### **NOVEMBER SOARS ON AT GOFFS**

Following the resounding success of the five days of foals at Goffs November, the momentum was maintained as the action switched to broodmares and fillies yesterday. Twelve months on from the €1-million paid for one of His Highness the Aga Khan's finest broodmares Dalara (Ire), it was the same breeder's draft

that generated the session's highest price when Anthony Stroud paid €430,000 for Alasana (Ire), consigned as hip 1363. Despite the daughter of Darshaan (GB) being in her advancing years at 15, she had produced the 2002 G1 2000 Guineas third and GI E.P. Taylor S. runner-up Alasha (Ire). From

the family of Desert Story (Ire) and this year's G3 Mooresbidge S. winner Alayan (Ire), she is carrying a foal by Sinndar (Ire). "She is from a wonderful family," Stroud said. "She has been bought for an established client in Ireland and will stay here." As a measure of the phenomenal success of this auction, the session average of €51,132 represented an increase of more than 19 percent on last year's equivalent, which included a €1-million mare and had itself risen by a massive 93 percent on 2004. The median, which was up by 85 percent last year, rose again by 37.5 percent yesterday. Selling continues tomorrow at 9:30 a.m., the final day of the marathon November sale. Belgravia (Mr. Greeley), a \$2-million purchase out of the Fasig-Tipton Calder Sale of Selected Two-Year-Olds in Training this past February, remained perfect in his young career, sweeping four wide into the stretch before hanging on for a nose victory over Dilemma (Grand Slam) in yesterday's GIII Hollywood Prevue S. on the Cushion track. "When that other horse [Dilemma] came up to him he really dug in and took off again," said winning jockey Julien Leparoux. "He has speed, but he seems like he really wants to go on." Cont. p2

### No Stranger to the Twin Spires...

After wintering in Florida, Precious Kitten made four starts at the Churchill spring meeting, finishing second in a turf maiden May 10 before graduating in an off-theturf affair May 25. A 60-1 chance when third in the GIII Regret S. back on the Matt Winn turf course June 17, she was second in the July 16 Heavenly Cause H., then shifted to Ellis Park, where she was fifth in the Aug. 12 Audubon Oaks. Rested a bit off that effort, she earned her first stakes victory in the Sept. 30 Martha Washington Breeders' Cup S., decisioning Meribel (Peaks and Valleys) by a neck, but fell a half-length short of that rival in the GIII Valley View S., scheduled for the Keeneland turf, but rained onto the Polytrack Oct. 20. Jockey Rafael Bejarano was impressed with the winner's effort. "I saw at the eighth pole that [J'ray] was coming from behind really strong, but I had a lot of horse and I saved a little bit," he said. "When that horse came to her, she [Precious Kitten] came again. She ran a good race."

Belgravia was no secret when he finally made his debut over the Polytrack at Keeneland Oct. 18, the chestnut still had about three lengths to find leaving the eighth pole, but found another gear late and got to the line 1 3/4 lengths to the good as the 6-5 chalk. Sent off as part of an entry which was the second choice to bigfigure maiden winner Notional (In Excess {Ire}), Belgravia was away well and took up a position at the tail end of the peloton, some four lengths from the front. Notional took the initiative and had first run into the stretch, but Julien Leparoux angled Belgravia out and went easily by the chalk. However, the real threat in the race would come from Dilemma, who was just hitting his best stride passing the eighth pole. As Belgravia drifted out under a left-handed stick, Dilemma sustained his bid nicely, but fell just short.

Daiwa Major was beaten a nose in last year's renewal by Hat Trick, but arrives in top form in his attempt to go one better. The morning-line favorite was fourth to Deep Impact (Jpn) in this track's G1 Takarazuka Kinen June 25, but returned from a spell to best Dance in the Mood by a neck in the Mainichi Okan Oct. 8. The fiveyear-old made it two straight with a half-length score in the Oct. 29 Tenno Sho (Autumn) last time out and is worthy of favoritism. Dance in the Mood could hardly have been more impressive in winning the GIII CashCall Mile at Hollywood July 1 and comes into this off a sixth in the Tenno Sho. Court Masterpiece has been a model of consistency this season with a win, a second and two third-place efforts against Group 1 company in Europe. The G1 Sussex S. winner will try to atone for his third in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. Sept. 23. "It's been two weeks since I saw him last, but he looks in good shape and looks very happy," said trainer Ed Dunlop.

