RECORD FALLS AT DEAUVILLE

Hot on the heels of the world record set at Tattersalls this week, Arqana's December Sale enjoyed its own slice of the limelight yesterday at Deauville when a sale

named champion three-year-old filly at the Cartier Awards. Consigned by Eric Puerari's Haras des Capucines as hip 82, she sold in foal to the Turkish stallion Dinveper (GB). Her sale price represented a seismic shift from the bargain €16,000 she brought here two years ago. Tada, who had set another record when paving \$2.7 million for a half brother to Electrocutionist at Keeneland November, said that the half to 2000 GI Turf Classic and GI Manhattan H. winner Manndar (Ire) had been bought for an undisclosed Japanese client. "She obviously has a great pedigree and has proved herself capable of producing a top-class horse, and that's what we were looking for," Tada said. "The plan was to come here to buy her, and there are no other plans. I don't know at this time whether she will be staying here or whether she will be exported to Japan." Argana sale cont. p5-6



Shortly after Mandalara (Ire) made her sales-record appearance at Argana's December Sale, six-year-old Mabalane (Ire) (Danehill) brought €520,000 for Lady O'Reilly's Haras de la Louviere. Catalogued as hip 91, she boasted a page highlighted by Miesque, her son Kingmambo and high-class relatives including last year's G1 Moyglare Stud S. and G1 Prix Marcel Boussac heroine Rumplestiltskin (Ire) and the brilliant Six Perfections (Fr). Ghislain Bozo's Meridian International was the name on the docket for the 3/4-sister to listed winner Nid d'Abeilles (Ire). Mabalane is in foal to Muhtathir (GB). Frederic Sauque, keen to purchase the cream of the Darley draft, made a trio of high-profile buys. Leading the three was hip 65, the listed-placed sophomore Flow Chart (UAE) (Jade Robbery), who made \in 420,000. She is out of 1991 G1 Prix Ganay and G1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis winner Kartajana (Ire), from the family of last year's G1 Prix Jean Prat winner Turtle Bowl (Ire) and 2002 G2 Prix d'Astarte scorer Turtle Bow (Fr). Saugue also secured hip 170, the impeccably bred three-year-old Huaca (Thunder Gulch), who is out of a group-placed sister to 1998 G1 St Leger winner Nedawi (GB). The bloodstock agent had to go to \in 240,000 to secure that filly, whose third dam is the great Dahlia. Saugue earlier paid \in 200,000 for hip 148, the five-year-old **Shooting Lodge (Ire)** (Grand Lodge), who is in foal to Cadeaux Genereux (GB). She is a half to the dam of Sinndar (Ire). His Highness the Aga Khan's draft included acquisitions from the late Jean-Luc Lagardere's empire. The consignment was headed by hip 166, three-year-old Vadazing (Fr) (Spinning World). The half to last year's G1 Prix Saint-Alary winner Vadawina (Ire), from the esteemed family of Valixir (Ire), Val Royal (Fr) and Vahorimix (Fr), was knocked down to Marc-Antoine Bergracht's MAB Agency for €360,000. expected to come before the commission in January. Both horses have been disqualified and the purse money has been ordered to be redistributed. No action can be taken, however, while the case is in appeal. Norman was fined \$1,000 for the first offense and the suspension for the second covers the period from Nov. 29 through May 29, 2007.
