

#### **BURNING DOWN THE HOUSE**

They could only find three rivals to try their luck against **Bernardini** (A.P. Indy) in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park yesterday, and the trio

proved hopelessly overmatched. Sent off the 1-10 favorite in his first outing against older horses, Bernardini was hard held by jockey Javier Castellano as he shadowed **Wanderin Boy** (Seeking the Gold) for the opening mile. The Darley three-year-old dismissed

the frontrunner at the top of the lane and was never out of third gear as he came under the wire a 6 3/4-length winner. "That was exactly what I was hoping for," trainer Tom Albertrani said. "He does things so easily, I don't know if anyone can give him the kind of race where he was to fight. Look at the hold Javier had on him. It looked like he could take the lead at any time. It worked out very, very well. I've got a fresh horse for the Breeders' Cup now." Cont. p2

Proving she doesn't need to be on the lead, Fleet Indian (Indian Charlie) changed tactics for yesterday's GI Beldame S. at Belmont Park. Stalking the early pace set by Take d'Tour (Tour d'Or) and then Round Pond (Awesome Again), the dark bay took over at the top of the lane and held off Balletto (UAE) (Timber Country) to pick up her eighth straight victory. "What we were hoping to find out, which will help us in the Breeders' Cup, is that she can sit off horses and dig in," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "She showed that today." Cont. p4

Bernardini hasn't put a foot wrong since finishing fourth in his debut at Gulfstream Jan. 7. Bred in the

purple and looking the part, he was a 7 3/4-length maiden winner Mar. 4 and came back to post a 3 3/4-length score in the GIII Withers S. Let go at 12-1 behind Kentucky Derby hero Barbaro in the May 19 GI Preakness, he was overshadowed when the star of the

show broke down just strides into the race, but has since proved that 5 1/4-length Classic score was no fluke. With connections opting to skip the GI Belmont

S., Bernardini awaited the July 29 GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga and won by nine in what was nothing more than a public workout. Allowed to sit second as Wanderin Boy tried to save something for the finish, easing through a half in :48.13 and three-quarters in 1:11.81, Bernardini went after the lead after a mile in 1:35.86 and galloped through a final quarter in

:25.16, leaving plenty in the tank for the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Churchill Downs. "I had so much horse today," jockey Javier Castellano said. "I never asked him. It looked pretty easy." G1 Irish Derby and G1 Irish Champion S. winner Dylan Thomas (Ire) (Danehill), making his first start on the dirt, trailed the field throughout, finishing 32 1/4 lengths behind the winner in last.

#### Patience Rewarded...

Javier Castellano was especially pleased with the patience his mount showed yesterday. "I liked the way he did it today," he said. "He settled down perfectly behind the speed horse. I didn't want him on the lead because I want him to be focused for his next race, the

Breeders' Cup. In the Breeders' Cup, someone may want to go for the lead. There is more pressure and more pace in that kind of a race." The rider added, "He's a special horse, and that kind of a horse is hard to find. He's my spoiled baby." Looking ahead, Tom Albertrani said, "He'll probably stay here [at Belmont] until a few days before the [Classic]. Depending upon what flights we

can get out, maybe he'll leave on Wednesday [Nov. 1]." And who are the horses to beat for year-end honors? "I think it will come down to Lava Man, Invasor (Arg) and us for Horse of the Year," Albertrani remarked. Trainer Nick Zito, who saddled Wanderin Boy and third-place finisher Andromeda's Hero, added his praise. "This horse has superstar credentials," Zito said. "If he wins the Breeders' Cup, he'll certainly solidify that. It's the first time I almost clapped for a horse that beat me. That was pretty cool. That was a tremendous horse. It looked like his rabbit might steal the race away from him, but English Channel ran down pacemaker lcy Atlantic (Stormy Atlantic) and pulled away to his third Grade I victory of the season. Fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf to end 2005, the chestnut opened the new year with a win in the Mar. 11 Canadian Turf H. at Gulfstream and earned his first at the highest level in the May 6 GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic at Churchill Downs. The four-year-old was compromised by a slow pace when fourth, just a half-length behind Cacique (Ire), in the June 10 GI Manhattan H., but turned the tables on that rival in the July 8 GI United Nations H. at Monmouth Park. The early fractions were slow again in the Aug. 12 GI Arlington Million and English Channel was fourth again, so owner James Scatuorchio went out and bought what he tought was guaranteed early speed in Icy Atlantic. The race, however, did not unfold that way. Icy Atlantic did go to the front, but loped through a leisurely six panels in 1:16.35. He still held the advantage as they hit the stretch, but English Channel charged past at the eighth pole for the score.

