One of just two eight-year-olds to take their chance on the day, **Collier Hill (GB)** (Dr Devious {Ire}) proved yet again that age has not yet caught up with him, finding the line just ahead of His Highness The Aga Khan's **Kastoria (Ire)** (Selkirk) in yesterday's G1 Hong

Kong Vase. Having been purchased for £5,500 as a cast-off to win a bumper at Catterick early in his career, and subsequently sent for a spell over hurdles, the gelding has undergone a fairy-tale metamorphosis and now sports earnings approaching \$4 million. As it turns out, he

was lucky to make the gate yesterday. "He was a bit dehydrated on Thursday and for a time it was touch and go whether we would run, and it was only [Saturday] that he came right again," trainer Alan Swinback commented. "We have always had trouble with his joints and now we can look after them when he gets home. He deserves a break now, doesn't he?" **HK Vase cont. p3**

TAKEOVER TARGET SCRATCHED

Takeover Target (Aus) (Celtic Swing {GB}), the ante-post favorite for the G1 Hong Kong Sprint, was scratched from the race by Hong Kong Jockey Club stewards after a final blood sample produced yet another positive result for a banned substance. Since his arrival in Hong Kong in late October, the seven-year-old was tested no fewer than six times and on each occasion, the results came back positive for 17-alpha-hydroxyprogesterone hexanoate, a banned substance. Trainer Joe Janiak was advised at 12:25 p.m. yesterday of the results and the decision of the stewards to compulsorily withdraw Takeover Target from the race.

Runner-up by a neck in last year's Cup, **Pride** was in need of the run when just fourth in the G1 Prix Ganay Apr. 30. Following an easy victory in the G2 Prix Corrida a month later, she rediscovered her best form, tagging Hurricane Run (Ire) with a head defeat in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud June 25. Rested for a fall campaign, she prepped for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe with a close third to Shirocco (Ger) in the G2 Prix Foy Sept. 10 before going down by a neck in the Longchamp centerpiece Oct. 1 while giving weight to the winner, Rail Link (GB). She atoned for that disappointment by registering a three-length victory in the G1 Champion S. Oct. 14, setting her up for her career swansong.

Revenge is Sweet...

Pride broke well, but came back nicely to jockey Christophe-Patrice Lemaire, who settled the mare last out of the stretch, but allowed her to creep forward midway up the backstretch. The field began to bunch up as the front-runners began to lose steam and they lined up five across the track at the quarter pole as the table was set for a dramatic finish. Vengeance of Rain was the first to come calling, and had the call in upper stretch, but he may have gone too soon, as Pride easily reeled him in and looked well on her way to the win. But **Admire Moon**, third to Daiwa Major (Jpn) in the Tenno Sho (Autumn) Oct. 29, came with a cracking run and was taking ground from the winner with each stride, but the wire came one jump too soon. "She has a great turn of foot, but her run is quite short so she was stopping a bit for me at the end and I was frightened we might get caught," Lemaire admitted. Third in the 2004 running and second last year, The Duke proved third-time lucky, sitting a perfect trip from the box seat before holding off Armada. A graduate of the 2001 Hong Kong International Sale, the seven-year-old ventured overseas for the first time last June, but could do no better than 15th, beaten over nine lengths, to Bullish Luck (Royal Academy) in the G1 Yasuda

Kinen in Tokyo. The gelding resurfaced with a seventh in the G3-HK National Day Cup H. over an insufficient 1200 meters Oct. 1, but returned on two weeks' rest to fill the runner-up spot in the 1600-meter G3-HK Sha Tin Trophy H. In his most recent appearance, the Caspar Fownes trainee

hooked up with the best of the local milers in the G2-HK International Mile Trial Nov. 19 and again acquitted himself well, running Armada to 3/4 of a length in second. Ramonti, winner two back of the G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua over the mile at San Siro, sprung the gates and covered the opening 800 meters in a strong :47 while being tracked by local speedball Sir Ernesto (Aus) (Danehill). The Duke, who landed on the rails and just behind the speed, enjoyed the run of the race and switched outside the Italian raider at the quarter pole. He struck the front shortly thereafter, but still had to deal with Armada, who settled in midpack and commenced his rally beneath Douglas Whyte at the 300-meter mark. He came with his patented flying finish, but the wire got there first and The Duke had his richly deserved first Group 1 win. "Although he is a seven-year-old, he is in the form of his life. He has been placed in this race before and it is great he has finally won it," Fownes said. "It's my first Group 1 win and it's very special." Winner of the 2005 G1 Irish St Leger, Collier Hill was second to Heart's Cry (Jpn) in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, but registered his first win since his Curragh success in the G3 Stockholm Cup at Taby Sept. 10. The globetrotter took in the G1 Canadian International S. Oct. 22 and dueled the length of the stretch before getting his nose down on the wire. The chestnut landed in fourth as Japanese St Leger hero Admire Main (Sunday Silence) took them along at a strong clip. Under urging fully six furlongs from home, Collier Hill called on his staying ability and took command in upper stretch. He began to labor late and was nearly collared by a dreadfully unlucky Kastoria, who was shuffled back to last inside the final quarter mile and closed furiously only to fail by the narrowest of margins.

Saint Stephen, off since winning the Henry Clark S. over the Pimlico turf in April, was winless in his only two main-track appearances but was trying an all-weather track for the first time. The bay settled into fourth as favored Ball Four (Grand Slam) and Flamethrowintexan (Way West {Fr}) battled on the front end through quick early fractions. As the pacesetters tired down the lane, Saint Stephen and Southern Africa closed powerfully, with the former running best for an authoritative victory. "Those two were kind of zig-zagging up front," explained jockey Garrett Gomez, winning his fourth race on the card. "They were playing and hedging with each other, so I wasn't necessarily too worried about them. I took a peak at them around the five-sixteenths pole, exactly how much ground I had to make up on them, and I still felt real confident. My only concern were the two horses, one was just in front of me, I think it was Martin [Pedroza aboard Don Incauto (Arg)], and there was one horse behind me I was concerned about [Southern Africa] who was making his run. But my horse ran a really good race." Gomez swept Hollywood's weekend stakes after winning yesterday's GI Hollywood Turf Cup.
