BOWL GAME DIES

Greentree Stables' Bowl Game (Tom Rolfe--Around the Roses, by Round Table), the champion male turf horse of 1979 who was believed to be the oldest living



Eclipse Award winner, was euthanized due to the infirmities of old age yesterday at his farm in Paeonian Springs, Virginia, according to the farm's owner, Jonathan Miller. He was 32. Miller had cared for the retired Bowl Game aikenracinghalloffame.com champion on behalf of the Thoroughbred Retirement

Foundation for the past six years, and said that Bowl Game had experienced some trouble eating over the past week, but had been receiving intravenous nutrition and appeared bright and alert when he was turned out yesterday morning. "It was a beautiful, sunny day and he was out in the pasture and got two-thirds of the way up the hill, and just lay down," said Miller, who also serves as president of the TRF. "He was in some distress, and it was clear to us that the time had come." At five, Bowl Game won the GI Washington D. C. International and set a track record in the GI Turf Classic en route to his championship honors. The bay lived on Betsey Cushing Whitney's Greentree Farm in Manhasset, New York until her death in 1998. He was taken in by the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation at that time, and went to live at Miller's farm in January, 2001. "It was just a pure delight to go out every morning and be with him," said Miller. Bowl Game will be buried on the farm. A four-time Grade I winner for Hall of Fame trainer John Gaver Jr., he compiled a record of 23-11-6-5, earning \$907,083.

Quad's Melody (Ire) (Spinning World), in foal to champion juvenile Action This Day (Kris S.), topped Friday's

session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. Bidding on behalf of European-based clients, bloodstock agent Cecil Seaman went to \$450,000 for the talented racemare, sold as hip 1679. Consigned to the sale by Taylor Made Sales as agent, the dark bay, from the first crop of the '97 GI Breed-

ers' Cup Mile hero, made an immediate splash at the races, scoring a debut maiden victory prior to a narrow win in the G3 Prix d'Aumale. The seven-year-old is also a half to three stakes winners, including Bonapartiste (Fr), a Grade II winner in the U.S. and multiple Group 3 placed in France. "I thought she was one of the prettiest mares in the sale today," said Seaman, who operates a company that evaluates horses on a biomechanical basis. "She was a stakes winner at two, she was beautiful and she measured exceptionally well." Seaman has been forced to pick and choose his spots. "[The market] is little bit softer [Friday] than it has been, but the good horses have sold very well. It's still a strong market," he said. Seaman indicated that his clients had not yet decided whether to keep or sell the foal she is carrying. Keeneland November cont. p2-3

mark. "I was getting a bit nervous," he admitted. Ultimately the bidding stopped at \$850,000, a number "right on top" of the reserve, and Nafzger and his partners held onto the daughter of Distorted Humor, a half-sister to GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Street Sense. The decision to retain the Mar. 28 foal was owed to some developments in the days following the race. "We decided to keep her because we sold the broodmare," the conditioner

commented. Nafzger and partners Randy Bloch, Bob Manfuso, John Seiler and Nafzger's wife Wanda struck a deal earlier this week to sell Bedazzle (Dixieland Band), in foal to Speightstown, to Sheikh Mohammed. Nafzger declined to disclose any further details of the deal. The partners purchased the mare for \$180,000 at last year's November sale. "We really wanted to keep her, but we really didn't want to get out of line," he remarked. "Since we sold the mare, we figured we'd like to keep some of the family--that's why we bought her. We wanted a broodmare who would produce racehorses. We just got very fortunate and her first foal was Street Sense." Nafzger gave Randy Bloch's wife, Kathy, and his wife Wanda all the credit for encouraging the team to keep raising the RNA amount. The partnership is very much looking forward to the filly joining the barn of lan Wilkes in 2008. "It was a deal, where, if we possibly could, we'd like to race the horse," Nafzger explained. "She looks a lot like Street Sense did at this time." Owner James Tafel, who sold Bedazzle last year, still retains a female connection to the family. He owns an Elusive Quality yearling halfsister to Street Sense that is currently in training at Ocala Stud in Florida.

