OUIJA BOARD RETIRED

Globetrotting star **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire} --Selection Board {GB}, by Welsh Pageant {Fr}) exhibited soreness in her left front leg yesterday and was



withdrawn from today's G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Vase. The 2400meter race, in which the five-year-old would have been favored to defend her title, was to have been her final career start, and she has been retired. "She was only going out

morning and she came back and just didn't look quite right, and so we thought we would have a closer look at things," owner Lord Derby told *Racing Post*. Trainer Ed Dunlop added, "We x-rayed the leg and the damage was unremarkable, but she has jarred herself either on the dirt or the grass, and we decided that enough was enough." Dunlop said the injury was the same left front splint bone problem which sidelined Ouija Board during the summer of 2005. Booked to Lane's End stallion Kingmambo in 2007, the popular mare may head back to Britain first in order to have her injury monitored before heading to Kentucky. **Cont. p3**

CLASH OF THE TITANS IN CUP

The International Races meeting culminates with the G1 Hong Kong Cup, featuring a pair of former champions and two of the best turf mares in the world. Vengeance of Rain (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) seeks to double up on his victory over Pride (Fr) (Peintre Celebre) a year ago and has been prepared meticulously by trainer David Ferraris. After having his 2005/2006 campaign curtailed by a heart condition and subsequent spell at Cambridge Stud in New Zealand, the rugged six-yearold enters this off a close fifth to Mile favorite Armada (NZ) in the International Mile Trial Nov. 19. "From gate two he will get a nice position with cover and I probably won't have him further back than second or third," said jockey Anthony Delpech. "He can go on from the 700-meter mark and he will be pretty hard to get past." Cont. p4

Placed in fifth by Garrett Gomez as **Symphony Sid** (Unbridled) set an uncontested lead through :24.25 and :47.37 fractions, Boboman came charging down the lane to take the lead in deep stretch and crossed the line in stakes-record time. "When he won [his last race] I said right there that this is what I would try next," trainer Richard Mandella said. "I wasn't sure I could beat these kind of horses, but I wanted to give it a try. They were just galloping along, and once Garrett kind of got him talked into it, you could see him kind of moving along pretty good." **Cont. p2**

Boboman began his career with three off-the-board finishes in France, but finally broke through at Longchamp in his fourth and final start of his two-yearold campaign, scoring by 3/4 of a length in October 2003. Freshened following that effort, the bay resurfaced in March 2004 at Santa Anita with an eighthplace finish in an \$80,000 optional claimer. Out for the entire 2005 season, the Wertheimer & Frere homebred returned at Del Mar this summer with consecutive thirdplace finishes July 30 and Aug. 28. Favored at 4-5 in an Oak Tree allowance test Oct. 7, Boboman delivered a 4 3/4-length tally and followed with an \$80,000 optional claiming score over this course last time Nov. 2.





Magna Graduate concluded his sophomore campaign with three straight tallies, including the GIII Discovery H. on the Breeders' Cup undercard at Belmont Park and the GII Clark H. at Churchill in November. The dark bay began 2006 with a well-beaten fourth in the GI Donn H. Feb. 4 and repeated that performance in the \$6-million G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 25. He was later moved up to third following Brass Hat's disgualification from second for a medication positive. Magna Graduate resurfaced with a 10th-place finish as the 5-2 choice in the Nov. 4 GIII Ack Ack H. after missing most of the year with an ankle injury. Favored by the Big A faithful to get back on track here, the Elisabeth Alexander colorbearer was hustled to the lead by John Velazquez and never looked back. "Generally, he's not a front-runner, but in this scenario, he found himself there," trainer Todd Pletcher commented. "We'll take him down to Florida and see what's next." Ouija Board Scratched From Vase, Retired cont. *A Magical Career...*

