SAINT-CLOUD CONCLUDES GROUP 1 SEASON

Europe's final Group 1 race of the season, today's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud, has attracted its largest field



since Magistros (Fr) beat 14 rivals in 1986. The two-horse home team may be short on quantity, but Spirit One (Fr) (Anabaa Blue {GB}) has the necessary quality to prevent the prize going Spirit One (shadow roll) paris-turf.com abroad for the fourth time in six years. His impres-

sive winning streak was halted when he was outbattled by Mount Nelson (GB) in the Oct. 29 G1 Criterium International over this course, but that encounter will stand the habitual frontrunner in good stead and he holds strong claims for a victory here. Aidan O'Brien saddles both Soldier of Fortune (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and Red Rock Canyon (Ire) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}). Kieren Fallon takes the mount on the former, who improved off a debut second at Gowran Oct. 6 to bag a Navan maiden last time Oct. 17. Fellow Ballydoyle incumbent Red Rock Canyon was a last-out eighth in the Oct. 21 G1 Racing Post Trophy at Newbury. Cont. p6

NAUGHTY BUT NICE

Taking full advantage when yesterday's Red Smith H. at Aqueduct was moved from the turf to the dirt, Naughty New Yorker (Quiet American) went right to the

front, fought off a challenge from 8-5 favorite Angliana (Giant's Causeway) and edged away to win it by 1 3/4 lengths. The race was downgraded to a Grade III after the surface switch, but could have Grade II status reinstated after a review by the Graded Stakes Committee. It was the

first graded score for the four-year-old, who has five New York-bred stakes victories to his credit. The winner of the Aug. 14 Noble Nashua S. and Sept. 13 Gen. Douglas MacArthur H., he was a troubled sixth in the Oct. 21 Empire Classic H. last time out. SPHINX A KEENOV WONDER

Bidding on behalf of George Middleton's Iron County Farms, Lonnie Kirby went to \$425,000 to land Golden Sphinx (Storm Cat), the topper at the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington yesterday. The three-year-old filly, bred by Darley and consigned for Sheikh Mohammed's operation by Brookdale Sales, won her lone trip to the races, breaking her maiden for Eoin Harty at Calder on New Year's Day this year. A full sister to the stakes-placed T S Eliot, she was sold in foal to Elusive Quality. "We're going to take her home, bring her back to Kentucky and foal her out, and breed her to a nice stallion in 2007," said Kirby, the brother of Chicago-based trainer Frank Kirby. "She's a big, goodlooking mare, well-bred and in foal to a nice horse." Middleton, 80, got into the Thoroughbred business in the mid-1980s shortly before selling the 70 Pizza Hut franchises he owned to PepsiCo. He maintains a 650acre farm near Arcadia, Missouri, Iron County Farms raced MGSW Bare Necessities, who was three times placed in Grade I company in California. She retired in 2004 with earnings of \$1,062,251. Cont. p3-5

Darley's Other Offerings Prove Popular...

A trio of horses which at one time raced in Godolphin blue or Darley maroon were the subject of much interest yesterday. Hip 2018, five-year-old Maple Syrple (American Chance), began her career with Team Valor, winning the Clarendon S. at Woodbine before being purchased privately off her runner-up finish to Ashado in the GII Schuylerville S. in 2003. Offered in foal to MGSW E Dubai (Mr. Prospector), the dark bay was purchased for \$320,000 by Bonnie Baskin. Hip 1827, the three-year-old filly Autumnal (Forestry), was sold for \$180,000 to Fred Hertrich III, who signed the ticket in the name of Stealing For A Living Stable. A daughter of GSP Marie J (Mr. Prospector), the full sister to GSP Sisti's Pride is in foal to Cherokee Run. Stoneway Farm was the successful bidder on hip 1805, eight-year-old Zahwah (Rahy). Produced by GSW and GISP Funistrada (Fappiano), the bay did her best running at two, scoring her most important victory in the GIII Arlington-Washington Lassie S. Stoneway, who purchased Zahwah's yearling filly by Monarchos for \$110,000 at Keeneland September, purchased the mare for \$160,000. In addition, Quiet Life (Sunday Silence), an unraced daughter of '96 champion two-year-old filly Storm Song (Summer Squall), was consigned by Mill Ridge for Darley. Cataloged as hip 2076, the three-year-old was purchased by Australia's Vin Cox Bloodstock for \$260,000.

The Wright Stuff...

