It's four weeks until the 23rd running of the Breeders' Cup at Churchill Downs Nov. 4, and no fewer than eight Grade I races will be decided from sea to shining sea this afternoon. At Belmont Park, the connections of just three horses were courageous enough to tackle the



assignment of taking on Bernardini (A.P. Indy) in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. In facing fellow sophomore and Irish raider Dylan Thomas (Ire) (Danehill), in some eyes Europe's top three-year-old, and two others, the Darley runner will be part of the smallest Jockey Club field since Waquoit bested three other rivals by 15 lengths in 1988. "He's done everything we could have possibly asked him to do this year facing three-year-olds," trainer Tom Albertrani said. "This is another challenge for him facing older horses, but right now I've got a world of confidence that this horse will go

out there and run his race. You have to take each race individually and respect each horse that's in there." In the GI Vosburgh S., Henny Hughes (Hennessy) will try to cement his status as the favorite for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, but must defeat Silver Train (Old Trieste), who looks to run his winning streak at Big Sandy to six straight. English Channel (Smart Strike) looks to regain some of his lost luster in the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic, Film Maker (Dynaformer), on the board in the past two runnings of the Filly and Mare Turf, may go favored in the GI Flower Bowl and Fleet Indian (Indian Charlie) goes for her eighth straight win in the GI Beldame S. At Keeneland, Miesque's Approval (Miesque's Son) squares off with Silent Name (Jpn) and G1 French 2000 Guineas winner Aussie Rules (Danehill) in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile and Circular Quay (Thunder Gulch) looks to remain undefeated as he tries two turns in the GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity. The GI Ancient Title Breeders' Cup S. at Santa Anita features Bordonaro (Memo {Chi}) and top Breeders' Cup chances Aragorn (Ire) (Giant's Causeway) and Lava Man (Slew City Slew) go postward in the GII Oak Tree BC Mile and GII Goodwood BC H., respectively.

Patiently handled approaching the stretch, she was steered out in upper stretch and outfought Untouched Talent to the wire.

In winning his subsequent five starts, no horse has so much as come close to warming up the Darley runner, who rose to national prominence with his "tarnished" success in the GI Preakness S. in May. With nothing to gain by competing in the Belmont, the son

of GISW Cara Rafaela completed the GII Jim Dandy S .--GI Travers S. double July 29 and Aug. 26 in front-running fashion, his less-preferred style. Should he adopt the same strategy today, he will have to deal with Wanderin Boy, a two-time graded-stakes winner this season, who most recently took the GII Brooklyn Breeders' Cup H. Sept. 16. But jockey Javier Castellano is not the least bit concerned about the shape of the race. "He's a really good horse and you can do anything you want with him," the rider said of Bernardini. "Wanderin Boy has a lot of speed. If he wants to go fast, I can take Bernardini back. He's not a rank horse. He's a classy horse." Dylan Thomas is Europe's leading threeyear-old in many circles off wins in the July 2 G1 Irish Derby and the Sept. 9 G1 Irish Champion S., an event in which he defeated champion Ouija Board (GB). The bay has reportedly trained well over a synthetic surface at home, but trainer Aidan O'Brien knows the task at hand is tough. "When he goes to the dirt, he may lose too much ground at the start," he commented. "Hopefully, we can keep him out of the kickback." John Velazquez takes the call.

Runner-up in this a year ago and subsequently fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, the four-year-old bested Cacique (Ire) in the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic May 6, but the Juddmonte runner exacted his revenge and beat English Channel into fourth in the GI Manhattan H. June 10. The chestnut found the line a half-length better than Cacique in the GI United Nations S. July 8, but he is coming off a lackluster fourth as the favorite in the GI Arlington Million. The top three from that Aug. 12 event have each returned to win stakes. Freedonia was victorious in two of her first four career starts before beating subsequent G2 Prix de Royallieu winner Montare (Ire) in the G2 Prix de Pomone at Deauville Aug. 6. The bay was an unlucky fourth in the Sept. 10 G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp, whose winner Mandesha (Fr) returned to take last weekend's G1 Prix de l'Opera.

