"The track at Churchill was muddy and she likes the Polytrack," trainer Dallas Stewart commented. "She went crisp and clean and cooled out fine. We're very happy with it." Lemons Forever heads to the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff off a fifth-place finish in the Oct. 8 GI Juddmonte Spinster S. Prepping for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, Commentator (Distorted Humor) and Malibu Mint

(Malibu Moon) each fired four-furlong moves in :47. "We couldn't be more pleased," trainer Jim Chapman said of the GI Princess Rooney H. heroine. "Actually, the rider [Kyle Kaenel] said she was a little more agressive today than normal. He said he was never able to turn the bit loose at all. She wanted to do a lot more." Malibu Mint was last seen annexing the GIII Thoroughbred Club of America S. at Keeneland Oct. 14, while Commentator looks to make amends for a 10thplace finish in Saratoga's GI Forego S. Sept. 2. Badge

of Silver (Silver Deputy) turned in a six-furlong bullet in 1:12.40 in preparation of the GI Breeders' Cup Mile. Exercise rider Frederic Buscail was pleased with the move. "He felt very good," Buscail said. "He traveled good. I didn't ask him. He did it all by himself pretty

Going Out in a Blaze of Glory...

David Hayes was confident Fields of Omagh would be competitive in his swansong after enduring a troubled run when fourth to El Segundo in the Oct. 14 Yalumba S., but the crowd sent the veteran off an 18-1 outsider. Settled one from the rear early, he charged down the outside to collar the leaders in the dying yards of a thrilling finish. "He just thrived on the atmosphere," jockey Craig Williams said. "I didn't have to pull the stick until quite late." Fields of Omagh had to overcome more than one setback to end his career in a blaze of glory, suffering two potentially career-ending ligament injuries. He was first injured after winning the G3 Eclipse S. at Sandown in November of 2001. Back on track nine months, he strained his offside suspensory nine starts later, but returned to be fifth in the 2002 Cox Plate. He won the prestigious event in 2003, was second in 2004 and third last year. "Fields of Omagh is a rule breaker," Lindsay Park Chief Veterinarian Campbell Baker said. "The amazing thing is that you rarely see a horse get sounder as he gets older. Most go the other way, but he's had less niggles as he's got older." You Make the Call...

Co-owner Bryan Martin, one of 31 members of the No Big Deal syndicate, also serves as the Moonee Vallee racecaller. He thought El Segundo had won until Fields of Omagh's number was semaphored; then he

almost fainted. "I can't believe it, I still don't know how he won," Martin said. "I felt at 800 meters we were a chance, but I cannot remember much of my call. Coming into the straight, I thought he was a chance to be in the finish. I was thinking it looked like El Segundo or Pompeii Ruler, and old Fields Fields of Omagh (far left) might run a great half-length

third." He added, "He is the bravest horse ever to look through a bridle, to come through the suspensory injuries he has had and win not one Cox Plate, but two, and he has been the catalyst for Living Legends." Needless to say, Martin was excused from calling the remaining three races on the card.

Living Legend...

Fields of Omagh captured a total of seven stakes, including three Group 1 races. Also runner-up in the 2002 G1 Caulfield Cup, he will now be retired to the new Living Legend Retirement property for former champion race horses at Greenvale, just outside of Melbourne. The property will be home to Might and Power (NZ), Doriemus (NZ), Saintly (Aus), Rogan Josh (Aus), Better Loosen Up (Aus), Paris Lane (Aus) and Sky Heights (NZ). In becoming the oldest winner of Australasia's weight-for-age championship, the nineyear-old also became the 11th two-time winner of the 84-year-old Cox Plate, joining the likes of Phar Lap (NZ), Sunline (NZ) and Northerly (Aus). He moves to fourth on the list of Australasia's all-time leading prizemoney earners. The A\$1.82 million he earned on Saturday took his career earnings to A\$6,456,240, placing him behind only Makybe Diva (GB), Sunline and Northerly.

He ran eighth in the Japan Cup Dirt Nov. 26 in his final start for Andrew Reid and found himself heading to Dubai. A close third in the G3 Maktoum Challenge - Round 2 Feb. 9, the chestnut weakened to be 10th in the G2 Maktoum Challenge -Round 3 Mar. 2 and concluded his tenure under Satish Seemar with a sixth in a rich Nad Al Sheba handicap Mar. 9. Eccentric didn't start again until Oct. 8, when he rallied for third in a grass allowance at Woodbine in his first outing for Roger Attfield. PANEL CALLS URGENT MEETING ON NYRA BAILOUT

by Tom Precious, Courtesy www.bloodhorse.com With New York Racing Association officials threatening to seek bankruptcy protection, state officials are rushing to complete a deal by Oct. 30 to get government bailout money flowing to the financially ailing NYRA. A state panel overseeing NYRA's finances is set to meet late in the afternoon Oct. 30, at which time the release of \$19 million could begin. The oversight board has refused to sign off on the funding stream because another state agency, the Lottery Commission, has not yet given final approval to a contract between NYRA and MGM Mirage for construction of a long-stalled casino project at Aqueduct racetrack. State officials declined to discuss the agenda for Monday's meeting. Scott Reif, a spokesman for the agency, said the details of the session are still being ironed out. Behind the scenes, though, lawyers for NYRA and the state are involved in heavy negotiations to get a final deal on the VLT project that will then release the \$19 million bailout package. The Legislature nearly a year ago approved a \$30 million pot of funds for NYRA, which must be re-paid, to help it meet a worsening cash flow situation. So far, \$11 million has been released. The issue has gotten embroiled in the bidding process underway to award a new franchise for the rights to run racing at Aqueduct, Belmont and Saratoga racetracks. NYRA is competing with two other entities representing a who's who of racing industry individuals and compa-



A filly by Starborough (GB) consigned by Thorsten Feddern's Bellow Hill Stud and a gelding by Mujahid from Tythe Barn Stables, agent for R.B. Hill, each brought final bids of 19,000gns to share top billing at a low-key final session to Part 3 of Tattersalls' October Yearling Sale in Newmarket yesterday. The filly, from the family of German champion Sheba (Ger), was purchased by bloodstock agent Borje Olsson. The gelding, a half to listed winner Fruit of Glory (GB), went to trainer John Jenkins. An expanded October catalogue saw the 1,100,000gns turnover rise by 35 percent on 2005, but the 6,320gns average was down six percent and the 3,500gns median fell by 28 percent. The clearance rate was 65.8 percent, as compared to 67.4 percent in 2005. "The record top price of 72,000gns for Fonthill Stud's Averti colt shows that, despite the huge rise in the number of yearlings catalogued here this year, there has still been demand for a good solid commercial yearling over the past two days," said Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony. "There have been a good number of English trainers in attendance and buyers from the established European markets of Italy, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Spain and Sweden, as well as newer emerging markets such as the Czech Republic, Iran, Kazakhstan and Russia have all been active."
