BIG A MOVES WEEKEND RACES TO INNER

Officials at the New York Racing Association decided yesterday to close Aqueduct's main track for racing and training from today through Monday, Nov. 20, with the main track re-opening for training Tuesday, Nov. 21. Racing will be held on the winterized inner surface in the interim. Racing will return to the main track Wednesday for a final week before Aqueduct's regularly scheduled inner-track season begins Wednesday, Nov. 29. "After discussions with our trainers and jockeys and our director of racing surfaces, it was decided that this was the best course of action to give the main track a chance to recover from the effects of recent adverse weather," said Bill Nader, NYRA senior vice-president and COO. "There is a forecast for heavy rain [Thursday night] and into morning, and we want to do all that we can to make sure the main track is ready for next week's HolidayFest program." The HolidayFest program is highlighted by the GI Cigar Mile on Saturday, Nov. 25. Today's races that were carded at 6 1/2 and seven furlongs--the fifth, sixth and seventh--will be run at six furlongs. All other races will be run at their original distances.
