Sent off at juicy odds of 15-1, California-bred **Romance is Diane** (In Excess {Ire}) showed that she belonged in Grade I company with a professional score in yesterday's GI Hollywood Starlet S. at Hollywood Park. Never far off crisp opening splits of :22.43 and :45.47 carved out by the blazing duo **Tizthen** (Tiznow) and **Super Freaky** (Smart Strike), the attractive bay overtook the wilting leaders approaching the final turn, increased her advantage to two at the head of the lane and had enough left in the tank to hold off the closing pair **Quick Little Miss** (Fred) and **Down** (Mr. Greeley). "That's the position I wanted to be in, second or

third, going into the first turn," said winning rider David Flores, who was winning his fifth race on the card. "From there, I was just controlling the race and my own horse. She was very professional, and when I asked her to go, she still had plenty left in the tank." **Cont. p2**

KING OF THE HILL

Bishop Court Hill (Holy Bull), who last visited the winner's circle after a win in the GI Carter H. in April, renewed his love affair with the Big 'A' during an impressive victory in yesterday's GIII Gravesend H. Sharp out of the blocks, the six-year-old held a comfortable advantage over 8-5 choice **Will He Shine** (Silver Deputy) through the opening quarter mile in :22.18 and a half in :44.46 and extended his lead to two lengths with an eighth of a mile left to negotiate. While Will He Shine began to weaken in the stretch, the Todd Pletcher-trained gelding remained strong, and had enough to fend off closer **Santana Strings** (Wheaton) at the wire. "I can't believe how fast he broke," said winning jockey John Velazquez. "He's the kind of horse that doesn't like the stick, so I was very happy that he was clear the whole way. It was a big effort. When he shows up, he's very tough to run down." **Cont. p2**

to Mike Mitchell's barn by owner Senji Nishimura, the filly responded with a solid two-length score going a mile against fellow Cal-breds at Santa Anita Oct. 6 and made it two straight for Mitchell with another professional victory in the Cal Cup Juvenile Fillies, trying an additional sixteenth of a mile over that track Oct. 28. "She trained really well going into this race," said

Down But Not Out..

Down (Mr. Greeley), a nose back in second in her debut at Belmont Oct. 22, looked to be good value at 8-1 on the morning line, but by the time the juvenile fillies filed into the paddock, the Maryland-bred had opened as the piping hot 3-2 favorite. Drifting up to 3-1 by the time the gate opened, the grey was caught flat-footed at the start and had to settle at the back of the pack, over 20 lengths off a saucy early pace. Still last of 12 after three quarters of a mile, the filly kicked it up a notch--while racing six wide--turning for home and battled alongside the equally-game **Quick Little Miss** (Freud) in the final stages, but was edged for the runner-up spot. "As soon as the gate opened, she kinda spooked and just stood there," said Alex Solis, aboard the Bobby Frankel-trained, Michael Bello-owned filly. "She made up all that ground and only got beat a length and a half in only her second race. Very impressive. It's too bad, but there'll be many other races for her."

PLANS DEVELOP FOR FUTURITY RUNNERS

Trainer Doug O'Neill was upbeat about his pair of juveniles following their efforts in Saturday's GI Hollywood Futurity S. **Liquidity** (Tiznow), who rallied to be a close-up second to winner Stormello and sixth-place finisher **Notional** (In Excess {Ire}) came out of the 1 1/16-mile event in good order and are expected to part ways for their upcoming starts. "They both came back fantastic," said O'Neill. "Their legs were ice cold and they both ate up well." While pondering his next move, O'Neill said, "Notional will probably stay here and Liquidity will probably go out of town. I've also got Great Hunter coming back and I have to find a spot for him. It's a great problem to have." With an eye to the future, trainer Patrick Biancone said that **Belgravia** (Mr. Greeley), who was a closing fourth as the favorite, would be rested until March. "We hope to run in the [Mar. 3] Gil Robert Lewis S. at Santa Anita and then we will see," said Biancone. He ran a good race and just needs to keep improving."

