INVASOR AND JAZIL SHIP TO NEW YORK

Fearful of being detained in Florida because of a recent outbreak of equine herpesvirus in several parts of the state, trainer Kiaran McLaughlin has shipped probable Horse of the Year **Invasor (Arg)** (Candy Stripes) and **Jazil** (Seeking the Gold), winner of the GI

Both horses joined McLaughlin's string at Belmont Park Sunday, and will remain there for the moment. After conferring with Shadwell's Sheikh Hamdan, racing manager Rick Nichols gave the word to send the Grade I winners north. One

or both horses may contest the Feb. 3. GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Park before a possible tilt at the \$6-million Dubai World Cup at Nad al Sheba Mar. 31. "Mainly, the reason we did it, is we didn't want to be restricted from going to Dubai," McLaughlin told *DRF*. "We were concerned if something else happened in Florida, that they may put restrictions on the whole state."

'MAN' MOVES ON; 'BOY' GETS MORE TIME OFF

While Doug O'Neill readies champion older horse candidate Lava Man (Slew City Slew) for an upcoming start in the Jan. 27 Sunshine Millions Turf at Santa Anita, the trainer was forced to put the breaks on a 2007 campaign for last year's juvenile champion Stevie Wonderboy (Stephen Got Even). "He went back to the ranch [of owner Merv Griffin in La Quinta, Ca.]," O'Neill said. "I had to take a little flake out of the same [right] ankle [earlier this year], but it's not related to the initial fracture." According to O'Neill, the sophomore will miss about two months of training. The leader of O'Neill's older team, Lava Man, winner of the GI Hollywood Gold Cup and GI Pacific Classic last summer, remains on course for an intended start in the Sunshine Millions series. "He is doing awesome," O'Neill said. "He worked Christmas Eve [four furlongs in :47.80]. I was out of town, but Dennis [O'Neill, Doug's brother and assistant] said he never saw him work so easy. He was just cruising."

Now in the hands of trainer Doug O'Neill, Vague looks to get things back on track in this drop back to the sprinting ranks. Out of the money in three previous attempts in the U.S., including a well-beaten 10th in her latest start in Hollywood's GII Bayakoa H. Dec. 3, the three-year-old is making her second start for O'Neill. "Two races before I got her, she ran in really tough company [9th in the GI CCA Oaks and 7th in the GI QEII Cup]. Paul [Reddam] bought her after she won a stakes in Dubai [going 8 furlongs Feb. 16] and now she is going back to a sprint. She'll be 30-1, but she is training great." Hoping for different results with a change in tactics here, O'Neill added, "Last time, we kind of took her back intentionally and tried to make a run. I think she's a filly that likes to be a little more involved early in the race."

Shrewd observers of the commercial scene have been on to the concept of the "rebound stallion" for some time. Often a stallion will make a bright start with his first or second crop, and then lose momentum with the



runners from his third and fourth crops, which more often than not see him cover less mares and/or mares of lower quality. This is a trend which has become more marked in recent years, as market breeders flock to first-year horses, only to flee from them in the subsequent seasons. The current rise in stud fees for proven horses is going to

further intensify this pattern, as for the coming we're seeing a lot of very nice commercial mares move from the depleted ranks of mid-range proven sires toward first year horses in the \$20,000-\$40,000 range, which means the drop off for those horses in the following two or three years is going to be even more marked. cont. p3

While this can be something of a nightmare for the stallion manager, it can also provide some excellent opportunities for the astute breeder. One of the best



examples in recent years has been the 1995 champion two-year-old Maria's Mon. He started off extremely brightly with his first crop of three-year-olds, which contained nine stakes winners, headed by GI Kentucky Derby winner Monarchos, and graded winners Wander Mom and Silver Tornado. There were five more stakes win-

How She Runs, but none in his third, which at 53 foals was his smallest to date (he was back to 84 mares the following year, suggesting that his young stock had been well-received). Now, Monarchos's GI Kentucky Derby victory was achieved in 2001, which meant that--as a Classic sire with his first crop--Maria's Mon was a hot item for the 2002 breeding season (with a Grade I winner in his second crop, he also remained fashionable in 2003). The real time to take a punt with him, however, was in the subsequent seasons, particularly this year and last. The logic: the first group of mares attracted by the success of Monarchos were covered in

