GAME ON AT TATTERSALLS

After a three-day break, selling resumes at Tattersalls for Part 2 of the October Yearling Sale with a marathon week in prospect. Action gets underway at 9:30 a.m. The 1,209-lot catalogue is 39 percent larger than its 2005 equivalent and buyers will have no shortage of choice. The sale is graded through the week, with the best lots on offer today and tomorrow. Among the standouts on paper is Lot 1123, a Cape Cross (Ire) half-sister to this season's G1 Falmouth S. winner Rajeem (GB) (Diktat {GB}). She looks sure to show a good advance on the 20,000gns she cost vendor Keith Harte as a foal. Lot 779 has had an important recent pedigree update. The Killeen Castle Stud offering is a full-brother to the recent G1 Cheveley Park S. heroine Indian Ink (Ire) (Indian Ridge). Lot 1116 is a Fraam (GB) (Lead On Time) half-brother to last season's G2 Lowther S. winner Flashy Wings (GB) (Zafonic) consigned from Norman Court Stud. Among the dearer pinhooked lots is Lot 713, a UAE-bred Selkirk filly who cost 80,000gns as a foal and is offered from Peter Stanley's New England Stud. Lot 791, a Diesis (GB) colt out of Mill Guineas (Salse), was bought for \$140,000 at Keeneland in January and reappears from Timmy Hyde's Camas Park Stud. "Everyone agrees it's a good catalogue," said Tattersalls marketing director Jimmy George yesterday. "It is bigger than last year's and there is sure to be value for money for buyers at all levels of the market. The G1 Epsom Derby winner Sir Percy (GB) (Mark of Esteem {Ire}) was bought out of this sale for 16,000gns two years ago and top two-year-old Strategic Prince (GB) (Dansili {GB}) also came from this sale, so the quality is there for all to see." The sale runs today through Saturday, beginning at 9:30 a.m. each day. On Thursday and Friday there are also post-racing sessions starting at 5:30 p.m.

SOVIET SONG RETIRED

The Elite Racing Club yesterday announced the retirement of its six-year-old mare **Soviet Song (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}). After a lackluster workout over the weekend, the decision was made to end the career of the five-time Group 1 winner, whose total prize money reached £1,168,370 while under trainer James Fanshawe's care. "We thought she might run in the Champion S., but she was a bit disappointing in a piece of work on Saturday and, after speaking to our managing director here this morning, we have made the decision to retire her now," the syndicate's racing manager Matthew Budden said yesterday. "She has been fantastic, a dream come true for all the members of the club and

there have been so many highs. We've had some fantastic times with her over the years, it's unbelievable really." Soviet Song was unbeaten at two and annexed the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot before returning to finish runner-up in the following year's G1 Coronation S.

Getty Images at that track. At four, she cap-

tured the G1 Falmouth S. at Newmarket, G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood and G1 Matron S. at Leopardstown before returning the next year to record a second straight Falmouth success. With just one win to her tally in 2006, which came at Royal Ascot in the June 21 G2 Windsor Forest S., retirement had been discussed by connections and was confirmed after her latest ninelength defeat in last Saturday's G1 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket. "She is obviously six years old now and we've come to the end of the season," Budden added. "She hadn't really sparkled in her work this year and she was really quite flat on Saturday. James [Fanshawe] just really felt that the time was right to retire her and that's why the decision has been made--I think it would have been very bold to keep her in training at seven." Soviet Song, who was bred by Elite, will become a feature of its select broodmare band now. "The horses are all owned by the club itself, so she could join our breeding program," Budden said. "We have seven mares at the moment, and of course we bred Soviet Song as well, so she'll be joining our broodmare band and hopefully we'll have an awful lot more to look forward to

"He'll go to Keeneland, then we'll figure out when we'll send him over to Churchill," said trainer Doug O'Neill. "The game plan is to train him at Keeneland as long as we can." Lava Man will be looking for his first win outside of California in the \$5-million Classic. "I think we definitely have something to prove," O'Neill admitted. "We definitely think we can do it. It's not like we're being bullheaded and going about the Classic the exact same way we went about the [GI] Jockey Club Gold Cup last year [when a well-beaten seventh]. We're going to do things different this year. He'll be back in Kentucky in ample time and he seems like he's as good as he's every been, too, so it seems like a good time to tackle that challenge of running out of state. Trainer Marcus Tregoning issued an upbeat bulletin on the June 3 Classic hero after an impressive recent home gallop. "He's fine," Tregoning told the Racing Post. "He took his work really well and we were delighted he went so well. The shoulder probably was a bit of a worry, so it is a relief to see him work well. He's a very fit horse, though, so it wasn't as if we had to start from scratch, we just had to keep him ticking over." Also included in the five-day entry: Hurricane Run (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}), Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) and Notnowcato (GB) (Inchinor {GB}). Back in 1994, Darshaan's eldest daughters were only eight years old. There were already signs, though, that this handsome Classic winner with an outcross pedigree was going to develop into a highly effective broodmare sire, just as his sire Shirley Heights and grandsire Mill Reef had done before him.

