Godolphin's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas and G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains winner Bachir (Ire) is also a half to the listed winner Elliots World (Ire) and was bought for Havana Horse's Andy Smith. "Mr. Smith wanted to buy a good horse and this is one of a handful that could win a Derby or a King George," Cole explained. "He's got the pedigree to do it and his brother is a dual Classic winner."

### Another Topper for Ferguson...

John Ferguson, who bought the first session's top lot for  $\in$ 1.05 million, was in action again yesterday when securing the top-priced filly of the day. Consigned by Noel O'Callaghan's Mountarmstrong Stud, hip 270 is a daughter of Cape Cross (Ire) out of Lady Alexander (Ire), who took the G3 Anglesey S. and G3 Molecomb S. at two and produced GSW Dandy Man (Ire) from a mating with Mozart (Ire). Ferguson secured the half to the talented G3 Palace House S. winner for €725,000. "She's an outstanding model and is from a very good family," he said. "She is one the best-bred Cape Cross fillies available and he has already produced two worldclass mares in Ouija Board and in Seachange in New Zealand." Keeping the connection, Ferguson later purchased a son of King's Best from the same family for €425,000. Sent up from the Irish National Stud, hip 365 is out of an unraced half-sister to 2002 G1 Golden Jubilee S. winner Malhub. "He's a very nice horse and is related to a Group 1 winner," he commented. "He's a very athletic colt and a good example of a King's Best." Ferguson also went to  $\in$  300,000 for hip 306, a son of Invincible Spirit (Ire) from the family of the top-class Prismatical, consigned by Liam Cashman's Rathbarry Stud.

Hip 393 is close to his heart, as he trained the dam Park Express (Ire) to be champion three-year-old filly in Ireland in 1986, courtesy of her winning exploits in the G1 Phoenix Champion S. The conditioner was forced to  $\in$  430,000 to ensure that the half-brother to the sire Shinko Forest (Ire) and to another of his past champions, 1999 G3 Matron S. winner Dazzling Park (Ire), went to Glebe House. "He's not typical, as he's a chestnut and most of them are bay, but there was a lot to like about him," Bolger said. "He's a fine horse and a great goer."

From the draft of Denis Brosnan's Croom House Stud, she is a half to the 2001 GI Gulfstream Park Breeders Cup H. scorer Subtle Power (Ire). Cheveley Park Stud went to €320,000 to acquire Eyrefield Lodge Stud's hip 402, a filly by Montjeu (Ire) whose second dam is the champion Marling (Ire). Trade was strong again during the second session, and the overall average of €110,950 represented an increase by 9.5 percent on last year's equivalent. Managing Director Matt Mitchell believes that the Goffs Million races are playing a major part in the buoyancy. "The sale continued to be strong again and the figures are well up," he said. "The races continue to influence the buyers and the market for fillies is strong. People want to buy to win the new million-euro race next year and that is underpinning the market for fillies." pion **Precisionist** (Crozier--Excellently, by \*Forli), a member of racing's Hall of Fame, was euthanized yesterday at Old Friends near Georgetown, Kentucky, according to *The Blood-Horse*. The 25-year-old was suffering from an inoperable tumor in his sinus passages. "Yesterday he looked at me and said, 'It is time,'"

Old Friends founder Michael Bown told *The Blood-Horse*. "[Wednesday], he came out and stood by the grave and knew. Chris McCarron told me he rode a lot of horses that gave 100 percent, but this was the only horse that he rode that gave 100 percent 100 percent of the time." A homebred for Fred W. Hooper, Precisionist won the

