Blood-Horse

PERCY MISSES ARC Anthony Pakenham's **Sir Percy (GB)** (Mark of Esteem {Ire}) will miss Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe after suffering a setback in training. Trainer Marcus Tregoning revealed yesterday that the June 3 G1 Epsom Derby winner would now be aimed at the Oct. 14 G1 Emirates Airline Champion S. at Newmarket.

"We have decided against it, as he has niggled a shoulder muscle on his off-fore shoulder," Tregoning told *PA Sport*. "I

don't think it's anything too serious--it just won't come right quick enough. In view of that, we have decided to miss the Arc as you need to be 150 percent for a race like that. We will aim for the Champion now, and hopefully, he will be in good shape by then."

CHASING THE MILLION

Hot on the heels of the inaugural running of their pair of races run at The Curragh, Goffs start their three-day Million Sale today, followed by the two-day Sportsman's and Bonus Sale. Revamped 12 months ago, the Kill auction received instant gratification with an upturn of fortunes which had been in relative decline during the final years of the old-style Orby. **Miss Beatrix (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and **Silk Blossom (Ire)** (Barathea {Ire}) shared the €2.4 million on offer last Tuesday, adding the sizeable pots to earlier wins in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. and G2 Lowther S., respectively. For next year, the Fillies Five Hundred will have its purse doubled to match that of the Million. The latter race will have a sole filly winner in its history, as it will be restricted to colts and geldings, beginning in 2007. The increase in quality, made possible by new management and strong support from vendors, proved irresistible for buyers 12 months ago. Arresting the Orby's decline, the Million returned an average of €99,455 and median of €65,000, with 27 yearlings sold for €300,000 or more. Following the three-day 663-lot Million Sale, Friday sees the one-session Sportsman's Sale with its sales race worth €100,000 while Saturday witnesses the new Bonus Sale, which will also have its own race in 2007.

A Tale of Success..

The Orby enjoyed a rich heritage of top-class performers behind it, led by the brilliant multiple Group 1-winning heroine **Alexander Goldrun (Ire)** (Gold Away {Ire}), who won the G1 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh earlier this term. Fronting this year's catalogue is G1 1000 Guineas heroine **Speciosa (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), while past graduates include 2005 G1 Grand Prix de Paris and G1 St Leger winner Scorpion (Ire); four-times G1 Irish St Leger hero Vinnie Roe (Ire); former Emirates World Series Champion Grandera (Ire); 2004 G1 Irish 2000 Guineas winner Bachelor Duke; 2004 G1 Man o' War S. scorer Magistretti; and 2004 G1 Phoenix S. heroine Damson (Ire).

Everything in Place..

With the top sires Cape Cross (Ire), Danehill Dancer, Galileo (Ire), Giant's Causeway, Gone West, Green Desert, Kingmambo, Machiavellian, Montjeu (Ire), Pivotal (GB) and Sadler's Wells featured this year, alongside first-crop sires Dalakhani (Ire), Dubai Destination, Hawk Wing, High Chaparral (Ire), Nayef and Oasis Dream (GB), international demand should be strong. Regular heavyweight consignors include last year's top six of Timmy Hyde's Camas Park Stud, Flash Conroy's Glenvale Stud, Eddie O'Leary's Lynn Lodge Stud, Denis Brosnan's Croom House Stud, Paul Shanahan's Ashtown House Stud and David Nagle's Barronstown Stud. Managing Director Matt Mitchell has cause for optimism heading toward the 2006 renewal. "Everybody I speak to is of the opinion that we have a greater depth and quality than last year and that augurs well," Mitchell said. "The market at the moment looks particularly strong, but there will be value in there for syndicates and partnerships. The great ideal of the Goffs Million means there will be the option of two fabulous races, which allow the opportunity to shoot for the dream." Selling for the Million begins at 11:30 a.m. today and tomorrow and at 10 a.m. on Thursday, with the Sportsman's and Bonus sessions also getting underway at 10 a.m. Friday and Saturday. Bred for speed and precocity, this filly is a half to the top-class juvenile of 2001 Captain Rio (GB) and will appeal to those looking for a candidate for next year's Fillies' Million.

