of Egerton, who was battling to ward off the attentions of Enforcer. "It was just like all his other breezes," said exercise rider Simon Harris, who was aboard for the move. "It

just amazes you that he does everything so easy."

The horse that figures to be Bernardini's main competition in the Gold Cup, the GI Whitney H. winner Invasor (Arg) (Candy Stripes), also worked Saturday. Trainer Kiaran McLaughlin sent the colt out to a fivepanel breeze over the training track in 1:03.03. "That's just him," McLaughlin said about the lackadaisical move. "He'll work back once more before the Gold Cup. I'm happy with the way he's going." McLaughlin's brilliant GI King's Bishop S. winner Henny Hughes (Hennessy) was another on Saturday's worktab, and like his stablemate, he hardly set the track on fire. The sophomore breezed a half-mile on the training track in :52.20. "I think I over-coached the riders, which is one of the reasons he worked so slow," McLaughlin commented. "If you don't take a hold of him, he'll go: 46, :58, and I'm not looking for that. Hopefully next week we can get a :48 out of him." Henny Hughes is being prepared for a tilt in the six-furlong GI Vosburgh H. at Belmont Oct. 7, his first start against older horses.

Meanwhile, McLaughlin's GI Belmont S. winner Jazil (Seeking the Gold), who was sidelined over the summer with a bruised hind cannon bone, took a stroll over Belmont's main track yesterday. "He galloped [Sunday] for the first time," said the conditioner. "He looked great. Right now, the Breeders' Cup is doubtful. We nominated him to the [G1] Japan Cup Dirt, but we'll wait and see."

I'm a Numbers Guy came from off the pace to win his debut going a furlong shorter at Delaware Sept. 9 and was given plenty of respect to take his stakes bow. Up to contest the early pace this time, the chestnut took command 1 1/2 furlongs from home and drew off to win by daylight. "He rated perfectly, and when he was asked, he sprinted down the lane," said winning trainer Tim Ritchey. "We'll probably bring him back in the [onemile] Sleepy Hollow S.