Reiding Between the Lines...

Walnut Green's Mark Reid knows a thing or two about Medaglia d'Oro, whose first weanlings have proved popular during the opening week at Keeneland. The striking dark bay, who holds court at Richard and Audrey Haisfield's Stonewall Farm, caught Reid's eye when he was training with David Vance as a two-yearold. Following an allowance win at Oaklawn Park in February 2002, Reid made owner/breeders Albert and Joyce Bell an offer they couldn't refuse on behalf of Edmund Gann, then sent the colt to Bobby Frankel. A Grade I winner at three, four and five and runner-up in the G1 Dubai World Cup, the son of El Prado (Ire) retired to stud with earnings of \$5,754,720. After getting outbid on a few of Medaglia d'Oro's offspring earlier in the sale, the bloodstock agent finally landed one yesterday, going to \$220,000 for hip 1514. Consigned by Three Chimneys, agent, the bay colt was produced by Double Trick (Phone Trick), a stakes-placed winner of \$220,790. Murayama Bloodstock paid \$95,000 to acquire Double Trick carrying this foal in utero at last year's November sale. "He's a very typey-looking colt," Reid said of his purchase. "He's out of an old Maryland family. We loved him physically, he had good vet work and he's a big, strong physical horse like his daddy, so we're taking a shot." Medaglia d'Oro impressed Reid as a racehorse, and he gives the stallion a great shot to succeed in the breeding shed as well. "I think he's going to be good sire," Reid offered. "They're very popular. For a \$40,000 stud fee, I think he's a pretty nice starting-out sire."

Lots to Laugh About...

Taylor Made Sales Agency, consignor of the top four mares Friday, also sent out the top-selling weanling. Hip 1705, a chestnut colt by Mr. Greeley--Saintly Hertfield (Saint Ballado), was hammered down for \$330,000 to the bid of Wright Brothers Bloodstock. The colt's dam preceded her foal into the ring and was purchased by Its Like This Stable for \$330,000. She is a half to Got the Last Laugh (Distorted Humor), dead-heat winner of the GIII Arlington-Washington Breeders' Cup Futurity.

Cup Sprint, will be pointed for a rematch with Sprint winner Thor's Echo in the Nov. 25 GI Frank J. DeFrancis Dash at Laurel Park. The winner of the GII Smile Sprint H., he returned to Calder Sunday. "He came back so nice and happy," trainer Manuel Azpurua said. "It doesn't look like he had a 17-hour van ride. He looks so good." Added owner Ron Borgese, "I would love to get a Grade I for him, so we're going to the DeFrancis Dash. People have been making inquiries about him

as a stallion prospect--[a Grade I win] would surely help him. But the most important thing is that I want him to end up some place nice. He's a great horse and has been good to us. I want to be good to him."

VACATION FOR COTTON BLOSSOM Dogwood Stable's Cotton Blossom (Broken Vow) will get a twomonth vacation following her third-place effort in last Saturday's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. The bay filly got a clean bill of health after a complete medical exam at Rood and Riddle Veterinary Clinic. "Cotton Blossom is absolutely sound and will now be brought to Aiken in the next few days," explained Dogwood President Cot Campbell. "We will turn her out daily and train her every other day, and then send her down to Florida to [trainer] Todd Pletcher around Jan. 15. She will be pointed for the seven-furlong \$150,000 [GII] Forward Gal S. at Gulfstream Park on Mar. 10 and will move on from there to Keeneland and Churchill Downs--with the [GI] Ashland S. and [GI] Kentucky Oaks being prime targets." Cotton Blossom won the GII Schuylerville S. in her second start and was second in the GI Spinaway S. She was fourth in the GII Darley Alcibiades S. before her third-place effort in the Breeders' Cup. "We were proud of her effort in the Breeders' Cup race, especially since she took the overland route on a day that was playing fast on the rail," Campbell added. "She was only beaten 2 3/4 lengths for all the money and indicated to us that she will relish added distances in her three-yearold year." 
