SCOTTY SCHULHOFER PASSES AWAY

Hall of Fame trainer Flint "Scotty" Schulhofer died Thursday night in a South Florida hospital following a bout with cancer. He was 80 years old. Schulhofer trained six champions, including 1990 champion two-

year-old Fly So Free, 1992 champion sprinter Rubiano and 2000 champion older horse Lemon Drop Kid. The former steeplechase jockey began his training career in 1962 and retired in 2001 with 1,119 victories from 7,157 starters. His horses earned more than \$52 million on the racetrack. He was inducted into the Thoroughbred

Racing Hall of Fame in 1992. Jockey Jose Santos was the regular rider of Fly So Free and Rubiano, as well as Lemon Drop Kid during his sophomore season. "It definitely hurts," Santos said of Schulhofer's passing. "I had a great relationship with Scotty when I came to New York in 1985. He put me on a lot of winners. He had a heart of gold and he was a great horseman. He always spoke the truth and always told you in black and white what was going on. My condolences go to his family." Schulhofer is survived by his wife Stephanie; daughters Margaret and Susan; and son and former trainer Randy. A funeral service is scheduled for Monday morning at Shellhouse Funeral Home in Aiken, South Carolina.