From comparatively few runners in 1994, Darshaan's daughters had been represented by Cajarian, a Group 3 winner in Ireland, Kalajana, a Group 3 winner in France, and Kalabo, a two-year-old Listed winner in England.

James Wigan, of London Thoroughbred Services, could therefore probably hardly believe his luck when he was able to buy Masskana, a six-year-old daughter of Darshaan, for 48,000gns. Admittedly Masskana hadn't been anything out of the ordinary on the race-course but she had won three small races at around 1¼ miles in the French provinces. Of greater importance was the fact that she came from a first-rate family--one good enough to persuade the Aga Khan to make one of his rare sorties into the sales ring. Also, she was in foal to Sadler's Wells' brother Fairy King, whose services had been priced at IR20,000gns in 1994.

The reason why the Aga Khan added Masskana's second dam, Miss Melody, to his broodmare band in 1977 was that she was a granddaughter of the remarkable broodmare Sister Sarah. Sister Sarah was herself a great-granddaughter of the legendary Pretty Polly. Among Sister Sarah's most notable descendants were St Paddy (Derby and St Leger), Flying Water (1,000 Guineas), To-Agori-Mou (2,000 Guineas) and the champion sires Nearctic, Great Nephew and Northern Taste. The family has more recently produced another exceptionally influential broodmare in Balidaress.

Miss Melody's purchase yielded one major dividend for the Aga, in the form of Masskana's dam, the Thatch filly Masarika. Having won the Prix du Bois and Prix Robert Papin as a two-year-old, Masarika triumphed in the French 1,000 Guineas in 1984. By the time Masskana came up for auction in 1994, Masarika had been represented by her group-winning sons Massyar (G2 Gallinule S. and third in the G1 Irish 2,000 Guineas) and Madjaristan (GIII Arcadia H. and third in the GI Eddie Read H.), so Masskana had plenty going for her.

Masskana's new owner has given her every chance, and has been amply rewarded, both on the racetrack and in the sales ring. Her 1996 Royal Academy colt, Wallace, went within a short head of becoming a group winner, earning a Timeform rating of 117 in the process, and Sulk, her 1999 filly by Selkirk, did even better. Sulk won the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac, carrying James Wigan's colors, and was later placed in the Yorkshire Oaks and Prix Royal-Oak, showing plenty of stamina for a daughter of Selkirk. These successes helped four of Masskana's yearlings to sell for between 220,000gns and 300,000gns. One of those yearlings, the Rock of Gibraltar colt Eagle Mountain, provided his sire with his first group success when he strode right away from the opposition in the G2 Juddmonte Beresford S. His impressive display caused Eagle Mountain's odds for next year's 2,000 Guineas to be generally reduced to around 14-1 behind the favourite Teofilo, who beat Eagle Mountain by only a head in the G2 Futurity S.


Eagle Mountain's Group 2 victory must have been good news to Charlie Gordon-Watson, who recently paid 300,000gns--the best price so far for a member of Rock of Gibraltar's second crop--for another colt out of a Darshaan mare.

You can also pick up a copy of the TDN today at the OBS Fall Mixed Sale and the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale. Darshaan's daughters have made enormous progress since Masskana came on the market in 1994. He has rarely been out of the top four broodmare sires over the last nine years, with five top-two finishes and a total of over 20 Group 1 winners. Ever since Darshaan mares started to enjoy spectacular success with Sadler's Wells and some of his sons, breeders have tended to follow this route with a single-minded devotion. This cross now has nearly 200 foals of racing age and has produced 13 percent stakes winners.

However, there are encouraging signs that Darshaan mares might also have a bright future with the Danzig male line, including the Danehill branch. Polish Precedent, a son of Danzig, sired this year's French Derby winner Darsi from a Darshaan mare, and he also had two Group 2 winners among his 23 foals bred this way. Green Desert and his son Desert Prince are others with stakes winners out of Darshaan's daughters. As for Danehill, he left only 12 foals out of Darshaan mares but they include Catcher In The Rye, a strong-finishing second in the 2003 French 2,000 Guineas, Mountain High, a narrowly beaten second in a pair of Group 2 contests this year, and an Australian stakes winner. Now Rock of Gibraltar has come up with a potential classic colt with his first mating with a daughter of Darshaan.

Incidentally, another Danehill stallion, Danehill Dancer, was mated with a mare from Eagle Rock's family and this mare--an unraced granddaughter of Miss Melody by Sadler's Wells--produced the 2006 G3 winner Danehill Music.

Eagle Mountain's efforts have been largely responsible for ensuring that Rock of Gibraltar is going to finish among the leading first-crop sires of 2006. I'd have to say, though, that I was expecting more from this magnificent racehorse--a winner of seven straight Group 1 races--than he has accomplished so far. However, he started the 2003 covering season in competition with his peerless sire at Coolmore. Unfortunately Danehill's death in mid-May, 2003, meant that Rock of Gibraltar led Coolmore's Danehill team in 2004, at a fee of €65,000, so it's possible that his second crop is destined to help fulfil my expectations.