Montauk H., and has been perfect ever since. She led every step to make it six in a row in the July 16 GII Delaware H. and added a front-running victory over Balletto in the Aug. 25 GI Personal Ensign S. last time out. But the five-year-old has been allowed to cut out very easy fractions during her winning streak, and that will not be the case today. "Her strength is that she's able to click off :12s over and over again, so we'll see if she can do that while stalking

somebody," trainer Todd Pletcher said. Take D'Tour cruised through four straight earlier this year, following a pair of Gulfstream allowance tallies with a 5 1/2length success over Balletto in the May 21 GII Shuvee H., where she dashed through an opening half in :46 1/5. The chestnut mare went a tick quicker early in the June 17 GI Odgen Phipps H. and still romped home a decisive winner, but she faded to fourth after being pressured through the opening fractions of the July 30 GI Go for Wand H. at Saratoga, and had to settle for second in her latest, the Sept. 10 GI Ruffian H. at Belmont. She has yet to prove she can carry her speed the nine furlongs of the Beldame. The two speedsters could well be compromised by pace scenario, but not so Balletto. It has been two days shy of two years since the chestnut filly has visited the winner's circle, but that victory came in the GI Frizette S., and she came back to be second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. She missed her entire three-year-old season, but has been on the board in four of five starts since her return, including a gallant effort when second by a nose to Spun Sugar in the Go for Wand. "She seems to be at her best right now," trainer Tom Albertrani said. Round Pond, six-for-nine lifetime, came back after a 5 1/2-month layoff to be second by a head in the Aug. 27 GII Molly Pitcher BC H. at Monmouth Park. She won the GI Acorn S. in her only other Belmont appearance, but tries nine panels for the first time.

Ultra-consistent Film Maker has been on the board in 21 of her 25 career starts. Second in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf in 2004 and third both this race and on Breeders' Cup day last year, the six-year-old mare capped off her 2005 campaign with a win in the Dec. 17 GII La Prevoyante H. at Calder. She returned to win the June 24 GIII All Along BC S. at Colonial Downs, and was just 1 3/4 lengths behind Gorella (Fr) when second in the Aug. 12 GI Beverly D. S., but needs to break her O-for-four streak at Belmont and her O-for-five record at a mile and a quarter. Honey Ryder captured five of her seven outings last year and has been just as effective this term. The gray reeled off victories in the Apr. 1 GIII Orchid H., May 27 GII Sheepshead Bay H. and July 15 R.G. Dick BC H. before finishing fourth in the Beverly D. In a field filled with come-from-behind horses, pacesetting duties could fall to Argentina. The four-year-old filly was just off the pace before finishing third in the May 29 GI Gamely BC S., June 24 GII New York BC H. and July 29 GI Diana H., where she was beaten just a head for all the money by Angara.

Remarkable News accomplished what not many can during the spring meet here, wiring an 8 1/2-furlong turf allowance event, and has gone on to better since. Winner of the GIII Connaught Cup S. at Woodbine in May, he was runner-up to Rebel Rebel (Ire) in the GIII Poker H. in July at Belmont. He bounced back to defeat top miler Ashkal Way (Ire) in the GII Fourstardave H. at Saratoga Aug. 6 and set the pace in the GI Woodbine Mile Sept. 17 before weakening to fifth. Miesque's Approval is arguably the second-best miler in the U.S. and commenced a three-race winning streak with an upset of Artie Schiller in this track's GII Maker's Mark Mile back in April. The seven-year-old added wins in the GII Firecracker Breeders' Cup H. at Churchill July 1 and the GIII Red Bank H. at Monmouth Sept. 9 and is the one to beat today. Silent Name won the GII Arcadia H. at Santa Anita Apr. 9, but has found Aragorn (Ire) too tough in his two most recent efforts when third in the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile May 29 and the GI Eddie Read H. over nine grassy furlongs at Del Mar July 23. He is well suited by the cutback to the mile, a distance at which he has four wins from seven starts. Aidan O'Brien sent the ill-fated Landseer (GB) to victory in this in 2002 and takes his chance with Aussie Rules this time around. Three-for-10 in his career, the gray colt posted his most important win to date in the G1 French 2000 Guineas in May, beating Marcus Andronicus by a half-length.