ners in his second crop, including Grade I winner See

2002, so would be foals of 2006, giving Maria's Mon an excellent chance of a major rebound this year. Theory is not always borne out in reality, but in this particular case the strategem has proved a sound one, and when Latent Heat captured Tuesday's GI Malibu S., he became the seventh stakes winner from Maria' Mon's 2003 foal crop, the others including GI Yellow Ribbon Stakes and GI American Oaks Invitational winner Wait a While; GII Dwyer S. and GII Super Derby victor Strong Contender; and Cause to Believe, successful in the GIII EI Camino Real Derby. Incidentally, we should also note that the 2002 foal crop has also helped the cause this year with Gaff taking the GIII Mr. Prospector H., and High Limit, the GII San Pasqual H. and GII Strub S. Latent Heat's dam, True Flare, would qualify as a good example of a superior mare who was attracted by Maria's Mon's early success. Juddmonte Farm's daughter of Capote was a two-time Listed winner and groupplaced in France before coming to the U.S., where she captured the GII Rare Perfume Breeders' Cup H. and GII San Clemente H., and finished third in the GI Del Mar Invitational Oaks. True Flare has quickly proved herself an equally good producer. Her first foal, Danzig's daughter Real Trust, was stakes-placed in France; her second, the Royal Academy colt Art Master, numbers the G3 Prix de la Jonchere and G3 Prix du Palais Royal among his victories; her third foal is the Cherokee Run filly Indian Flare, third this year in the GII Chilukki S.; and Latent Heat is her fourth foal.


True Flare's dam, the stakes-placed Mr. Prospector mare Proflare, has been an even more prolific black-type producer, as True Flare and her brother, Capital Secret, a group winner in Germany, are just two of her six stakes winners. The others include the GII Rampart H. winner Apple of Kent; War Zone, winner of the GIII Poker H. and G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot; and Set Alight, successful in the G3 Prix Thomas Bryon.

True Flare's granddam, Flare Pass, failed to win and never produced a stakes winner (although she is granddam of three other black-type winners, in addition to the sextet out of Proflare). She was, however, a sister to the GII Saranac and GIII Peter Pan S. winner Buckaroo, and closely related to Bebopper--dam of the good runners and successful sires Stop the Music and Hatchet Man--who was by Tom Fool (sire of Flare Pass's own sire, Buckpasser) out of Flare Pass's granddam, Bebop II.

Latent Heat and Wait a While are both by Maria's Mon out of mares by sons of Seattle Slew, and Maria's

Mon is also sire of stakes winner Yankee Mon out of a mare by Seattle Slew himself. The two Seattle Slew sons who appear as broodmare sires of Latent Heat and Wait a While--Capote and A.P. Indy--are rather different horses, but as far as the pedigrees of Latent Heat and Wait a While are concerned, we can note

that both True Flare (dam of Latent Heat) and A.P. Indy combine Seattle Slew with Buckpasser. This is probably rather significant if we consider that Seattle Slew's dam has the sisters Busher/ Striking 3x3 in her pedigree, this pair being three-parts sisters to Buckpasser's dam, Busanda (all by War Admiral out of a La Troienne).

If we turn to the pedigree of Maria's Mon, we can note that his sire, Wavering Monarch, is out of the mare Uncommitted. She is by Buckpasser (out of Busanda) and her dam is by Better Self, a horse who functions as a reverse relative to the tribe of horses by War Admiral out of La Troienne, as he is by La Troienne's son, Bimelech, out of a mare by War Admiral. This means that any time Maria's Mon covers a mare with Seattle Slew in the pedigree, there are at least four crosses of La Troienne (via the related Busanda, Better Self, Busher and Striking), which are concentrated through Uncommitted and My Charmer (dam of Seattle Slew).

Her granddam, Proflare, is by a son of Raise a Native, out of a mare by Buckpasser, which is a very similar cross to Maria's Mon's sire, Wavering Monarch, who is by a grandson of Raise a Native out of a mare by Buckpasser. On top of that, Proflare's dam Flare Pass is actually inbred to La Troienne through Buckpasser's granddam, Businesslike, and her half-brother Bimelech (who appears via Bimlette, a reverse cross to Businesslike). So to sum up, Latent Heat has Raise a Na-

In the case of Latent Heat, the story is even better.

tive/Buckpasser crosses 2x2 at the top and bottom of the pedigree (Wavering Monarch and Proflare). Then he has six crosses of La Troienne--four through Striking/Busher/Busanda (all by War Admiral out of daughters of La Troienne), and one through their reverse relative Better Self, and he also Bimlette, a reverse genetic relative to the dam of Busanda. While the La Troienne strains are some way back their potency is undoubtedly increased by the fact that they appear through three sources (Uncommitted, My Charmer and Flare Pass) who are 3x4x3 in the pedigree, and who are each inbred to La Troienne through genetic relatives.

While last week concluded with tragedy when upand-coming star Phantom Rose was fatally injured during a morning workout, this week has seen a reversal of fortunes for the hot combination of Juddmonte Farms and trainer Bobby Frankel. Indian Flare, a half sister to Tuesday's GI Malibu S. winner Latent Heat, proved as impressive as her little brother to gain her first stakes victory yesterday. Sharp at the break, the bay was hustled to the front and streaked through crisp early fractions of :21.71 for the opening quarter and :44.21 for the half. In command turning for home, the four-year-old had enough to hold off favored Somethinaboutlaura at the wire. A runaway winner in a \$75,000 optional claimer at the Spa Aug. 3, the filly ran fourth behind winner Dubai Escapade in the GI Ballerina BC H. Aug. 27 before finishing a troubled sixth in the GIII Floral Park H. at Belmont Park Sept. 16. 
