INDIAN RIDGE DIES

The Irish National Stud's Indian Ridge (Ire) (Ahonoora {GB}--Hillbrow {GB}, by Swing Easy) died yesterday of

a suspected heart attack, at the age of 21. The sire of Domedriver (Ire), Indian Haven (GB) and Ridgewood Pearl (GB) and this year's G1 Cheveley Park S. winner Indian Ink (Ire) stood at the County Kildare stud for 12 years and that establishment's Director John Clarke told the Racing Post, "Indian Ridge has left a wonderful legacy behind.

He was one of our greatest stallions here at the Irish National Stud and he was a real old friend to everyone here." In total, Indian Ridge, who won the G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot in 1988 before adding the G3 Duke of York S. and G2 King's Stand S. to his record the following year, sired eight Group 1 winners, with his most famous product being Ridgewood Pearl, who carried all before her in 1995 when she took the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, G1 Coronation S., G1 Prix du Moulin and GI Breeders' Cup Mile. He started his stud career in Britain at the Campbell Stud in 1990 at a fee of £5,000 and produced the Group winners Island Magic (GB) and Ridgewood Ben (GB) from his first crop, taking him to the top of that category amongst his peers. Moved to his Irish base in 1993, he went on to sire the 1997 G1 July Cup hero Compton Place (GB), the 2000 G1 Prix de l'Abbave scorer Namid (GB), as well as the 2002 GI Breeders' Cup Mile winner Domedriver and the following year's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas victor Indian Haven. Last year, Relaxed Gesture (Ire) captured the GI Canadian International at Woodbine. He was standing at €75,000 at the time of his death.

CHINANDEGA STAYS PERFECT

Chinandega (Fr) (Chichicastenango (Fr)), a stable companion of the impressive G3 Prix des Chenes winner Spirit One (Fr), won at first asking at Chantilly 12 days previously and stepped up to add more strength in depth to Philippe Demercastel's Classic team for 2007. Missing the kick and racing in rear early, she was rousted along at the top of the straight by Stephane Pasquier and delivered a telling turn of acceleration down the outside to swamp Cicerole (Fr) (Barathea {Ire}) with 150 yards remaining to win yesterday's G3 Prix des Reservoirs by 3/4 of a length. Pushed out with hands and heels to assert in the run to the line, she was firmly on top there for an emotional result. "We saved this filly from certain death as a youngster, so this is rewarding," Demercastel, her breeder, owner and trainer said. "She is also the first stakes winner for Chichicastenango, who was such a good horse for me and she looks guite nice. She is through for the season, but we'll look at the Classics next year and with Spirit One, it's been a nice year."

WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES

Saturday's GI Champagne S. offered a fascinating mix. There was the proven, represented by Scat Daddy, winner of the GII Sanford S., and runner-up, after a rough trip, in the GI Hopeful S. The undefeated stakes winners Got The Last Laugh, successful in the GIII Arlington-Washington Breeders' Futurity; Xchanger, who had taken the GIII Sapling S., and New York-bred I'm a Numbers Guy, runaway victor in the restricted Bertram Bongard S. The unproven, but distinctly promising Nobiz Like Shobiz, devasting winner of a Belmont maiden on his only previous start, and Liquidity, who was also victorious in his only outing, winning a six furlong Oaklawn maiden in a fast time also added intrique to the Champagne. Just for good measure, the field also included Big Timer, an undefeated English group winner whose pedigree encouraged his connections to believe that he would handle dirt.

Turning for home, the race came down to a battle between horses from the two extremes, Nobiz Like Shobiz--who had made a big move on the turn--and Scat Daddy--beginning to role on the outside--along with the GI Hopeful S. fourth Pegasus Wind, who had made a bold bid to steal the race.

All three colts emerged with great credit, but at the end of the day, Scat Daddy prevailed by 3/4 of a length over Nobiz Like Shobiz with Pegasus Wind just a halflength back. The trio pulled nearly nine lengths clear of the fourth horse.

Both first and second are further credits for Storm Cat. Scat Daddy is from the first crop of Johannesburg, a grandson of Storm Cat, while Nobiz Like Showbiz, a son of Albert the Great, is out of a mare by Storm Cat. The victory of Scat Daddy opened up Johannesburg's lead in the freshman sire race (also propelling him into first in the two-year-old sire table), and there can have been few more likely candidates for early stud success. A look a Johannesburg's juvenile career shows it to be quite simply unique.

Undefeated in seven starts, he won six group/graded events from five to 8 1/2 furlongs, and his last four outings saw him capture the G1 Phoenix S., G1 Prix Morny, G1 Middle Park S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, making him the only horse to win Group/Grade one races in four different countries in a single season. These efforts probably took their toll on Johannesburg, as he didn't recapture his form the following season. He was beaten just a short-head by the year older Rebelline in the seven-furlong G3 Gladness S. on his debut, but then finished off the board in the GI Kentucky Derby, and when dropped back to six furlongs in the G1 Golden Jubilee S.