His compelling 4 1/2-length victory in the GI Hopeful S. put Circular Quay on top of the two-year-old division in the East and now the Todd Pletcher-trained colt looks to use the 93rd running of the Futurity as a springboard to favoritism in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Nov. 4. The son of GISW Circle of Life is undefeated in three lifetime starts, including late-rallying wins in the July 8 GIII Bashford Manor S. and the Sept. 4 Hopeful, when he made up some 13 lengths with a powerful, sustained run. Since then, Circular Quay has had two maintenance works going five panels at Belmont. Michael Tabor, who owns the chestnut with wife Doreen, won this race in 1995 with Honour and Glory, while Pletcher is looking for his first victory in the Futurity. Seven others will try to deny Team Pletcher, including Jim Tafel's Street Sense, who comes off a solid third in the Sept. 10 GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity. The dark bay looked strong in a mid-August maiden win in Chicago and, out of a Dixieland Band mare, is an interesting play as he tries the Polytrack for the first time. The presence of Great Hunter could provide a glimpse of how the West Coast juvenile colts will fare in this year's Breeders' Cup. A private purchase by J. Paul Reddam earlier this year, Great Hunter has completed the exacta in three straight graded events in Southern California, most recently to Horse Greeley as the favorite in the Sept. 6 GII Del Mar Futurity.

With trainer Rick Dutrow, Jr. unsure about sending Silver Train to the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint four weeks from today, race fans might have to be satisfied by seeing arguably the two best sprinters in the country square off in this afternoon's Vosburgh. Not that the race should be looked at as a consolation. Silver Train, last year's Sprint hero and winner of the GI Met Mile over this strip in May, will get one of the biggest challenges of his career as he lines up against the superb three-year-old Henny Hughes, who dazzled the Spa crowd with a dominant win in the Aug. 26 GI King's Bishop S. Dutrow said he is happy with the way Silver Train has progressed since winning the July 16 GII Tom Fool H., but is aware of the stiff task at hand. "Since I have had him, this is the absolute best he has ever been," Dutrow said. "This is an extremely important race for him. Henny Hughes is a monster. After this one we will explore all our options. Certainly the Breeders' Cup Sprint and the Hill `n' Dale Cigar Mile [GI at Aqueduct Nov. 25th] will be looked at." While he can't match Silver Train's impressive five-for-seven record at Belmont, Henny Hughes has also enjoyed some success over the surface. He won the Tremont S. by 15 lengths last year at Belmont, and was second in both the GI Champagne S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. He is considered a sure thing to try to do one better in this year's Breeders' Cup, but trainer Kiaran McLauglin isn't looking past the Vosburgh, as he knows that the race could hold championship implications. "The Vosburgh is a very important race in itself," McLaughlin said. "If we win this, it will our help our chances as Eclipse Award winning sprinter."



With Siren Lure training up to the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, Bordonaro looms the one to beat here. The five-year-old gelding has won eight of his 11 career starts, including the GIII Vernon O. Underwood S. at Hollywood last December and the GIII Count Fleet Sprint H. at Oaklawn in April. The 4-5 chalk despite making a return off a 3 1/2-month layoff in the July 30 GI Bing Crosby H. at Del Mar, he should have earned yet another victory, but was hit in the face by jockey Jon Court's whip as they approached the wire and finished second, a half-length behind Court's mount, Pure As Gold. The stewards declined to change to order of finish, so Bordonaro will look to exact his revenge here. To avoid a repeat of the Bing Crosby incident, trainer Bill Spawr guipped, "He's going to wear a face mask." Former claimer Pure As Gold, haltered for \$50,000 in February and by his present connections for \$100,000 in June, followed his controversial Grade I score with a second-place finish behind Siren Lure in the Aug. 20 GII Pat O'Brien BC H. Zanzibar, a Group 1 winner in his native country, was second by a halflength behind Captain Squire in the 2005 Ancient Title. He has not raced since, but has been working well for his return, posting a bullet five furlongs in :58 out of the gate Oct. 2.