Hip 12, c, Rock of Gibraltar (Ire)--Belsay (GB), by Belmez

Consigned by Lynn Lodge Stud

This colt is a half to this year's G3 Craven S. winner and G2 Celebration Mile runner-up Killybegs (Ire), who was a highly respectable fourth in Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot. Belsay is a half to 1991 G3 Nell Gwyn S. winner Crystal Gazing, whose progeny include the smart sprinter Conroy.

Hip 33, c, Danehill Dancer (Ire)--Breyani (Ire), by Commanche Run (GB)

Consigned by Thomastown Castle

Danehill Dancer's relentless scaling of the heights has been one of the stories of the year and his yearlings will be in increasing demand this week thanks to the Million success of Miss Beatrix (Ire). This colt, who is a half to the 1998 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas winner Tarascon (Ire); top-class Mister Monet (Ire); and Mala Mala (Ire), hails from the family of the 1988 G1 Futurity S. winner Al Hareb and this year's G3 Jersey S. runner-up Asset (Ire).

Hip 44, f, Pivotal (GB)--Cassandra Go (Ire), by Indian Ridge (Ire)

Consigned by Ballyhimikin Stud

Out of Trevor Stewart's top-class sprinter Cassandra Go, who is a half to Verglas (Ire), this filly's half-sister Theann (GB) sold for €400,000 at last year's sale and ran with credit to finish fifth in last Tuesday's Fillies Five Hundred.

Cassis was a top-class sophomore for Jeremy Nosedo in 2003, winning the G3 Musidora S. and placing in the G1 Coronation S. and G1 Del Mar Oaks. She is a half to Hum Along, who produced 1996 champion juvenile filly Storm Song and last year's top-class two-year-old Diamond Omi.

Hip 54, c, Kingmambo--Chimes of Freedom, by Private Account

Consigned by Camas Park Stud

One of the highlights of Day 1, this colt named Atep is a three-parts brother to the high-class Aldebaran, as well as being a half to 2002 G1 Atto Mile scorer Good Journey and GIII Jenny Wiley S. heroine Sea of Showers. The top-class dam is a half to Denon and Imperfect Circle, the dam of Spinning World. This family received another update last Sunday when Beauty Bright (Ire) captured the G3 Renaissance S. at The Curragh.

Hip 134, c, Galileo (Ire)--Epping (GB), by Charnwood Forest (Ire)

Consigned by Newtown Stud

Galileo has proven that he can get precocious juveniles such as Teofilo (Ire) and this full-sibling to the G1 St Leger runner-up The Last Drop (Ire) has as his third dam the top-class Sarah Siddons (Fr). She is the dam of the 1984 Irish Oaks winner Princess Pati (Ire) and stallion Seymour Hicks (Fr), so Million prospectors will have in mind that this colt will have abundant stamina to call on if the rain comes next September.

Classic, trainer John Kimmel confirmed Monday. "We're planning on going," said Kimmel. "It's good timing and he came out of his last race in good order. We weren't going to tackle Bernardini and Invasor in the [GI] Jockey Club Gold Cup [Oct. 7]. I think the Classic is a good spot. It will be interesting to see how he handles the Polytrack." Explaining the decision to ship to Kentucky, Kimmel added, "We were considering the [GII] Meadowlands Breeders' Cup on Oct. 13, but if it came up sloppy, it would put us in a hole for the [GII] Clark H. [Churchill Downs, Nov. 24], since I don't want him to run on an off track. With the Polytrack, an off track is not a consideration."

Pair Added to Juvenile Tests...
A pair of juveniles have been added to Saturday's juvenile features, including **Shermanesque** (Fusaichi Pegasus), third to Chace City and King of the Roxy in the GII Saratoga Special Breeders' Cup S. Aug. 17. The latter came back to win his latest start, last Saturday's GII Futurity S. "He's doing really well right now," said trainer Tony Reinstedler. "We were going to run him in the Arlington-Washington Futurity [Sept. 10], but the track was off and I didn't want him to run on an off track." The Willmott Stable-owned colt also was runner up to Circular Quay in the GIII Bashford Manor S. July 8. That Todd Pletcher-trained colt subsequently won the GI Hopefull S. Sept. 4. Also looking to line up on Turfway's marquee day is **Lucky Approval** (With Approval), who will contest the Juvenile Fillies. According to trainer Hal Higgins, the new Polytrack surface was the deciding factor in starting his star pupil. The filly won her latest start going a mile on the turf at Ellis Park Sept. 2. "Had that last race been on the dirt, I'm not sure we'd enter her," explained Higgins. The chestnut is expected to ship to Turfway Friday or Saturday.