Signing tickets on behalf of a new pinhooking operation called Wright Brothers Bloodstock, Dromoland Farm's Gerry Dilger paid \$420,000 for a striking chestnut colt from the first crop of 2004 GI Haskell Invitational H. hero Lion Heart (Tale of the Cat). The Jan. 31 foal was consigned by Taylor Made and the agency's Mark Taylor was confident that the colt would be appealing, especially to the Saturday market. "He's a hell of a foal," he commented. "In retrospect, we should probably have had him in Book 2, but around entry time [Aug. 1], we thought he was a solid horse, but we didn't know how good he was going to get. He was a big fish in a small pond and he's by a promising sire. He was a big-time physical standout. It goes to show you that the market puts the emphasis on conformation." Hip 2124 is the first foal produced by Shorewalk Drive (Formal Gold), a winning half-sister to the outstanding sprinter Champali and to MSW Drexel Monorail.

Tap-Top Shape...

Youngsters by Gainesway's Tapit (Pulpit) have performed well at public auction thus far; his six to sell from nine through the ring averaged \$135,333, over nine times his 2005 advertised stud fee of \$15,000. "Tapit was a real talent as a racehorse," stated Gainesway's Michael Hernon. "He's a very good-looking, high-quality horse and he's a stallion with outstanding potential. There's a strong influence of Unbridled in his stock. They have plenty of leg underneath and plenty of stretch." Tapit, winner of the 2004 GI Wood Memorial S., was responsible for two of the top five foals yesterday. Hip 1937, consigned by Warrendale Sales for Runner's Ridge Farm, was purchased by Blandford Stud for \$210,000. The bay colt hails from the family of GISW Scorpion. Hip 1792, was purchased by David Fiske, who also selected Tapit as a yearling. From the immediate family of Unbridled's Song, the bay filly is a daughter of Wednesday's Child (Storm Cat) and was consigned by Gainesway. Hernon added that hip 1792 would likely be returned to either next year's Saratoga yearling sale or would appear in one of the first two books at the 2007 Keeneland September sale.

He returned to run second in the GI Cigar Mile at the end of 2004, and captured the GIII Hal's Hope H. and GII New Orleans H. in 2005. In his only other appearance this term, the dark bay posted a 2 1/2-length tally when making his turf debut in the GII San Gabriel H. in January. "We couldn't be more excited over Badge of Silver's prospects of being a top stallion," Brereton Jones said. "This is a brilliant racehorse who was fast and precocious enough to break his maiden by nine lengths as an April two-year-old, going 4 1/2 furlongs in :51 and change, but was also versatile enough to beat the best going a mile and an eighth, while also running within a head of Aragorn (Ire) in the Breeders' Cup Mile. Add the fact that he is a very good-looking, well-balanced and correct horse with good size and we believe he has all the makings of a top commercial and, most importantly, top-producing sire." A stud fee has not yet been set.

- Most fascinating backstretch character you've met? There are many, but Hash Weinstein stands out because he looks almost the same as he did when I was a kid.
- If you could name a stakes for anybody, who would it be and why? Frank Y. Whiteley, Jr. because he was such a great trainer and is a wonderful gentleman.
- Who do you think is one of the most underrated stallions out there? Any proven older stallion that becomes either less fashionable because of age or suffers declining numbers of stakes winners. I don't subscribe to the popular belief old stallions cannot sire top quality racehorses.
- What was your first job? Hot walker at Belmont and Aqueduct (still have my original license)

Favorite sports team? Atlanta Braves

How would you describe the present state of Thoroughbred racing? There are too many factions and no centralized leadership. I doubt slots will be the long-term solution for the sport. I wish the younger generation could know the sport the way it was in the '60s and early '70s, and more emphasis needs to be placed on marketing racing to them.

The best racehorse you have ever seen? Kelso, because I don't remember any horse performing at his level over so long a period of time.

The fastest racehorse you have ever seen? Mr. Prospector

The best jockey you have ever seen? I would rank them: 1. Arcaro,
2. Baeza, 3. Shoemaker – but Jerry Bailey always knew where to be in a race and is the smartest rider I have seen.

What is the most exciting race you ever won? It would probably be between Rising Award winning by a nose (paying \$99) and Life Cycle (a colt I bought for \$1,400 at Fasig Tipton) setting a new track record in the GI Hollywood Invitational.





There was not any rhyme or reason for him to do it." The colt returned to the track yesterday, but the decision was made to skip the race. "I hated to scratch him, but he's a nice horse and the result you're going to get most of the time when you run a horse after they tie up is that they're not going to get enough oxygen to the muscles," Howard said. "They almost run like they've bled. When you need the horse most at the quarter pole, they'll start slowing down a little bit." He added, "I really do think the long and short of it is that the horse is just maybe tailing off just a little bit. Sometimes they have different ways of telling you. I think this is his way of telling me he needs a little bit of a break, and that's what we're going to do." 