Still, Johannesburg's stellar two-year-old record, combined with a first crop totaling 135 foals, made rapid results a virtual inevitability, and so it has proved. So far, he has 18 first-crop winners, including Scat Daddy; the G2 Richmond S. winner, Hamoody; Rabatash, who took the G3 Round Tower S. in Ireland; Continental Mile S. victor Marcavelly; and Fernando Po, who took the With Anticipation S. at Saratoga. He's twice had a stakes one-two, with Scat Daddy and Teuflesberg in the Sanford, and with Marcavelly and Daytona in the Continental Mile.

What she lacked in race-record, Love Style, more than made up in pedigree. A daughter of Mr. Prospector, she was out of Likeable Style, a Nijinsky II mare who established herself as one of the best three-year-old fillies of her generation with wins in the Santa Ysabel S., GIII Senorita Breeders' Cup S., GIII Honeymoon H. and GI Las Virgenes S. Likeable Style's dam, Personable Lady, was another good sophomore filly, taking the La Centinela S. and Pasadena S., and finishing second in the GI Santa Susana S. and GIII Santa Ynez S., and third in the GI Fantasy S.

Personable Lady's third dam is the imported English-bred mare, Nato II. A listed winning two-year-old in her own county, Nato II became a successful and influential broodmare. Her only black-type winner was the Bewitch S. winner Royal Bund, but she also appears in the female line of turf star Quack; G1 Prix Lupin victor Flemensfirth; GI Metropolitan H. hero Wild Rush; G1 Middle Park S. winner Hayil; Sweet Talker, who took the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup, and who is bred on somewhat similar lines to Scat Daddy; she is by Stormin Fever, a son of Storm Cat, while her granddam is a half-sister to Scat Daddy's fourth dam.

As far as the structure of his pedigree is concerned, Scat Daddy is the product of a pattern we are beginning to see quite frequently these days--a Storm Cat line stallion over a Mr. Prospector line mare, with Nijinsky II also in the dam. Other examples include Group/Grade I winners Good Reward, High Yield and Nebraska Tornado, and Tale of the Cat, a half-brother to Johannesburg's dam. It's no surprise that this pattern works well, as Storm Cat and his sons cross extremely well over Mr. Prospector line mares, while Storm Cat's sire, Storm Bird, is bred on very similar lines to Nijinsky II.

Scat Daddy's pedigree takes things a stage further. Johannesburg's second dam, Yarn, is by Mr. Prospector, out of a daughter of a Nijinsky II mare, which makes him 4x2 to Mr. Prospector and 4x6x3 to Storm Bird/Nijinsky II.

It might be the latter combination that is responsible for the fact that Scat Daddy appears to be improving as the distances stretch out, something which one might not necessarily have expected from a son of Johannesburg out of a Mr. Prospector mare. Incidentally, we can also note that Teuflesberg, the Johannesburg colt who was a very close second to Scat Daddy in the Sanford, has Mr. Prospector and Nijinsky II through the three-parts-sisters Yarn and Line, who appear 3x2. Hamoody is out of a mare by Gulch, and has Mr. Prospector 4x3, and Rabatash has a second dam by Mr. Prospector, so also has that horse 4x3. Thus, the pattern of inbreeding to Mr. Prospector which seems to have been a matter of concern for some pundits certainly doesn't seem to be doing any harm for Johannesburg.

YEARLINGS TOP \$800-MILLION

Last week's Tattersalls October 2 yearling sale closed out the 2006 major North American and European Yearling Sale season in spectacular fashion. Having taken a huge chance by cataloguing 330 more horses (38 percent) than last year, it looked especially chancy after the unevenness of the previous week's October 1 sale. But, in the event, October 2 actually proved the strongest of all the 11 majors--in spite of the massive increase in numbers. For the whole week, 861 yearlings (80 percent of those offered) sold for a total of 27,700,200gns, and averaged 32,072gns (just about double that to convert to U.S. dollars). With the catalogue having increased by 38 percent, and a slight dip in the clearance rate, there were 35 percent more sold, for 63 percent more money, and a 20-percent increase in the average. Adding that many to the catalogue, you'd declare the sale a success if the average was just comparable to last year. For it to be up 20 percent on top of a 35-percent increase in the number sold--that's a monster sale.