Hoist the Flag S. at two in 1983 before developing into a top performer at three. Winner of the GI Swaps S. and three other graded events, the chestnut also ran second in both the GI Super Derby and GI Santa Anita Derby. He continued his progression at four in 1985, when he won the GI San Fernando S. and GI Charles H. Strub S. and ran second in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup in June. The Hooper colorbearer was sidelined after that, but returned with an excellent performance to take the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint (video) in November at Aqueduct, defeating Smile and Mt. Livermore, and received an Eclipse Award as the nation's top sprinter. He added victories in the GI Woodward S. and GI Californian S. as a five-year-old and ran third in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. Retired to stud, Precisionist suffered fertility woes and was put back in training. He made 10 starts at age seven, capturing the GIII Cabrillo H. and Del Mar Budweiser Breeders' Cup. Third to Forty Niner in the inaugural NYRA Mile, he ran a close fifth to Gulch in the 1988 Breeders' Cup Sprint, then lost a pair of photos in the GII Citation H. and the GIII Native Diver H. His final career record stood at 46-20-10-4 with earnings of \$3,485,398. Precisionist retired to Hooper's Florida farm, where he covered a few mares, but was pensioned after proving subfertile. He sired just four foals; one of those, Preciseness, became the dam of GSW Draw Again.

SECOND OF JUNE EUTHANIZED Second of June (Louis Quatorze--Whow, by Spectacular Bid), a game second-place finisher in the GI Woodward S. last out Sept. 2, was euthanized Wednesday morning after suffering a fractured ankle in a workout at Churchill Downs. The 2004 GIII Holy Bull S. victor and GII Fountain of Youth S. runner-up was preparing for a showdown with Bernardini and Invasor (Arg) in the Oct. 7 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park. Owned by Barbara Cesare and trained by her son William Cesare, the Florida-bred was purchased for \$7,500 as a twoyear-old in training at OBSJAN. "His injury was similar to Barbaro's," the conditioner told the Blood-Horse. "Dr. [Steve] Allday x-rayed him afterward and said he didn't have a shot." Second of June won four of 14 career starts and had \$528,800 in earnings.

'DEEP' IMPRESSION Makoto Kaneko's Deep Impact (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) came through his final serious work ahead of Sunday's G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere with flying colors and connections were afterwards looking ahead to the Longchamp showcase. Having covered six furlongs of the Chantilly racecourse under big-race partner Yutaka Take, the four-year-old delighted trainer Yasuo Ikee, who commented, "I am quite satisfied with Deep Impact's final preparations. He is in very good shape. All the staff, including myself, were very pleased to hear Yutaka say that he got a very good response from Deep Impact today. We will do our best from now until the race day to make him 100 percent fit for the race." Take, who has ridden the Japanese champion in all of his five domestic Group 1 successes, was impressed. "I think this is the best work he's done since arriving here," he said. "I won't talk about his draw because if I say what I wish for, it probably won't come true, but I would rather it didn't rain before the race." The final field was reduced to 11 vesterday after John Livock's Listed Predominate S. winner Championship Point (Ire) (Lomitas {GB}) was scratched by Mick Channon, and will not feature Princess Zahra Aga Khan's G1 Prix d'Astarte and G1 Prix Vermeille heroine Mandesha (Fr) (Desert Style {Ire}). Conditioner Alain de Royer-Dupre revealed yesterday that the sophomore would not be supplemented at today's stage. "We want to keep her in training as a four-year-old, when the 2007 Arc will be her target," he explained yesterday. As a result, Christophe Soumillon will partner Baron Georg von Ullmann's GI Breeders' Cup Turf and G1 Coronation Cup winner Shirocco (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}), while Frankie Dettori will be on Paul and Susan Roy's Sixties Icon (GB) (Galileo {Ire}), who will be added at today's supplementary stage.



## NTRA REPORT FROM Capitol Hill

### I-Gaming at Center of Legislative Flurry

With Congress scrambling to pass a Department of Defense (DOD) authorization bill before the campaign recess that starts this weekend, three law-enforcement measures are under consideration for inclusion: Internet gaming, courthouse security and anti-gang measures aimed at illegal immigrants.

Any or all of the three measures threaten to derail the DOD bill, intensifying the end-of-session politicking among Congressional Leadership, including Senate Majority Leader Bill Frist (R-TN), House Speaker Dennis Hastert (R-IL) and Senate Armed Services Committee Chair John Warner (R-VA).

Should the DOD bill become an unattractive option, I-gaming could be attached to a port security bill or other late-breaking legislation.

The NTRA lobbying team continues to work with Members of the House and Senate to ensure that any I-gaming bill protects online pari-mutuel wagering as authorized by the Interstate Horseracing Act.
