BERNARDINI EVEN-MONEY IN THE FALL CLASSIC

Darley homebred Bernardini (A.P. Indy), unbeaten in his last six attempts, including the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup S. last out Oct. 7, has drawn the three hole in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. The even-money morning-line favorite will try to become the first three-year-old to win the Classic since Tiznow in 2000. **Invasor (Arg)** (Candy Stripes), on the shelf since notching Saratoga's GI Whitney H. by a nose over **Sun King** (Charismatic), seeks his fourth straight Grade I tally. The 5-1 second choice has been assigned the 11 slot. Perfect in seven starts this season, 6-1 third choice **Lava Man** (Slew City Slew) will break from the eight post.

TRAINER CHANGE FOR SUPER FROLIC

Super Frolic (Pine Bluff), a 50-1 chance in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, has been moved to trainer Scott Blasi's barn. He was formerly trained by Vladimir Cerin. "Vladimir couldn't make the trip for personal reasons," Blasi commented. "We have horses here in Kentucky for Mr. Parra, so it was logical that he'd send the horse to us. The owner wanted to give the horse every chance and felt the Classic was a little tough, so they chose the Mile." Last year Super Frolic outran his 69-1 odds in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic to finish fourth behind Saint Liam.

DUO WORK IN CHURCHILL SLOP

Nightmare Affair (Out of Place), 30-1 on the morning-line for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, worked three furlongs in :36 over a sloppy Churchill main track yesterday. Jockey Edgar Prado was aboard for the move. "He worked very well, very easy," Prado said. "He's feeling good and even bucked me off on the way home. I landed on my feet though." **Teuflesberg** (Johannesburg), a 50-1 shot in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, breezed three furlongs in :38.80 with trainer Jamie Sanders in the irons. "Because the track wasn't good, we decided to do a two-minute lick [for a mile] instead of working, but he was getting a little strong," assistant trainer Donnie Kelly explained. "They ended up timing him. We put the blinkers on him and he knew it was time to work. He was getting mad because she wouldn't let him go."

Even after losing her last two starts by more than 34 lengths, **Joint Effort** figures to factor into the mix here. The chestnut rattled off consecutive wins beneath the Twin Spires earlier this season, notching the Gill La Troienne S. May 6 and the Gill Dogwood Breeders' Cup S. June 3. She looks to make amends for a seventh-place finish in the July 1 GI Mother Goose S. and the Aug. 5 GI Darley Test S.

Trippi Street, never worse than second in four career attempts, was the runner-up behind French Park over this course in last season's Gill Pocahontas S. She has faced the starter only twice this year, notching an Arlington allowance Aug. 2 before finishing second in that track's Safely Kept S. Sept. 4. **Sangrita** was freshened after a fifth-place finish behind Bushfire in Tampa's Florida Oaks Mar. 18, but returned to the races in style at Delaware, beating up on allowance foes Oct. 9.

PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES

STAYING FAST – SPEED MARES MORE VERSATILE AS PRODUCERS THAN RUNNERS

When asked what the three most important Thoroughbred attributes were, the late Aga Khan replied, "speed, speed and more speed." The Aga Khan should certainly have known as he was the owner of Mumtaz Mahal, also known as the "Flying Filly" and who, even now, almost a century after her birth, is renowned as one of the fastest horses ever to grace the turf.

Mumtaz Mahal's legacy to the breed extends well beyond her legendary reputation for speed. She and her daughters established a dynasty of important runners and producers, some of whom have had an incalculable impact on the breed. In North America that impact came primarily in the forms of Mahmoud, Nasrullah and Royal Charger.

Mahmoud, winner of the Epsom Derby, was the leading U.S. sire of 1946, and his offspring include Almahmoud, the granddam of Northern Dancer; Nasrullah, the best two-year-old of his crop in England. Nasrullah, like Mahmoud, a grandson of Mumtaz Mahal, followed Mahmoud to the U.S., and was five-time leading sire. His offspring includes Bold Ruler and Nashua. Royal Charger, a great-grandson of Mumtaz Mahal, and a three-parts-brother to Nasrullah, also made the journey from Europe to the U.S. He never lifted the sires' crown, but did found his own male line that extends through Turn-to and Hail to Reason.

One of the most notable aspects of Mumtaz Mahal's influence was that her pure speed, when correctly mated, rapidly transmuted into classic ability. Mahmoud not only won the Derby, but placed in all three legs of the English Triple Crown, and Nasrullah and Royal Charger were both classic placed.

Moving forward in time, a look at some more notable speed mares demonstrates that this attribute is not unique.

In fact a quick review of some more recent mares whose prime attribute was speed, reveals that it actually might be something of a trend. While not attempting a rigorous scientific study, we did peruse race records for examples of mares that captured black-type exclusive at distances of a mile or less, and produced major stakes winners that scored at a mile or up.

The early 1960's produced a couple of true standouts in this category in Too Bald and Best in Show. Too Bald produced five stakes winners, headed by Exceller, an international star best remembered for his epic battle with Seattle Slew in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, and a winner of 11 Group or Grade I events. Coincidentally, a mating between Seattle Slew and Too Bald produced another star in GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile victor and leading sire of two-year-olds, Capote. Too Bald also features as ancestress of this year's Grade I winner and Classic contender, Bob and John.

