The last horse through the ring at Keeneland November yesterday, Spring at Last (Silver Deputy) wound up topping the session at \$675,000. J. Paul Reddam signed the ticket for the three-year-old, who is a halfbrother to Sharp Lisa, a Grade I winner in Reddam's colors. Spring at Last, bred by WinStar Farm, carried those silks to an impressive 7 1/2-length allowance victory Saturday at Aqueduct (video) before selling yesterday as hip 3378. He had been trained by Todd Pletcher. Sharp Lisa was consigned by Reddam to the Fasig-Tipton Sale Nov. 5 and topped the auction at \$3.4 million. "WinStar has developed a unique marketing concept whereby they offer quality horses in training at the Keeneland sale rather than sell them privately," said Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "This is the second November Sale in which they've sold racing prospects, and it's proved to be a very successful marketing exercise. This concept was developed in conjunction with [WinStar Racing Manager] Elliott Walden, who suggested that the horses be cataloged on a dark day so trainers could see them." Tuesday's second-highest price was \$225,000 for Aljawza (Riverman), a 15-year-old mare from the consignment of Shadwell Farm and purchased by BBA Ireland. HOLLYWOOD STORY RETIRED

Multiple Grade I-winning millionaire Hollywood Story (Wild Rush--Wife for Life, by Dynaformer) has been

retired from racing and sent to Hill 'n' Dale Farm. The five-year-old has been booked to Storm Cat for 2007. Acquired by George Krikorian for \$130,000 as a yearling at FTKJUL, the dark bay broke her maiden in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. for trainer John Shirreffs. She added a victory in the GII Bayakoa H. at three, the GIII Hawthorne H. as a four-year-old and the GI Vanity Invitational H. this season. Hollywood Story heads to the breeding shed with a record of 27-4-6-6 and earnings of \$1,171,105.

Ross Doyle secured Miltown Park Stud's <u>hip 273</u>, who is out of a sister to two stakes performers, for €55,000. Earlier, Michael Morrin's Pier House Stud, which had been responsible for purchasing one of

the top-priced fillies of the first session, paid \in 48,000 for Sweeney Myles' <u>hip 257</u>, a daughter of Invincible Spirit (Ire) from the family of the 1989 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches winner Pearl Bracelet. Eleanor Kent's Ballyhampshire Stud consigned the top-priced colt of the day when <u>hip 226</u>, a Choisir (Aus) half-brother to this year's GIII Will Rogers S. winner Stratham (Ire), was knocked down to Bluebell Farm for \in 40,000. WEEKEND PEDIGREE PERSPECTIVES by Alan Porter

2006 FRESHMAN SIRES

With a post-Breeders' Cup Iull in major stakes activity, this looked like a good opportunity to take a look at the leading freshman sires. As is appropriate for a "Pedigree Perspective" column, we're going to consider them from a pedigree pattern angle, to look for trends which might be emerging for these horses in particular and for the population as a whole.

Topping the freshman charts is **Street Cry** (Machiavellian--Helen Street, by Troy). Street Cry retired as that potentially very useful asset, a stallion free of his sire's best cross, the Northern Dancer line. In this case, Street Cry is by Machiavellian, a son of Mr. Prospector whose granddam is a half-sister to Northern Dancer and who has a second cross of Northern Dancer's own granddam Almahmoud through Halo. Not surprisingly, Machiavellian worked very well with Northern Dancer, and Street Cry, who is free of Northern Dancer, has already sired GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Street Sense (dam by Dixieland Band) and English Group 3 winner Big Timer (dam by The Minstrel) out of mares by sons of Northern Dancer.

Johannesburg (Hennessy--Myth by Ogygian), who has a double of Northern Dancer through Storm Bird and Nijinsky II and a second dam by Mr. Prospector, is thriving on inbreeding. Second on the list by earnings, he already has six individual stakes winners. His Grade I winner Scat Daddy is out of a mare by Mr. Prospector with a second dam by Nijnsky II. Teuflesberg, who was a very close second to Scat Daddy in the GII Sanford S., has Mr. Prospector and Nijinsky II through the 3/4sisters Yarn and Line, who appear 3x2. His English Group 2 winner Hamoody--out of a mare by Gulch--has Mr. Prospector 4x3, and the Irish Group 3 winner Rabatash (out of a mare by the Northern Dancer-line stallion Marju) has a second dam by Mr. Prospector, so he also has that horse 4x3. It's only going to take a few more major sire prospects like this one and Dixie Union, with Mr. Prospector tucked away in the dam, to finally nail the myth that Mr. Prospector inbreeding is a deleterious factor to performance.