Last year's champion two-year-old colt in Japan, Fusaichi Richard, a disappointing 13th in the Nov. 24 G1 Japan Cup Dirt, was off at 9-1 in the inaugural running of the Hanshin Cup. Away well from the gate, the gray grandson of French Deputy tracked off the leaders, moved to collar Meiner Scherzi in the last 50 meters and dug in to take the blanket finish over the rallying Precise Machine. Foreign invader Court Masterpiece (GB) (Polish Precedent), favored at 5-2 despite running seventh in the G1 Mile Championship at Kyoto last month, broke slowly and never fired, checking in ninth. THIS WEEK IN HISTORY...

December 20, 1987...D. Wayne Lukas-trainee **Tejano** became the first juvenile millionaire when he won the Hollywood Futurity with Laffit Pincay Jr. aboard.

December 22, 1991...Jockey Kent Desormeaux, at age 21, won his 2,000th race aboard Saron Lake, trained by Gary Jones, at Hollywood Park. He was the youngest jockey to reach that mark and did so faster than any other rider.

December 25, 1934...Santa Anita Park opened in Arcadia, CA. The five-year-old mare Las Palmas won the inaugural race before a crowd of 30,777.

December 27, 1982...Michael Dickinson, then a steeplechase trainer in England, saddled a record 12 winners in one day.

December 27, 1987...D. Wayne Lukas set a single-season record for stakes wins by a trainer, 92, when he saddled High Brite to win the Palos Verdes H. at Santa Anita Park.

**TRAINING STALWARTS LAKE, PLETCHER
FACING BANS**

Trainer Scott Lake, who currently leads the nation with 528 wins for the year, and two-time Eclipse Award winner Todd Pletcher, who leads in earnings with a record-setting \$27,427,878, are both to begin serving suspensions for medication infractions during the month of December. Lake was suspended for 30 days, to be served Dec. 24 through Jan. 22 of 2007, by order of the New York State Racing and Wagering Board. The suspension was handed down because of a clenbuterol positive in one of Lake's trainees, Zeal Power, who had traces of the prohibited bronchodilator in his system after finishing third in the second race at Aqueduct on April 12. The trainer withdrew his appeal of the suspension and will pay a \$1,000 fine, stewards said Dec. 16. Lake is already 19 days into the fulfillment of a previous 30-day suspension handed down from the Delaware Park Thoroughbred Racing Commission when one of his horses, Secret Run, tested positive for the drug after winning Delaware's fifth race on June 7. He began to serve that suspension on Nov. 27 after losing an appeal before a Delaware Superior Court. It was the trainer's second clenbuterol positive of the Delaware meet; he also had clenbuterol positives in March at Philadelphia Park and Aqueduct, and one in July at Belmont Park. Meanwhile, Pletcher's 45-day suspension is to be served Dec. 18 through Jan. 31 by order of the New York State Racing and Wagering Board. Pletcher was handed the suspension when traces of mepivacaine, a Class 2 local anesthetic, were found in the system of his trainee Tales of Glory. The horse finished first in the third race at Saratoga on Aug. 14 of 2004, but was ruled unplaced when the drug was discovered. For the complete story click [here](#).

FALLON PICTURE TO CLEAR Kieren Fallon's legal team will appear in the British courts today, with the timetable of proceedings expected to become clearer. Having been charged with conspiracy to defraud by the City of London Police as a result of their investigations into alleged race-fixing, Ballydoyle's retained rider and his 10 co-defendants are facing a lengthy legal process with a trial not expected to start until next fall. However, it is understood that Fallon's solicitors have until Tuesday to lay papers if they intend making an application for the case against him to be thrown out. Aidan O'Brien told the *Racing Post* that he is standing by Fallon. "Kieren is coming down to the yard every day and he'll do that throughout December and beyond," he said of the jockey, who is currently banned until June 7 after testing positive for a prohibited substance by France Galop. "He needs that sort of discipline, for his own personal sake and for the sake of his fitness. Kieren's a star. He's very much part of the team and we'll sit down to sort out the future for him and the stable next year."