Hip 1387 is the six-year-old Storm Cat mare Nellie Nolan, who was listed placed at two and is out of a sister to the topclass Caline. Carrying a close relation to her sire sibling Raphane, she was secured for €280,000. Dennis O'Flynn's Old Carhue Stud had been responsible for the purchase of some of the session's highlights, including two high-profile mares by Spectrum (Ire). The first was Abbeville & Meadowcourt Studs' five-year-old Sidecar (Ire), a half to last year's GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. victress and G1 Irish 1000 Guineas third Luas Line (Ire), consigned as hip 1302. She is in foal to Danehill Dancer (Ire) and was knocked down to the Coachfordbased operation for €275,000. Shortly after, they landed hip 1314, the seven-year-old Corrine (Ire), who is out of a sister to the sire Bellypha (Ire). Consigned by Seskin Stud as agents, the listed winner had been responsible for a Galileo (Ire) foal sold to Camas Park Stud for €255,000 just 24 hours earlier. Carrying a full sibling after a return visit to the Coolmore hotshot, she reached €225,000. Towards the end of the day's trading, Adali Humkar paid €180,000 for hip 1392, the five-year-old Starline (Ire) in foal to Montjeu (Ire). The daughter of Trempolino is a half to two German listed winners, as well as the dam of the smart stakes sprinter Shinko's Best (Ire). As usual, Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Derrinstown Stud draft proved popular and it was hip 1280, the Nashwan mare Mubkera (Ire), who attracted the most attention. Carrying to Marju (Ire), the stakes-placed seven-year-old from the outstanding family of Rainbow Quest and the giltedged broodmare Slightly Dangerous was knocked down to BBA Ireland's John Tyrrell for €175,000.

## YOUBET HAILS DECISION IN TVG ARBITRATION FIGHT

Youbet.com Inc. must pay about \$1.3 million to its license partner TVG for underpayments during a three-year content agreement that ended Mar. 31, 2005, an arbiter ruled Nov. 16. TVG initially claimed it was owed \$5.8 million. The arbitration figure included damages, reimbursement and interest, according to TVG. The ruling separately included \$90,000 that TVG must pay to Youbet, which said TVG was cited for violating the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. TVG called it a payment for "short swing profits" that occurred in March 2004 when TVG surrendered a pre-existing warrant for shares of Youbet in a transaction between the parties. Charles F. Champion, Youbet CEO, hailed the arbitration decision, saying it affirmed his company's understanding of key provisions regarding host, license and transaction fees. "From the onset, we had an obligation to defend ourselves against TVG's claims, and the non-financial claims were potentially more damaging to our ongoing value than the monetary claims," he said. "At the same time, we had a series of important business principles to assert, and we were successful." For the complete story, click here.



HONG KONG'S BEST IN HKIR TRIALS A week ago, Hello Pretty (Aus) (Distorted Humor) stamped himself a leading local hope for the G1 Hong Kong Cup with a victory in the Cup Trial at Sha Tin. Today's program features the final prep races for the G1 Hong Kong Mile and G1 Hong Kong Sprint. The Mile Trial has attracted every top miler in the SAR, but the horse that will garner the most attention is Vengeance of Rain (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}). Last year's G1 Hong Kong Cup winner and World Series Racing Champion returned from an 11-month absence and was 10th in the HSBC Premier Bowl H., but finished well to hit the line five lengths behind the winner. Today's 1600 meters is well short of his best, but trainer David Ferraris is confident the prep will have the six-year-old primed for a title defense in the Cup. Among the competition is former Hong Kong Horse of the Year Bullish Luck (Royal Academy) and rising star Floral Pegasus (Aus) (Fusaichi Pegasus). The Sprint Trial is a wide open affair in which Scintillation (Aus) (Danehill) could start a lukewarm choice. Fourth by a length in the 2004 Hong Kong Mile, he has excelled at shorter distances, but is having his first run since finishing second in a domestic Group 1 last March. Silent Witness (Aus) (El Moxie), a two-time winner of the Hong Kong Sprint, gets a five-pound pull in the weights and has trained well for this. As he has aged, however, the 1000 meters has become too sharp and that is likely to be the case again this afternoon. The International Races are set for Sunday, Dec. 10.