Third on the list by earnings is Officer (Bertrando--St. Helens Shadow, by Septieme Ciel), who represents an extended In Reality/Seattle Slew cross. He is far more of an outcross for a lot of the most fashionable lines than the pair above him. He also has six stakes winners, and three of these are out of mares by sons of Danzig: the speedy New York-bred Chief Officer (dam by Pine Bluff); English stakes winner and group-placed Satulagi (dam by Danzig Connection); and Frisk Her (dam by Honor Grades). The graded-winning Officer Rocket is out of a mare by Gone West, and there is also a stake winners out of a mare by Sefapiano (by Fappiano); this one is also inbred top and bottom of the pedigree to In Reality (which also produced last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies heroine Folklore for Officer's fellow In Reality-via-Relaunch-line horse Tiznow) and Never Tabled (by Never Bend). For what it's worth, Danzig Connection, Honor Grades and Gone West, all bring in one of the half-brothers, Secretariat or Sir Gaylord.

Include (Broad Brush--Illeria, by Stop the Music) has made a bold start for a horse whose pedigree and performances didn't indicate precocity. He has 13 individual winners and three stakes winners, headed by Cash Included, who took the GI Oak Leaf S. A look at her pedigree shows that she has Hail to Reason 4x5x5, and Hail to Reason's sire Turn-to (duplicated close up in Broad Brush's pedigree through two daughters), 5x5x5x6x6. Another stakes winner, Runaway Rosie is out of a mare by South American-bred Siphon (inbred to South American strains, but an outcross for anything Northern Hemisphere), but does have a double of Nijinsky II, along with Blushing Groom, a strain which is usually good with Nijinsky II. Include has the excellent mare Hidden Talent 4x5, and his third stakes winner Sul Lago picks up on this as her dam is by American Standard (half-brother to Baldski, sire of Include's second dam, giving two crosses of Two Bald, and three of her dam Hidden Talent). Incidentally, Mr. Prospector also shows up in the pedigree of all three of Include's stakes winners.

Considering he didn't win a race a two, one has to be impressed by the start made by champion sprinter **Orientate** (Mt. Livermore--Dream Team, by Cox's Ridge). He has 16 winners and six stakes horses, headed by the GIII Tempted S. victress Successful Outlook. She is out of a mare by Gulch, but her second dam is by Mt. Livermore's sire Blushing Groom, so that horse appears 3x3 at the top and bottom of the pedigree. For good measure, Nijinsky II--aforementioned as simpatico for Blushing Groom, is also in the pedigree. **Cont. p5**

Below the top five, we're just going to pick on a few examples of interesting pedigrees which have helped get their sires started. **E Dubai** (Mr. Prospector--Words of War, by Lord At War) has multiple stakes winner Barilko (dam by Greinton, by Green Dancer) bred on an orthodox Mr. Prospector/Nijinsky II cross (and also going back to a mare bred on the Nasrullah/Princequillo cross, which should be good for E Dubai). E Dubai also has a stakes winner out of a mare by Timeless Moment and a stakes-placed horse out of a mare by Timeless Moment's son, Gilded Time, underlining how Timeless Moment's distaff side continues to make him a good foil for Mr. Prospector (Timeless Moment has Native Dancer, Count Fleet and Bull Dog, all names prominent in the pedigree of Mr. Prospector).