The first two days of October 2--last Tuesday and Wednesday--were certainly among the hottest, if not the hottest, days at the European sales season. In that respect, they resembled Keeneland September, which was really strongest for the middle books. During last Tuesday and Wednesday combined, 463 yearlings grossed 20,308,000gns, and averaged 43,862gns-increases of 19 percent in the number sold, 57 percent in the gross, and 32 percent in average, from the comparable 2005 sessions. About 75 percent of October 2's gross increase over last year came on the first two days.

With October 1 following the international trend of contracting numbers at the top (Saratoga down from three days to two in 2005-06, Keeneland September Book 1 number catalogued falling), and, in light of my comments last week about stabling (Tattersalls is 850 per week), it now seems blindingly obvious. October 2's first two days were really the equivalent of a Book 3 at Keeneland's September Sale, therefore, the logical thing for Tattersalls to do is just to combine it all into one October Sale. The first four days would be Book 1 (two days instead of four, which should suit everyone better) and Book 2, each two-day book alphabetical by dam. The October 1 book we had this year would simply be renamed October, Books 1 & 2, and this year's October 2's first two days would be October, Book 3, and so on. The fact that the Tatts' grading system has quite naturally yielded up two days of Book 3 horses at the beginning of October 2 demonstrates that the two-day Book format seems guite logical, applied to their best two weeks of yearling sales.

October 2 completed the full complement of 11 bellwether North American and European yearling sales we're covering this year. The overall results are impressive. At this year's sales, a total of 7,706 yearlings sold for the U.S. dollar equivalent of \$808,761,050 (see table for conversion rates used)--an average of \$104,952, probably the first time ever the major yearling sale average has been over \$100,000. Last year, after the Fasig and Keeneland November sales and Tattersalls December, we were able to say that, in 2005, over 12,000 horses sold in 12 major yearling and breeding stock sales, grossing over \$1.2-billion, and averaging over \$100,000. This year, we are adding three European sales to our major sale designation: yearling sales at Baden-Baden and Milan, and Goffs' November Mixed Sale, for a total of 15. Whether they will actually average over \$100,000 remains to be seen, but what we can certainly say is that the now-11 major yearling sales we're covering were markedly better than last year. The number sold was up two percent, the gross up nine percent (nearly \$64-million), and the average up seven percent from last year's record levels. In 2005, remember, Keeneland September alone jumped almost \$60-million, and the equivalent sales had been up almost \$100-million in gross from the corresponding 2004 yearling sales.

The 11-sale gross has therefore increased by 25 percent--over \$160 million--in the last two years (from \$646 million to \$808 million), even as the average has gone up by almost \$15,000, or 16 percent, from \$90,101 in 2004 to a presumed record \$104,952 this year. It should be kept in mind, however, that in the previous four years, 2001-2004, the major sale yearling market grew by only four percent, from \$621 million in 2001 to \$646 million three years later. In fact, in North America the yearling market lost an estimated \$130 million in 2002-03, mostly from MRLS mare abortions in Kentucky, but also as a result of the Dotcom crash, which began in 1999, but didn't affect the thoroughbred industry's breeding and sales sector numbers until 2001. So the North American three-sale total of \$409 million in 2004 was only two percent higher than the corresponding 2001 total of \$402-million. The European yearling sales did increase in gross every year, though 2003 was better than 2004, when the European gross actually dropped about five percent, or \$14 million. Even given successive record Keeneland September sales, the European sales have certainly kept pace in the last two years. The combined eight-sale gross is up almost 40 percent since 2004 (\$94 million, to \$331 million this year from \$237 million in 2004), even while the European average is up 25 percent in the same period. That's strong.

But even given these impressive increases, is it really profitable? Recent history recalls that the best ratios of yearling averages to stud fees were happening around 1998-2000, in the early years of a huge thoroughbred market recovery which actually began in 1995. Perhaps most significantly, the percentage of yearlings being offered at that time by big-time stallions, with big-time stud fees, was not as great as it's been since the turn of the century. Thus the issue of profitability is being raised. The researchers are on the case now, and we're hoping to be able to produce some numbers for you this time next week--so stay tuned, as they say, on that one. Whatever the facts reveal about that, it's a certainty that breeders are in better shape on that score than they were two years ago, given the overall \$160-million increase in yearling sales since then.

LEMONS FOREVER DISTAFF BOUND


Lemons Forever (Lemon Drop Kid), victress of this year's GI Kentucky Oaks at Churchill Downs, will return to the site of her 47-1 upset in the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. "She loves the track here," trainer Dallas Stewart said. The chestnut is winless in her last four starts, including a fifth-place finish in the GI Spinster S. last out Oct. 8. "A couple of more jumps and I think she would have been second, so I was real proud of her," Stewart said. "There's always pace in the Breeders' Cup, so I think she'll be right there."