#### Turf Classic cont.

"He made it look a little more difficult than it was, but he went on and looked really good," said jockey John Velazquez. "He proved today that he can get 12 furlongs." It was the third Grade I winner on the afternoon for trainer Todd Pletcher, who also took the GI Beldame S. with Fleet Indian and GI Flower Bowl Invitational S. with Honey Ryder. "This horse has a heavy argument for being champion turf horse," Pletcher said. "His record stacks up with anyone's in the division." Too much for the sophomore sprinters to handle in the July 1 GIII Jersey Shore BC S. at Monmouth Park and the Aug. 26 GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga, Henny Hughes took on older speedsters at Belmont and made it a perfect three-for-three on the year. Longshot Attila's Storm was sent away from the gate in his first start since January and cut out quick fractions, but he was joined by Henny Hughes at the quarter pole, and the three-year-old pulled away from his rivals down the lane to stamp himself the one to beat in the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. "I told Johnny that if another horse clears us, that would be great," trainer Kiaran McLaughlin said. "Just ride your race. We broke a little flat-footed, but everything worked out great." As for how he will get the colt ready for the World Thoroughbred Championships, McLaughlin added, "We're there now. We'll keep him happy. We just have to go a few halves with him." Fleet Indian started her streak in modest company, besting New York-breds in the Montauk H. at Agueduct last November. A Philly Park allowance winner in December, she was sent through the ring at Keeneland January, then added the Mar. 26 GIII Next Move H. in her first start under new management. The five-year-old was allowed easy leads in her next four starts and was never challenged, scoring by an average of 7 1/2 lengths over a stretch that culminated with a 4 1/4length victory over Balletto in the Aug. 25 GI Personal Ensign S. at Saratoga. She would have company on the front end in the Beldame, but was sent off the odds-on chalk to make it eight in a row. Settled in fourth while tucked in at the rail through six panels in 1:10.36. Fleet Indian drove past Round Pond as they hit the lane and was all out to hold off perpetual bridesmaid Balletto, who was picking up her third straight second-place finish in Grade I company. Great Hunter had to settle for second in the July 4 GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship S., Aug. 13 GII Best Pal S. and Sept. 6 GII Del Mar Futurity, but outfinished favorite Circular Quay to earn his first stakes success after a trip to the Midwest. The dark bay was sent off a lukewarm, second choice in his first try at the Grade I level. Jockey Victor Espinoza bided his time just off the early leaders while saving ground, but his strategy nearly backfired when his mount was caught in tight as they headed into the far turn. Steadied briefly off heels, Great Hunter fought his way to the outside for clear sailing and twice brushed with the crowd's odds-on choice as they turned into the lane, then took over nearing the wire as Circular Quay stayed on for second. "He even shocked me today, the way he ran," said Espinoza, on the colt for the first time. "He was in a little traffic, but as soon as he got free he settled nicely. I had a chance to swing to the outside and I got lucky because he got through on the outside. He was really something else." The winner will aim for the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. The one-time claimer Bordonaro improved his record to nine wins in 12 lifetimes starts with his first Grade I score. The Cal-bred gelding got off to a late start, making his career debut in February of his four-year-old season, but won all but two of his eight attempts last term, including the restricted Pirate's Bounty H. and Cal Cup Sprint H. and the GIII Vernon O. Underwood S. Favored in his 2006 bow, he took the Sunshine Millions Sprint at Gulfstream Park Jan. 28, then returned three months later to annex the GIII Count Fleet Sprint H. at Oaklawn in mid-April. The 4-5 chalk coming off the bench in the July 30 GI Bing Crosby H., he was in the process of engaging Pure As Gold (Stolen Gold) in upper stretch when he was struck in the face by his rival's whip. Forced to settle for second that day when stewards opted not to reverse the order of finish, he was out to avenge that loss here. Making it look easy, Bordonaro set the track on fire through :21 2/5 and :43 4/5 fractions and was always holding Thor's Echo safe down the lane. 