The Hong Kong Vase was to have brought the curtain down on Ouija Board's extraordinary career, which spanned three seasons at the highest level. Lord Derby's homebred, beaten a length when third in her debut at two, graduated as the even-money favorite in her second outing at Yarmouth in October 2003. The Racing Post commentary of that novice race concluded that the Cape Cross filly "looks sure to win in decent company next year." A true understatement, even if she ended her juvenile campaign with a third in the Listed Montrose Fillies S. Her three-year-old season began with a six-length success in the Listed Pretty Polly S., which preceded a seven-length coronation in the G1 Oaks S. at Epsom a month later. She duly added the G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh in July and made her next start in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in October, when she had a troubled trip, but managed to be third by 1 1/2 lengths to Bago (Fr). Sent to Lone Star for the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf, the three-year-old defeated six Grade I winners and earned herself an Eclipse Award as U.S. champion turf female as well as the Cartier Horse of the Year honor. Ouija Board began 2005 with a distant seventh in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at the Royal meeting, but emerged with a splint injury and missed the rest of the summer. She returned to capture the G3 Princess Royal S. in September before traveling once again for the Breeders' Cup at Belmont, where she ran second to champion Intercontinental (GB) in the F/M Turf. She followed that with a close fifth in the G1 Japan Cup in Tokyo before concluding 2005 with a victory in the G1 Hong Kong Vase in December. Sportingly kept in training this year at five, the dark bay began 2006 with a fourth in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba in March, then missed by less than a half-length when third in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin the following month. She returned to England for the G1 Coronation Cup June 2 and wound up second to Shirocco (Ger), but found her way back to the winner's enclosure with a popular victory in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot three weeks later.

Fifth in the G1 Coral-Eclipse S. July 8, Ouija Board emerged as the winner in a thrilling battle with Alexander Goldrun (Ire) in the G1 Nassau S. at Glorious Good-



wood Aug. 5 before succumbing late to Dylan Thomas (Ire) in the G1 Irish Champion S. Sept. 9 at Leopardstown. She then earned her second Breeders' Cup title in the F/M Turf before heading to Japan, where she ran a gallant third to Deep Impact (Jpn) in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 26 in what would be her final trip postward.

Armada will fly the flag for Hong Kong in a competitive renewal of the Mile. Unbeaten in his first six starts, the chestnut missed by 1 1/2 lengths when fourth in the 1200-meter G3-HK HSBC Bowl Oct. 29, but rebounded to take the G2-HK CX Mile Trial Nov. 19 over course and distance. "He has done very well since his last run, but this is still a real rise in class," said trainer John Size. "His Mile Trial win was very good, but it's fair to say he probably has to improve again on that performance to win this. I'm very happy to have him in the race and hopefully he is still heading upwards--but this is his biggest task." DANEHILL COLT SETS RECORD AT HK SALE

Widely expected to be the topper before setting foot in the ring of yesterday's Hong Kong International Sale, a

two-year-old Danehill colt sold for HK\$7,500,000, the highest price ever at the auction. The previous record was HK\$6 million. Cheng Keung Fai purchased the handsome bay, lot 15, produced by the Secretariat mare Sister Dot. A halfbrother to champion

Dehere, the Irish-bred colt was the final Danehill juvenile to be sold at public auction; he was purchased as a vearling by the Hong Kong Jockey Club for €360,000 at the 2005 Goffs Orby Million Sale. The second-highest price at yesterday's sale was HK\$4,400,000 for lot 30, a gelding by More Than Ready. Bought by industrialist Sui Pak Kwan, he will be trained by David Ferraris, who said, "I have the only other son of More Than Ready in Hong Kong, and like this horse and sire very much." Foaled in Australia, the son of Dainty Dancer (Aus) (Al Hareb) was acquired by the Hong Kong Jockey Club for NZ\$120,000 at the New Zealand Bloodstock Premier Yearling Sale. In all, 28 lots sold for HK\$81,200,000, leading to a 63-percent increase in average to HK\$2,900,000. "It was not a bargain sale, but Thoroughbreds worldwide have become more expensive and, combined with the currency weakness here and other factors, it was in line with overall trends," said Winfred Engelbrecht-Bresges, HKJC's executive director of racing. "We are considering the idea of some races confined to horses from our sale so that we can show our support for the enthusiasm of the purchasers." 