RAJEEM RULED OUT OF CHARIOT Saeed Manana's **Rajeem (GB)** (Diktat {GB}) will sidestep Saturday's G1 Kingdom of Bahrain Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket. Conditioner Clive Brittain revealed yesterday that shock G1 Falmouth S. scorer would miss the mile contest due to a freak accident. "She slipped going into her box and banged her hip," Brittain told *PA Sport*. "She was too sore to think about running at the weekend, so until we get the soreness out, she's obviously on the easy list. You can never put a time or a date on a recovery from a hip injury. The filly will tell me when she's ready to go on again and she definitely stays in training next year."

Plenty of Quality Remaining...

At yesterday's stage, 11 distaffers remained in the race headed by Noel and Miriam O'Callaghan's **Alexander Goldrun (Ire)** (Gold Away {Ire}) and the Elite Racing Club's **Soviet Song (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}). Terry Neill's G1 Matron S. winner **Red Evie (Ire)** (Intikhab) and Cheveley Park Stud's duo **Peeress (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) and **Nannina (GB)** (Medicean {GB}) are other notables alongside Jaber Abdullah's Matron S. third **Flashy Wings (GB)** (Zafonic). Abdullah's Racing Manager

Bruce Raymond announced yesterday that the sophomore would not run if the ground became soft. "It has rained cats and dogs here in Newmarket today and she won't run if it's in any way soft," Raymond told *PA Sport*. Clerk of the Course Michael Prosser confirmed that the ground was officially good to soft ahead of the three-day Cambridgeshire meeting. "It's been raining all day and has only just stopped," Prosser said. "We have had half an inch and the ground is now good-to-soft. We have two dry days forecast for [today] and [tomorrow] and then sunshine and showers forecast from Thursday to Saturday. It's in tremendous shape with a fantastic covering of grass and has taken the rain very well indeed. If we get the dry weather we've been forecast for the next two days, I would hope that we might go into the meeting with ground just on the easy side of good on Thursday."

KEENELAND ENDS ON A HIGH NOTE Keeneland concluded its record-breaking September Yearling Sale Monday, grossing a world-record \$399,791,800 through 14 days, an increase of 4 percent over 2005's record of \$384,349,900. Average figures also rose, up from \$108,420 to \$112,427, while median increased to \$45,000 from \$40,000 in 2005. "The select portion of this sale was stronger than last year and set the tone for the rest of the sale," said Geoffrey Russell, Keeneland's director of sales. "However, the success of this sale was built on the middle market-Books 3, 4 & 5. We graded deeper into the middle market this year, and really made this a conformation class. Our consignors worked hard with us to understand and make adjustments, and they were rewarded with a stronger sale." The sale opened with fireworks when John Ferguson, representing Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, went up to \$11.7 million for a Kingmambo colt, establishing a sale record for an individual yearling. Through the course of the sale, Sheikh Mohammed secured 32 yearlings, with 12 of them realizing \$1-million or more. Among other highlights, trainer Todd Pletcher, acting on behalf of James Scatuorchio, bought the highest priced filly of the sale, going to \$3.2 million for daughter of Seeking the Gold out of Take Charge Lady. Taylor Made Agency led all consignor's, selling a total of 406 horses for \$58,108,800. *cont.p5*

Halo Steven has gone through a number of trainers, since breaking his maiden at first asking facing \$25,000 maiden claimers at Calder last November. After heading West and competing in a handful of starter allowances for trainers Nick Hines and John Sadler earlier this year, he was sent to Terry Jordan's care in Canada and won the Jim Coleman Province H. and Alberta Derby during a 13-day stretch in June. He reappeared nearly two months later with Stuart Simon, who saddled him to victory in the Count Lathum S. at Northlands Park Aug. 6. Pulled up after a mile in the Aug. 26 GIII Canadian Derby, he was looking for redemption here now representing Barbara Heads. Gunned to the front, he led the way through :22 1/5, :45 1/5 and 1:10 splits while being pressed by Ok Nothanksforaskn. Trust N Luck Filly Tops Keeneland Finale...