Born just a year after Too Bald, Best in Show was another super-producer with four stakes winners, among them Blushing Groom's daughter, Blush With Pride, heroine of the GI Kentucky Oaks. Of course, Best in Show has now founded an extraordinary family, which includes El Gran Senor, Spinning World, Domedriver, Denon, Strong Hope, Aldebaran, and this year's GI Belmont S. victor Jazil.

Moving to the 70's, at the beginning of the decade we find Shy Dawn, one of the legion of good runners produced by matings between another notable speed mare, Shy Dancer, and her descendants, with the sire, Grey Dawn II. Shy Dawn hit the target at stud with three stakes winners, including Opening Verse, triumphant in the GI Oaklawn H. and GI Breeders' Cup Mile, and the GIII Columbian H. winner So She Sleeps.

The mid-to-late 1970's provided a particularly rich vein of mares who achieve the alchemy we have been discussing, producing Great Lady M., Terlingua, Secrettame and Fall Aspen. Great Lady M., a prolific speedster, threw a true great in Lady's Secret. The gray daughter of Secretariat not only dominated the distaff division during her four-year-old season, but also defeated colts in the GI Whitney H., and earned honors as Horse of the Year.

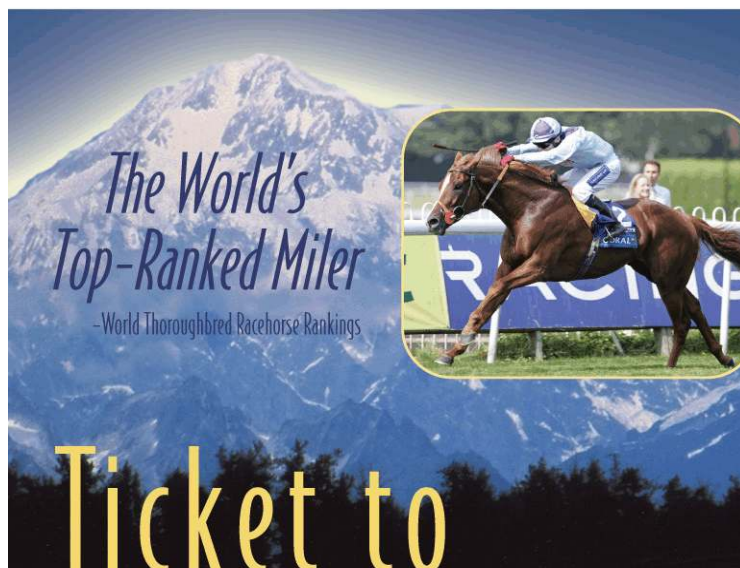

The inspiration for breeding Great Lady M. to Secretariat came from the fact that D. Wayne Lukas had trained Great Lady M.'s stable-companion, Terlingua. A member of Secretariat's second crop, and out of another brilliantly fast filly, Crimson Saint, Terlingua showed outstanding speed at two and three, her victories including a tally over the boys in the GII Hollywood Juvenile Championship. Of course, Terlingua changed the shape of the breed with her second foal, a colt by Storm Bird named Storm Cat. The Secretariat connection continues here with another daughter of 'Big Red' Secrettame. She made an indelible mark on the breed by producing GI Dwyer S. winner Gone West, sire of top-class horses at distances as far as 1 1/2 miles, and now one of the most sought-after sires of sires in the world. Fall Aspen would rank as one of the great producers of any era. She has no less than nine stakes winners to her credit, eight of them group or graded. They include Timber Country, champion two-year-old, and winner of the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and GI Preakness S.; Fort Wood, who took the G1 Grand Prix de Paris and now a stallion sensation in South Africa; the GI Gamely H. heroine Northern Aspen; and Mazzacano, who gave a remarkable example of speed to stamina transmutability with a triumph in the G3 Goodwood Cup at more than 2 1/2 miles.

Our first example of sprint mares who have been able to produce top-class ability at longer distances was Too Bald, and coincidentally, Too Bald's sister, Turn to Talent, also gets into the picture. She figures as the granddam of Broad Brush, who crossed very well with fast females. Out of Fara's Team, he sired Concern, captor of the GI Breeders' Cup Classic as a three-year-old. And, out of another good sprinting mare, Illeria, Broad Brush was responsible for both graded stakes winning Magic Broad, and Include, an earner of over \$1,600,000 whose victories included the GI Pimlico Special. Incidentally, one year before Include's victory, the Pimlico Special was captured by Golden Missile, another whose black-type wins came exclusively in sprints.

Moving right up to date, we'll conclude the informal survey of fast females with Roamin Rachel. Winner of the GI Ballerina H., she is dam of Zenno Rob Roy, a Sunday Silence colt who has amassed earnings of well over \$10 million, including a victory over some talented overseas invaders in the G1 Japan Cup.

Editors note: with the breeding stock sales at hand and many of our readers no doubt looking to add to their broodmare band, we thought this column was a timely addition to Alan Porter's normal Weekend Pedigree Perspectives in the TDN.

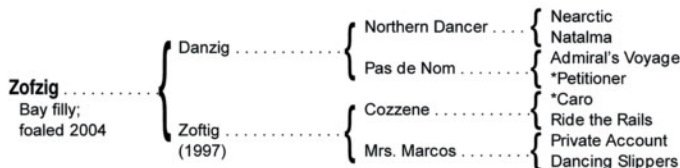
