

TATTS AUTUMN HORSES IN TRAINING BEGINS

A busy October at Tattersalls continues this week when the Autumn Horses In Training Sale begins this morning. The four-day event, with 1,470 lots catalogued, is the world's largest sale of its type and, despite the fact that many of the best lots catalogued have been withdrawn, there are still plenty of offerings to appeal to the international flat and domestic jumping markets. Three-year-old Golden Arrow (Ire) (Danehill) is offered from Dermot Weld's stable, having won a Cork conditions event easily on his last start. Offered as Lot 902, he previously finished fifth in the GII American Derby. Several high-profile members of Aidan O'Brien's draft, originally slated for sale, are among the absentees, but those that remain include Lot 920, Tusculum (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), a Listed winner at The Curragh this year, who most recently finished fifth in the G1 St Leger at York. Six-year-old New Seeker (GB) (Green Desert), Lot 952, winner of a Listed event at Redcar last month also bears watching. 