Louisville, Kentucky by way of Anderson, Indiana? Perhaps. Whether a win in this race will translate into a trip to the GI Breeders' Cup Classic for Bright One remains to be seen, but the intriguing chestnut will get a chance to once again put himself on the three-year-old map after missing an intended start in the GI Travers S. due to illness. Given Bernardini's dominance in the Midsummer Derby, maybe his failure to make the race was a blessing in disguise. Regardless, Bright One has been impressive winning his last three and deserves respect. He broke his maiden by 9 1/2 lengths at Churchill June 17, winning the one-mile event in 1:33 4/5, then added the July 15 Forestry H. In his first test beyond two turns, the Dale Romans trainee was always in charge when taking the GIII West Virginia Derby Aug. 6, but a few weeks after emerged with some mucus in his lungs and was briefly sidelined. If his morning works are anything to go by, he should be ready for his return. On Sept. 24, from Romans's base at Churchill, Bright One worked four furlongs in a bullet :47 2/5, then came back to breeze five furlongs in :59 3/5 last Monday. Dr. Pleasure, a well-beaten third in the Travers, and Lewis Michael, a neck runner-up in the GII Peter Pan S. and most recently third to Lawyer Ron in the St. Lewis Derby Aug. 26, look to be the main challengers.

Lava Man comes into this contest on the strength of a six-race skein that includes the GI Santa Anita H., GI Hollywood Gold Cup and, most recently, the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 20. Each of those races was weight-for-age, however, and as the 126-pound highweight here, he'll have to give away at least eight pounds to his rivals. According to trainer Doug O'Neill, the weights "are as fair as they can be these days, but Lava Man, for what he's accomplished, should be carrying 130, but we get a nice spread of 11 pounds." He added, "Either we're going to be good enough or we're not if we run a really good first or second, we're going to be real happy." Getting an 11-pound concession is Brother Derek, the multiple Grade I winner who is unbeaten in four starts at Santa Anita. Hero of the GI Santa Anita Derby in April, the Cal-bred bay wound up fourth in both the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. and went on vacation. He returned Sept. 2 in the El Cajon S. at Del Mar, but was shocked at 2-5 to be fourth to Cindago. Trainer Dan Hendricks later admitted that he didn't have his charge quite fit enough that day.

Aragorn carries a three-race winning streak into the Oak Tree BC Mile. Off at 6-1 when he captured the May 29 GI Shoemaker BC Mile, he was 3-2 for his fourlength score in the July 23 GI Eddie Read H. and 2-5 when he hit the wire 1 1/2 lengths to the good in the Aug. 26 GII Del Mar BC H. The four-year-old was taken in hand in the final yards of that mile test and still stopped the timer in 1:32 3/5. If Wild Buddy runs a big race today, owner Michael Miller could put up \$180,000 to get him into the GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Churchill Nov. 4. The seven-year-old gelding was third in the July 16 GII Sunset BC H. going a mile and a half and, dropping back in distance, ran second after setting the pace in the Del Mar BC. "He ran his eyeballs out," trainer Steve Knapp said. "If he runs huge [today], we'll supplement him." Six-year-old Buckland Manor was third in this race last year, then came back after a short break and missed by a nose when second to High Limit in the Jan. 7 GII San Pasqual H. on the dirt. A distant eighth in the Feb. 5 GII San Antonio H., he returned to the grass for the Mar. 4 Kilroe Mile H. and pressed the pace before weakening late to be eighth again, but this time beaten just 1 3/4 lengths. Pick 6 Rescheduled for Saturday:

Officials at Belmont Park were forced to postpone yesterday's Pick 6 wager, featuring a carryover of \$456,861, to Saturday, after technical difficulties interfered with the dissemination of the NYRA racing signal beyond New York. The problems surfaced early in the day and resulted in a 28-minute delay in the post time for race three as attempts were made to rectify the problem. The decision to cancel the Pick 6 was made immediately after the third race; the wager was set to begin with the following race. "This was a decision based on fairness to all our wagering participants across the country," said William A. Nader, NYRA senior vice president and COO. "Bettors here on track and at New York City OTB had the opportunity to watch and wager on our races, but the rest of the NYRA simulcast network was in the dark. Since the huge carryover was built on dollars wagered by customers from Canada to California, every customer deserved the opportunity to participate. This was a tough decision, but one based on fairness."

Aggadan Retired to Monhill Farm:

Aggadan (Carnivalay--Georgia K., by Horatius), a three-time stakes winner and runner-up to Ghostzapper in the 2003 GI Vosburgh S., has been retired and will enter stud at Bernardo Mongil III's Monhill Farm in Pine Plains, New York. He will stand for a fee of \$7,500. On the board in 31 of his 42 career starts, he posted 11 triple-digit speed figures, including a streak of seven in succession, and earned \$860,306.