Storm Cat's son Pure Prize (Storm Cat--Heavenly Prize, by Seeking the Gold), is a Storm Cat/Mr. Prospector cross and already has had success with Mr. Prospector in his offspring. He has two stakes winners out of Mr. Prospector-line mares with dams by Marguetry (a useful lower level broodmare sire, and a good cross for Storm Cat) and Crafty Prospector. As with Galileo in Europe, it's beginning to look as if stallions out mares by sons of Mr. Prospector can safely be bred back over the Mr. Prospector line. Pure Prize also has the cleverly bred Birdbirdistheword, whose dam is by a son of Alydar (genetic relative to Mr. Prospector) with a second dam by a grandson of Nijinsky II, genetic relative to Storm Bird). This means the dam is a reverse cross to Pure Prize (both Raise a Native and Northern Dancer strains coming through genetic relatives) and a parallel Raise a Native/Nijinsky II cross to Pure Prize's dam Heavenly Prize.

The good Florida-based sprinter **Snow Ridge** (Tabasco Cat--Snow Forest, by Woodman), has benefited from an old stalwart, an accumulation of La Troienne genetic relatives. Snow Ridge's broodmare sire Woodman is out of a mare who has the La Troienne family 3/4-sisters Busanda and Striking 2x3. His stakes winner Snow Lady is out of a mare by Digression, a son of Seattle Slew (dam inbred 3x3 to La Troienne family sisters Busher and Striking) out of a mare by The Axe II (granddam out of La Troienne and a sister to the dam of Busanda).

Littleexpectations (Valid Appeal--Mepache, by Iron Constitution) earned a ticket from Texas to Kentucky with King of the Roxy's win in the GII Futurity S. This is more a 'nick' horse than a pedigree pattern one, as the mating was chosen to emulate the proven In Reality/Bold Forbes cross. Canada's **Cat's At Home** (Tabasco Cat--Homewrecker, by Buckaroo), has stakes winner Spread the News. This one has Storm Cat (Northern Dancer/Bold Ruler cross) in the third generation in the sire line, and Sovereign Dancer (Northern Dancer/Bold Ruler cross) in the third generation as sire of a mare in the direct female line.

While this is far from a scientific study, looking at the above, our intuitive feeling is that clever inbreeding and linebreeding--particularly to and through genetic relatives--is having a more than coincidental impact on the start made by the freshman stallions.



Barbaro Update

BARBARO DOING WELL AFTER CAST REMOVAL

KENNETT SQUARE, PA... Kentucky Derby winner Barbaro continues to improve following the removal of his right hind leg cast last week, according to his medical team. "Barbaro's strength on the right hind limb has been gradually improving," said Dr. Dean W. Richardson, Chief of Surgery. "It is normal to be a bit stiff and weak after being in a cast for a long time; however, he is capable of bearing full weight on the previously fractured right hind leg even without the supporting soft bandage." Barbaro's lower right hind leg had been in a cast since surgery at Penn's George D. Widener Hospital following his accident at the Preakness May 20. Barbaro's left hind foot, which had laminitis, continues to improve. "The left hind foot continues to slowly grow, but still has a very long way to go," said Dr. Richardson. "Barbaro's attitude and appetite remain excellent, and he still takes short walks outside to graze each day if the weather permits." The next update will be posted on Tuesday, Nov. 28, unless there is a significant change in Barbaro's condition.




FIRST SLOTS PARLOR OPENS AT POCONO

Mohegan Sun at Pocono Downs became the first track in the state of Pennsylvania to open a racino yesterday. Following \$70 million in renovations, the racino currently occupies 90,000 squarefeet, with over 1,000 slot machines available to patrons. The second phase of expansion, scheduled for next year, will see the construction of a 400,000 square-foot racino that will include over 2,000 machines. Gambling regulators awarded conditional slots licenses to Mohegan Sun and five other horse racing tracks earlier this fall. It expects to award as many as six more licenses--one to an established resort and five to standalone slots parlors--in December. The state plans to use gambling revenues to cut taxes for homeowners and workers who pay Philadelphia's wage tax, fatten horse racing purses, and support a rent rebate program for senior citizens. The Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board gave Mohegan Sun-who paid \$280 million for Pocono Downs in 2004permission to open after successful dry runs on Friday and Sunday nights. The test nights, which featured an invitation-only crowd of gamblers, brought in a total of \$95,049. Of that amount, 34 percent--or \$32,317--was earmarked for property-tax relief, as prescribed by state law.


