DREAM COLT SHINES AS TRADE SLOWS

John Ferguson purchased the highest-priced lot, 483, at yesterday's third day of the Tattersalls' October Yearling Sale - Part 1. The 550,000gns session topper, a colt from the first crop of top sprinter Oasis Dream (GB), was one of two yearlings to break the half-million gns barrier yesterday. The Irish-bred, offered by Kilfrush Stud, was produced by the stakes-winning Side of Paradise (Ire), a Sadler's Wells half-sister to champion Last Tycoon (Ire) and three other stakes winners.



Ferguson acquired the colt on behalf of Sheikh Mohammed, underbidder. "He's one of the most athletic horses in the sale and from one of the best families in the book," Ferguson commented. "And Kilfrush Stud has an outstanding record as a nursery for top horses over the years." Ferguson had earlier gone to 320,000gns to purchase lot 403 a son of Pivotal (GB) out of Pure Spin (Machiavellian). "He was a really athletic horse with a great sense of purpose," the agent commented about the Airlie Stud offering. "Sheikh Mohammed will decide, but I should think there is a good chance he will race for Godolphin. It's no secret that we have a quarter share in Pivotal, and he's a stallion we have a very high regard for." Demi O'Byrne, buying for the Coolmore partnership, paid 500,000gns for lot 450, a Montjeu (Ire) colt. The son of Run to Jane (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}), offered from Denis Brosnan's Co Limerick-based Croom House Stud was bought for €300,000 last November at Goffs. Agent Grant Pritchard-Gordon was underbidder. A Gone West colt out of Royal Alchemist (Royal Academy), a half-sister to Grade I winner Fire the Groom, was bought for 320,000gns by agent Amanda Skiffington. "I bought Fire The Groom as a yearling years ago and it is such a great family," Skiffington said about lot 443. "I saw the horse at Castlebridge and loved him every time I saw him." The bay, purchased on behalf of owner Duncan Davidson, will go into training with James Fanshawe. Yesterday's trade failed to match the 2005 levels when the 12,308,000-guineas turnover fell by 24 percent and the 109,893gns average dipped by 12 percent. **Stats p5**

DUBAI WORLD CUP MOVED BACK A WEEK

The Dubai Racing Club has announced that the Dubai World Cup meeting will be pushed back a week to Saturday, Mar. 31, 2007. The date change was made to capitalize on the international holiday season. Once again, the 10-furlong G1 Dubai World Cup will be worth \$6 million, and will be accompanied by a pair of \$5-million events, the G1 Dubai Duty Free and the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic. The card known as "Super Thursday," consisting of a series of lead-in races to the Dubai World Cup meeting, will be held Mar. 1. **Cont. p7**

SATURDAY LOOKS SUPER AT BELMONT

An exciting day of racing is on tap Saturday at Belmont, with a line-up of five Grade I races and a forecast for sunny skies. The featured G1 Jockey Club Gold Cup drew a short field of only four runners, but pits American Classic winner **Bernardini** (A.P. Indy) against Irish Classic winner **Dylan Thomas (Ire)** (Danehill). Since taking the G1 Preakness S., Darley Stables' Bernardini was a convincing winner of Saratoga's GII Jim Dandy and G1 Travers S. "This horse has never been tested because there's never been anyone that can match strides with him," said a confident trainer Tom Albertrani. "I've never been around a horse quite this talented." The Gold Cup will be Bernardini's first start against older horses, but his stiffest challenge could well come from fellow sophomore Dylan Thomas, winner of this year's G1 Irish Derby and G1 Irish Champion S. The Gold Cup will be the colt's first start on dirt. "After his last race, we were looking about what to do with him," trainer Aidan O'Brien explained. "He's shown what he can do on the turf and if we are thinking about running him in the [Breeders' Cup] Classic, he needed to run in this race. By running in this race, we get to see what his limitations are. By running against Bernardini, we'll get a better feel on how good he is on dirt." In Saturday's G1 Vosburgh S., speedy **Henny Hughes** (Hennessy) will face off against Belmont-loving **Silver Train** (Old Trieste), while a talented field of six fillies and mares--five of them Grade I winners, goes postward in the G1 Beldame S. The likely favorite is Todd Pletcher's **Fleet Indian** (Indian Charlie), a perfect five-for-five on the year with wins in the G1 Personal Ensign H. and GII Delaware H. **Belmont Super Saturday fields p3-4**