A filly by GI Fountain of Youth S. winner Trust N Luck out of the Carson City mare Surf City brought \$65,000 at yesterday's final session of Keeneland's September Yearling Sale in Lexington. Consigned by Nardelli Sales, agent, the chestnut was purchased by Vinery Stables. A full sister to GII Sapling S. winner Boone's Mill, the unraced 10-year-old mare is also the dam of stakes-placed Don't Tell Ashlie. The 14th session concluded with an increase in gross, up from \$1,325,300 last year to \$1,466,300, while average dipped slightly to \$8,146 from \$8,606 in 2005. Median took a tumble this time around--dropping 21 percent--from \$5,850 last term down to \$4,600 in 2006.

On a day when his sire also supplied the winners of the meeting's two Group 1 contests, the victory of Danehill's son Admiralofthefleet in the G2 Juddmonte Royal Lodge S. perhaps didn't receive as much attention as it merited. Racing for the first time in two months and tackling a mile for the first time, Admiralofthefleet turned in an improved effort off a fast pace. Indeed his 2 1/2-length victory moved him up to sixth on the *Racing Post's* list of top European juveniles, his rating of 113 being six pounds below the top-ranked Teofilo.

His connections have high hopes that Admiralofthefleet will develop into a live classic contender, but his future looks assured even if he doesn't quite reach the top of the tree. The truth is that he was born with the proverbial silver spoon in his mouth and he possesses a pedigree which will have the world's leading breeders drooling at the prospect of using him as a stallion.

The Royal Lodge winner represents a blue-blooded partnership between two of the Coolmore partners, Michael Tabor and Sue Magnier, with The Niarchos Family. This is the second time in two years that the Niarchos Family has combined with the Tabor-Magnier team to produce a leading juvenile by Danehill. Last year's star was Rumplestiltskin, who triumphed in five of six starts, including the Moyglare Stud S. and Prix Marcel Boussac, on her way to the title of Europe's champion juvenile filly.

These very talented performers have plenty in common. Both were sired by Danehill from Mr. Prospector fillies which failed to win, and both come from families which provided the late Stavros Niarchos with some of his finest performers. Whereas Rumplestiltskin is a grand-daughter of the brilliant Miesque, the dam of Kingmambo and the champion filly East Of The Moon, Admiralofthefleet is out of Rafina, a daughter of the celebrated Coup de Folie.

Rafina is one of five brothers and sisters produced by the Mr. Prospector-Coup de Folie alliance. Although Rafina managed only a couple of third places during a light campaign, most of her siblings achieved a great deal more. Three of them won at the Group level and two of them--Machiavellian and Coup de Genie--achieved the status of champion at two, when they both completed a Group 1 double in the Prix Morny and Prix de la Salamandre.

The achievements of Coup de Genie and Machiavellian didn't stop there, as both have made a major impact at stud. Coup de Genie's contribution to the family fortunes includes three Group/Graded winners headed by the champion French two-year-old filly Denebola, and she is also the second dam of Bago, an Arc winner who scored at Group 1 level at two, three and four.

Machiavellian, for his part, sired a dozen Group 1 winners, including Medicean, Street Cry and Storming Home, during a career which saw his fee rise as high as 80,000gns in 2002 before his death at the age of 17 in 2004.

Credit for the excellence of this family could fairly be attributed to the fact that Coup de Folie--a two-year-old Group winner with a Timeform rating of 112--was inbred 3x3 to that remarkable broodmare Almahmoud. After all, Almahmoud produced only three daughters but each of the three became the dam of a champion sire, with Cosmah being responsible for Halo, Natalma for Northern Dancer and Bubbling Beauty for the French champion Arctic Tern.

The power of Almahmoud's influence was also apparent in the way that Danehill was transformed from a high-class racehorse (a winner of only four of his nine starts) into a superstar stallion. He was inbred 3x3 to Almahmoud's daughter Natalma, so mating a daughter of Coup de Genie to him creates an eye-catching pedigree. Natalma's name appears three times among the eight mares in the fourth generation of Admiralofthefleet's pedigree and there are also four lines of Almahmoud among the 16 mares in the fifth generation. The colt's pedigree also contains four lines of Native Dancer; three through Natalma and one through Raise A Native.