DISTAFF MAY BE NEXT FOR BAGHDARIA

A four-length tally in the Oct. 6 GIII Indiana Breeders' Cup Oaks may have earned **Baghdaria** (Royal Academy) a spot in the starting gate for the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. "We'd like to think she's a contender for the Breeders' Cup Distaff," trainer Tom Amoss commented. "That's a biased opinion from a trainer. But I can tell you this, she won't embarrass herself. I'm hopeful that it's not going to be a race that overfills, and if it does, I hope they [Breeders' Cup selection committee] will select her." Prior to the Indiana Oaks, Baghdaria finished eighth in the GI Coaching Club American Oaks at Belmont July 22.

BC DECISION LOOMS FOR VACARE

Lothenbach Stables' **Vacare** (Lear Fan), perfect in four career attempts, including a tally in Saturday's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup S., has returned to Hawthorne and may start in next in the GI Breeders' Cup F & M Turf. "The decision is Mr. Lothenbach's," trainer Chris Block said. "She came back out of the race in good shape, but it's tough to tell too much about her right now because she's so low key all the time. We'll know more about how well she bounced back when we send her to the track on Thursday."



THE DADDY RETIRED Graded stakes winner The Daddy (Valid Expectations--With a Princess, by With Approval) has been retired with a splint bone problem, according to Daily Racing Form. The New York-bred had not raced since taking the 2005 GII Super Derby. "He's the best horse I ever had," owner Greg Norman told DRF. "He just had a world of potential...he's going to be missed." Norman indicated that he wanted to stand the four-year-old for \$5,000 in New York, but that no farm had been confirmed yet. "There are a few of the farms here in New York that are interested in him," he added. "We should have a farm selected probably within the next few days. I probably will keep, if not 100-percent ownership in him, then a majority interest in the horse." A \$60,000 KEENOV weanling, The Daddy was purchased by Norman for \$125,000 as a yearling at FTNAUG. He captured his debut in July 2005 at Hollywood and added a 12-length victory in a Saratoga allowance a month later. The half-brother to GSW With a City then ran fourth to Lost in the Fog in the GI King's Bishop S. in what would be his only career loss. He rebounded to take the 10-furlong GII Super Derby Oct. 1, 2005, taking his career record to 4-3-0-0 with earnings of \$517,700.

72-Hour Entry Schedule to Begin at Churchill:

Beginning with the Oct. 29-Nov. 25 Churchill Downs Fall Meet, the Louisville, Kentucky racetrack will accept entries for races three days in advance. "With 72 hour entries, we can disseminate the racing information to our audiences much more quickly," said Don Richardson, senior vice president of racing for Churchill Downs Inc. "That's especially valuable to fans when there is a big carryover in the Pick Six, or if they're fans of multirace wagers like the Pick Three and Pick Four. When the entries are out 72 hours in advance of the race, it gives those fans more time to handicap those races."

TDN CRITERIA

The races covered in the TDN are as follows:

Stakes - purses of \$40,000/up Allowance Races - purses of \$20,000/up Optional Claiming Races - purses of \$20,000/up and a minimum claiming price of \$25,000 Maiden Special Weight Races - purses of \$18,000/up Maiden Claiming Races - purses of \$18,000/up and a minimum claiming price of \$40,000

LISHES PLAN OF ACTION Participants from the Thoroughbred breeding and racing industry who attended the Welfare and Safety of the Racehorse Summit in Lexington, Kentucky, Oct.16 and 17 have drafted action plans in six areas to improve conditions in various facets of the Thoroughbred industry. The six areas are Education & Licensing; Racing Conditions/Racing

Office; Research; Health and Medical Records; Racing Surfaces/Shoeing/Hoof Care; and Breeding Practices. Among the recommendations coming out of the two-day summit were:

WELFARE AND SAFETY SUMMIT ESTAB-

- Research, develop and publish additional statistics that will provide insight into the durability and longevity of progeny of breeding stock.
- Make efforts to have scientific research more widely distributed among industry stakeholders.
- Examine the use or ban of certain horseshoes, such as toe-grabs, in the wake of presentations and research by Dr. Sue Stover and other participants.
- Develop a uniform on-track injury reporting system for horses and humans.
- Provide continuing education for all horsemen, exercise riders, farriers and make initiatives like the Groom Elite Program more available throughout the country.

The summit was coordinated and underwritten by Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation and The Jockey Club and hosted by Keeneland. Its goal was to identify critical issues that affect horse health and/or shorten the career of racehorses and to develop action plans to address each issue. "I think the turnout and the interest in this summit proves that there is widespread concern among industry stakeholders about the welfare and safety of the racehorse," said Ed Bowen, president of Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation. "The summit was certainly successful in identifying issues and devising action plans and we're grateful to all the participants who were here."