Appealing Zophie, who aired by 10 1/2 lengths in her debut over this dirt track in April, rebounded from a runner-up effort in the Mountaineer Juvenile Fillies S. with a front-running 5 1/4-length romp in the Sept. 3 GI Spinaway S. at Saratoga. **Untouched Talent** has known nothing but stakes company in her short career, winning a Pleasanton stakes in her July 1 debut before taking the Aug. 5 GIII Sorrento S. She is coming off a runner-up effort in the Sept. 4 GI Del Mar Debutante S.

The bay filly prepared for her all-weather track debut with a local bullet three-furlong blow-out Oct. 2. After an easy victory in her Monmouth Park debut in June, **Cotton Blossom** recorded a 1 3/4-length triumph in the July 26 GIII Schuylerville S. She suffered her first defeat when second in the Spinaway last time out.

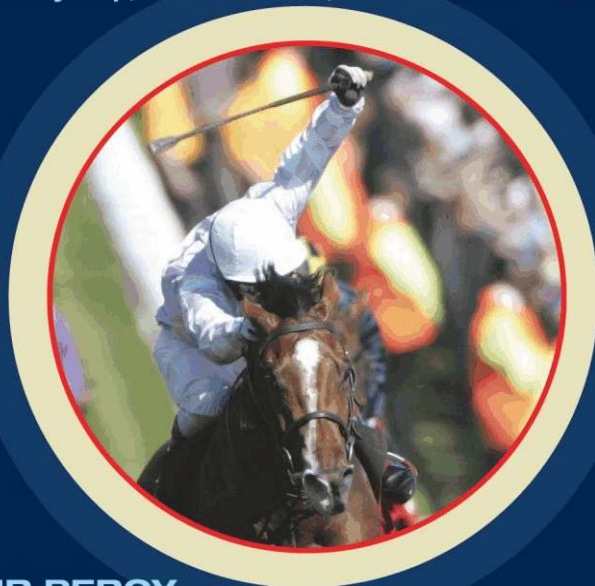

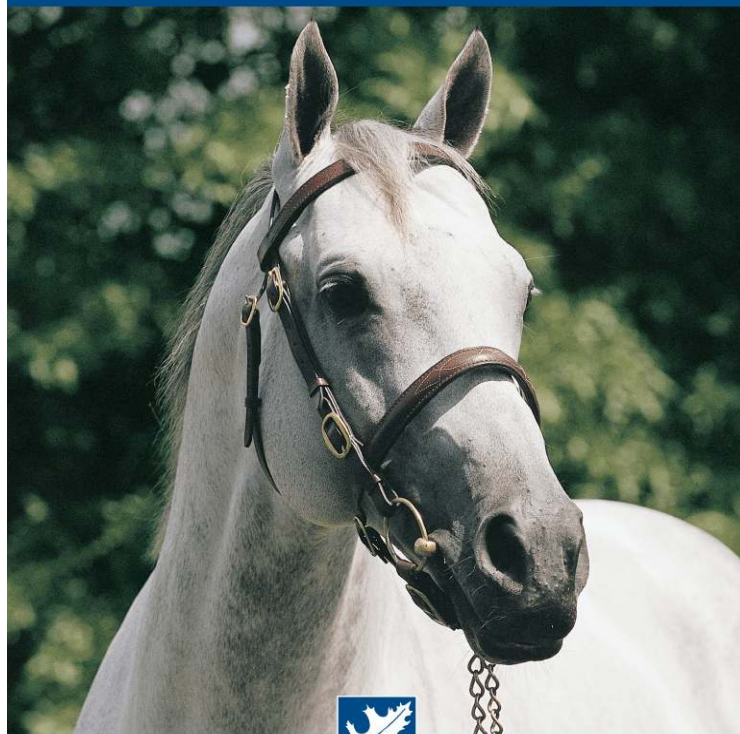