Admiralofthefleet's owners must have had their expectations of their colt heightened by the emergence last year of Nannina, one of Europe's best juvenile fillies. Nannina, who has gone on to win this year's G1 Coronation S., is bred similarly to Admiralofthefleet, but in reverse. Her sire, Machiavellian's son Medicean, is inbred 4x4 to Natalma and 5x5x5 to Almahmoud, while her dam Hill Hopper is by Danehill and is therefore inbred 4x4 to Natalma. This adds up to Nannina being inbred 5x5x5x5 to Natalma, with five lines of Almahmoud in the next generation.

Nannina isn't a one-off, as Medicean's other matings with daughters of Danehill have also produced Regional Counsel, winner of the G3 Anglesey S., and Regal Royale, a useful handicapper.

Danehill himself sired four black-type winners from his first 10 foals out of Machiavellian mares, including the English Listed winners Coy and Miss Pinkerton. Best of the four, though, are the Australian brother and sister team of Scintillation and Shania Dane. Scintillation has developed into a Group 1 sprinter in Hong Kong this year, while Shania Dane was a four-time Group winner in 2005. These good winners are inbred 4x4x5 to Natalma and 5x5x6x6 to Almahmoud.

All this success makes Admiralofthefleet a highly valuable stallion prospect, especially if he can make a successful transition to Group 1 company, as his latest win suggests. His value must be increased by the fact that he is a member of the last crop by Danehill, whose progeny won five of the 13 races contested at Ascot on Saturday and Sunday.

Although Admiralofthefleet was never destined for the sales, Danehill's other Ascot Group winners were both sold at Tattersalls, with Simply Perfect being a 220,000gns buy and George Washington a 1,150,000gns sale topper. These two rank among a total of eight individual Group 1 winners by Coolmore stallions in 2006 which were sold as yearlings, and these eight include the winners four of Britain's five classics. As the other classic winner, Sir Percy, is by a Darley stallion, these statistics underline the folly of the two main buying camps ignoring yearlings by each other's stallions. But one man's boycott is another's opportunity and it is going to be interesting to see how much new money there will be at the upcoming sales circuit, which starts at Goffs today.

HEFFERNAN APPEALS Ballydoyle jockey Seamus Heffernan has lodged an appeal against the Ascot stewards' decision to ban him for 14 days after Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. Found guilty of improper riding on Ivan Denisovich and judged to have adopted team tactics to interfere with Godolphin's Librettist in the mile contest, the rider's appeal will be heard by the Horseracing Regulatory Authority, who will open the inquiry to the media. Frankie Dettori, who claimed foul play after the race, refused to comment yesterday, while Ivan Denisovich's trainer Aidan O'Brien had told the *Racing Post* on Sunday, "Ivan Denisovich had been an unlucky second in a 10-furlong Group 1 at Arlington and ran very lazily when he won a Listed race over a mile at the Curragh. We put a visor on him to sharpen him on Saturday and the plan was for him to follow the pacemaker and to do his best to have every chance in the race. Frankie rushed his horse up on Seamus's outside before the turn and all Seamus did was hold his position as he was perfectly entitled to do. Because of this Frankie found himself carried a bit wide. We are going to appeal the decision, as we feel Seamus did nothing wrong and was very hard done by."

THIS DATE IN HISTORY...

September 26, 1942...The Jockey Club stewards revoked jockey **Eddie Arcaro**'s license for one year after a display of "rough riding" aboard odds-on favorite Occupation in the Cowdin S. September 19. In the race, Arcaro deliberately drove his horse into another, Breezing Home, knocking jockey Vincent Nodarse into the infield. Nodarse and his mount had crowded Arcaro at the start, almost causing him to be unseated.

September 27, 1894...Aqueduct Racetrack opened its doors. The building was torn down in 1955 and the new Aqueduct was reopened September 14, 1959.

September 27, 1947...Armed, then the world's leading money-winning Thoroughbred, met 1946 Triple Crown winner **Assault** in the first \$100,000 winner-take-all match race, held at Belmont Park. Armed won easily over a less-than 100 percent Assault.
